I § 1b(b)</p> <p>On the above date and time, I was in service in Palm Beach County as a Deputy for the PBSO, assigned to the North Region. I was dispatched to a delayed domestic violence call that occurred at [REDACTED]. The complainant/victim, identified as LINDSEY MAY MARTIN called to advise that her girlfriend, CLARIBEL TORRES CLASS broke items in their shared apartment and also hit her. She left because she felt unsafe. Ms. Martin had been present with some Deputies in District 14 Lake Worth Beach initially to report the matter but since the incident occurred in District 3 and Ms. Martin was adamant about returning home to the apartment, she transferred the call over to us. I was advised to meet Ms. Martin at the Walgreens Store located at 6907 OKEECHOBEE BLVD, West Palm Beach, FL. I made contact with the Deputy in District 14 over the phone to get a clear understanding of the case. The Deputy explained in summary: Ms. Martin advised that she was out with a friend, later identified as ANDRES JULIAN ORSINI SANTIAGO at Miller Ale House. Ms. Martin went on to state that Andres and her arrived back at her apartment. When she went inside of the residence, her girlfriend had awoken. When she came out of the room, they began to have a verbal argument. Ms. Martin stated that Ms. Class punched her in the face. She also stated that Ms. Class was intoxicated from drinking. Ms. Martin stated that she left the apartment with the intention of having Andres drive her to Broward County where her mother lives but she changed her mind. She changed her mind because she did not feel like she should leave the apartment since she pays the rent as well and her name is on the lease. Andres convinced her to call 911 to report the domestic violence incident. They drove back north and exited off 10th Avenue South from Interstate 95 to meet with the PBSO. The Deputy took photos of her face where she advised that she was punched. The Deputy did not interview Andres. Upon my arrival at Walgreens, I made contact with Ms. Martin. I explained to Ms. Martin that I would be taking over the investigation and needed to obtain a sworn statement from her regarding the domestic violence incident. Ms. Martin stated that she did not want to give a statement. She explained that prior to her arriving at the Walgreens, she went back to her apartment but Ms. Class had refused to let her in the residence by latching the top lock. Ms. Martin stated that she was not concerned about her safety, she just wanted us to escort her home so that she could sleep. Ms. Martin advised that she was forced by her friend to report the incident. I advised Ms. Martin that I was concerned about her safety and needed to conduct a proper investigation. I did not observe any injuries on her face. I then obtained a sworn recorded statement from Andres. Andres stated that they came back to the residence from the Ale house. When they went inside, Ms. Class had awoken and stated that they were making too much noise. Ms. Martin and Ms. Class began to argue and Andres observed Ms. Class punch Ms. Martin in the face and about the body several times. Andres stated that Ms. Martin defended herself. Andres does not live here in the county, he is visiting from Ft. Meyers, FL.</p> | | | | | | | | |

After speaking with Andres, we drove over to the apartment in an attempt to make contact with Ms. Class. Upon arrival, Ms. Class was no longer at the apartment. I obtained Ms. Class phone number from Ms. Martin. Contact was made with Ms. Class, who stated that she went over to a friend's residence located at 316 CRANES ROOST, Royal Palm Beach, FL 33411. Upon making contact, I asked Ms. Class to share her side of today's incident. Ms. Class advised that she was asleep in the apartment, when Ms. Martin and Andres arrived. Ms. Class stated that Ms. Martin was intoxicated and came into the room hitting her, all because Ms. Class told her that she was being too loud. Ms. Class stated that they fight all the time and that her friend convinced Ms. Martin to call the police but they never called the police before. Ms. Class stated that during the incident, she was scratched. I observed a scratch on the right side of her neck. It should be noted that neither party appeared to be under the influence. Ms. Class stated that she has ADHD, Ms. Martin stated that Ms. Class is Bi-Polar. Ms. Martin stated that herself is also ADHD. I find Ms. Class to be the primary aggressor. Ms. Class was placed into handcuffs that were checked for proper fit and tightness. Ms. Class will be charged with simple battery for actually and intentionally striking Ms. Martin against her will when she punched her, as seen by the witness Andres. Ms. Class was transported to the Palm Beach County Jail for Booking.
