<b>NARRATIVE:</b> The undersigned has probable cause to believe the above-named defendant on the <u>17</u> of <u>January 2024</u> at <u>11:00</u> at <u>N ORLANDO AVE &amp; MAYO AVE</u> (Zone: <u>1</u> ) in Orange County did			
<p>On 01/16/2024 at approximately 2300 hours, I was patrolling the area of US Hwy 17-92 and Sybelia Pkwy, in the City of Maitland, Orange County, Florida. I observed a white Audi, bearing Florida license plate 34ECUK, driving northbound on US Hwy 17-92 without any headlights lights on. I maneuvered behind the vehicle and conducted a traffic stop at US Hwy 17-92 and Mayo Avenue.</p> <p>I approached the vehicle, introduced myself and made contact with the driver, Danyell Pino (Defendant Pino). I explained the reason for the stop to Defendant Pino and questioned her about why her headlights were not on. Defendant Pino stated she just bought the vehicle a couple days ago.</p> <p>Officer Killon arrived on scene to assist with the traffic stop.</p> <p>I asked Defendant Pino for her driver's license, vehicle's registration, and proof of insurance. Defendant Pino provided her registration but was unable to provide her Florida driver's license. I questioned Defendant Pino as to why she didn't have her driver's license. She stated she had just bought the vehicle and her license was in her other purse, which was in her car rental.</p> <p>As I was speaking with Defendant Pino, I observed her eyes to be bloodshot and glassy. I noticed there was an odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the Defendant Pino, which grew stronger as she spoke. I questioned Defendant Pino if she had been drinking this evening. She stated yes that she had a couple glasses of wine at Copper Rocket, which is a local bar and grill.</p> <p>Officer Gagne arrived on scene to replace Officer Killon who needed to leave work.</p> <p>Based on my observations, I expressed my concerns to Defendant Pino about her ability to safely operate a motor vehicle and asked her to step out of the vehicle. She agreed. I then asked Defendant Pino if she was willing to participate in Field Sobriety Exercises and she agreed. While speaking to Defendant Pino, the odor of alcoholic beverage was emanating from her, which grew stronger as she spoke.</p> <p>Defendant Pino was moved to a clear spot in the parking lot. The area was well lit and free of debris. The weather was cold and calm. I questioned Defendant Pino if she was comfortable in the shoes she was wearing. Defendant Pino stated she was comfortable because she wears heels regularly.</p> <p>Prior to starting the exercises, I asked Defendant Pino several questions. Her answers were as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Not diabetic and doesn't have any medical conditions</li> <li>- Does not wear contacts or glasses</li> <li>- Does not take any medications</li> <li>- Hasn't used any illegal narcotics or drugs.</li> <li>- No injuries that would prevent her from conducting any walking or standing exercises</li> </ul> <p>The first Field Sobriety Exercise conducted was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus, during which I utilized the tip of my right index finger as the stimulus. The instructions were explained to Defendant Pino to which she indicated she understood. During the exercise, I observed the following clues:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Orbital sway</li> </ul>

- Lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes
- Distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes.
- The onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes

After conducting Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus, Defendant Pino stated she had vertigo. Defendant Pino stated that the only portion that affected her vertigo was the vertical portion.

The second Field Sobriety Exercise conducted was the Walk and Turn, during which a line of 2 inch masking tape was utilized. The instructions were explained and demonstrated to Defendant Pino to which she indicated she understood. During the exercise, I observed the following clues:

- Missed heel to toe on several steps
- Stepped off the line
- Improper turn
- Used arms for balance

The third Field Sobriety Exercise conducted was the One Leg Stand, during which Defendant Pino lifted her right foot. The instructions were explained and demonstrated to Defendant Perez and she indicated she understood. During the exercise, I observed the following clues:

- Started too soon
- Swayed greater than two inches
- Put foot down prior to the exercise being completed
- Used arms for balance

The final Field Sobriety Exercise conducted was the Modified Romberg with alphabet recitation. The instructions were explained to Defendant Pino and she indicated she understood. I asked Defendant Pino what her highest level of education was, she replied high school diploma. I asked Defendant Pino if she knew the English alphabet. She stated she did. During the exercise, I observed the following clues:

-said the alphabet in a rhythmic manner.

After completing the exercises, I asked Defendant Pino on a scale from 0 to 10, 0 being completely sober and 10 being the drunkest she had ever been, where she would place herself. Defendant Pino stated 0.

Based on the totality of the circumstances, I determined that Defendant Pino was in actual physical control of her motor vehicle in the State of Florida while her normal faculties were impaired by alcohol and/or drugs. Defendant Pino was placed under arrest and secured in handcuffs that were double locked and checked for proper fit. Defendant Pino was searched by Sergeant Nowling, who is a female Sergeant, with negative results.

Defendant Pino's vehicle was towed from the scene by Tri-County Towing. A vehicle inventory form was completed.

Defendant Pino was transported to the DUI center without incident.




Defendant Pino was issued a DUI citation and a UTC for operating her motor vehicle without any headlights on.
