Probable Cause

On Thursday June 8th, 2023 at approximately 7:40 AM, I was on routine patrol on Interstate 95 (SR9) in the center lane. I observed a grey Ford F150 in the HOV lane. The vehicle passed me and I could see only a driver in the vehicle which is a violation of the HOV violation between Mon-Fri 7A-9A where you need at least two people to be able to drive in the HOV lane. I activated my emergency lights and sirens and attempted to initiate a traffic stop on the vehicle. I had my hand out the window for the driver to go to the left shoulder. The driver seemed very confused. I then drove up to the driver window and motioned the driver over to the left shoulder. The driver still seemed confused. I got on the PA system and told the driver to go to the left. After approximately a mile the driver finally pulled over onto the left shoulder. I approached the driver on the driver side of the vehicle and identified myself to the driver and requested the driver license. The driver looked all around the vehicle for his license and also patted his body as if looking for the license. The driver then tried to hand me the vehicle registration. After a few minutes the driver stated that he left his wallet at home. While speaking to the driver I was able to smell a very strong, obvious and distinct odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage from the drivers breath and person. I observed that the drivers eyes were bloodshot and glassy and the drivers speech was slightly slurred. The driver tried to talk away from me so that I would not be able to smell any alcohol on him. I asked the driver to exit the vehicle so that I could speak with him. While speaking with the driver outside, I was still able to smell the odor of alcohol emitting from the drivers breath. I asked the driver where he was coming from and where he was going to. The driver advised he was coming from PSL and going to his daughters graduation in Broward. I asked the driver how much he has had to drink and he stated nothing this morning. I then asked how much he had to drink last night and he stated that he had a great time by himself. I asked the driver who the vehicle belonged to and he stated he owned it. I advised the driver that I could smell the alcohol on him and that his eyes were bloodshot and glassy and asked if he would submit to lawful field sobriety exercises and he stated yes. I asked the driver if he had any medical issues and he stated he was a little hard of hearing. I asked if he had any issues with his eyes and he stated just old age. I asked if he had any issues with his legs and he stated no. We began the FSE's

Driver started with right foot and got to the count of 10 and put his foot down. Driver then asked if I wanted him to do it with his other leg. Driver then picked up left foot to count of 10 and put his foot down

Finger to Nose

Swayed from front to back and side to side in a circular motion
 Eyes did not remain closed
 Brings head forward to finger
 Did not touch pad of finger to tip of nose
 Took a bit to remove finger from nose

Rhomberg

Swayed from side to side and front to back in a circular motion
 Eye lid tremors

Upon completion of roadsides the driver was placed under lawful arrest for DUI. Once in my vehicle, I identified the driver as the owner of the vehicle and asked him his name, and dob. The driver was then identified as Christopher Dubissette. Mr. Dubissette was transported to Palm Beach County Jail for breath test and booking. Arrival was 9:00 AM at which point I conducted a 20 minute observation to make sure Mr. Dubissette did not have anything by mouth or regurgitate. Upon completion of the 20 minute observation Mr. Dubissette went into the breath testing room and refused a breath test. Implied consent was read and Mr. Dubissette advised that he understood and would not submit to a lawful test

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of his breath. Miranda warnings were read and Mr. Dubissette refused to answer any questions.
