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**NARRATIVE:** The undersigned has probable cause to believe the above-named defendant on the, 19 of September 2025 at 23:46 at INTERSTATE 4WB MM68 (Zone: 4) in Orange County did

On September 20th 2025 at 12:27AM I arrived on scene at a single motor vehicle crash that occurred on Interstate 4 westbound near MM68 to assist Trooper Amaral (4262). This crash occurred on September 19th 2025 at 11:46PM. Trooper Amaral stated that Vehicle 1 – a Jeep SUV with the Florida license plate: C19LJ was traveling eastbound in the westbound lanes of Interstate 4 near MM68 before colliding with a concrete half wall. Trooper Amaral stated that there were two females inside the vehicle, but the younger female had already stated she was the driver of the vehicle. Trooper Amaral also stated that the older female’s glasses were located on the passenger side of the vehicle. Trooper Amaral completed an incident report with his observations.

The driver of the vehicle will be identified by her Florida driver’s license as Dakota Taylor Bence with a date of birth of 08/01/1996. Ms Bence has a Florida license number: B231-345-17-200-0. Ms Bence was walking around with no shoes on, just socks when I first met her. Ms Bence had a yellow wristband on her right wrist, commonly associated with establishments that serve alcohol. At 12:29AM I read Ms Bence her Miranda rights to which she stated she understood but asked for my advice. I explained to Ms Bence that I couldn’t provide her legal advice. I asked Ms Bence where she was coming from, to which she stated Disney Springs with her mother. Ms Bence stated they were at a concert and were heading back home to Deltona. Ms Bence stated that she was driving the vehicle but did not know where she entered Interstate 4 from. Ms Bence’s speech was slurred and she was talkative. Ms Bence could not stand still and at times would lose her balance and fall backwards. Ms Bence’s eyes were bloodshot and glossy, and her pupils were dilated.

While speaking to Ms Bence I had to repeat my questions and rephrase my questions to ensure she understood what I was asking. Ms Bence had a lack of concentration and memory issues. Ms Bence forgot what my name was after only a few minutes had elapsed and repeated her statements multiple times. At this point, I informed Ms Bence that Trooper Amaral’s crash investigation was complete and that I was conducting a DUI investigation. Ms Bence stated she only had one shot of alcohol at least two hours ago. Ms Bence does not take any prescription medications, controlled substances or other drugs. Ms Bence is overall in good health.

I requested Ms Bence to complete voluntary field sobriety exercises to ensure she was safe to drive. Ms Bence wanted to know if that was her only option, to which I explained that I would have to base my decision off everything up until this point – if she refused to complete the exercises. Ms Bence did not understand to which I explained this to her numerous times. Ms Bence stated she would rather just walk over to the hotel that she was staring at. Eventually, Ms Bence understood her two options to which she stated she would not complete the voluntary field sobriety exercises.

At 12:54AM Ms Bence was placed under arrest for DUI. Ms Bence was then placed inside my patrol vehicle after ensuring there was nothing on her person. Ms Bence’s vehicle was towed by AATR Orlando. At 12:59AM I read Implied Consent to Ms Bence to which she again asked if she had another option. I then read Refusal to Ms Bence. Ms Bence needed the options read again to her and would need me to explain the options multiple times. Ms Bence would eventually state that she would provide a legal sample of her breath.

At 01:03AM the twenty-minute observation period began. Ms Bence did not regurgitate or put anything in her mouth during the observation period. Ms Bence stated that she had two and a half drinks tonight. Ms Bence was very talkative during the observation period, jumping from topic to topic. Ms Bence stated she hoped I had a great night multiple times. Ms Bence talked about how she worked out and did cardio every day and that it had been over a week since she last smoked weed or drank alcohol. Ms Bence stated she does not drink very often. It appeared that Ms Bence did not understand the severity of the incident.

At 01:25AM Ms Bence provided her first legal breath sample which read to be 0.209.

Ms Bence was in actual physical control of a motor vehicle in the State of Florida, and her normal faculties were impaired. Ms Bence caused a motor vehicle crash in the State of Florida which caused property damage. All these events occurred in Orange County, Florida.

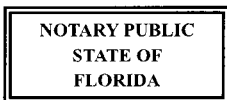
