**Probable Cause** 

On 11/14/2019 at approximately 6:00PM I received a call for a crash involving two vehicles. The grash originated on Interstate 95 (State Road 9) southbound at Forest Hill Boulevard, Palm Beach County, Florida. On my arrival to the scene I was able to observe two vehicles on the right shoulder next to the concrete wall. One of the vehicles was identified as a road ranger marked vehicle bearing a Florida Tag: HHHT11. The other vehicle was identified as a gray in color Dodge Ram bearing Texas Tag LTY4667, vin number: 12920043494250015. The vehicle was registered to a ADAM CHRISTOPHER WALSH. The road ranger was identified as Javier Antonio Brito by his Florida Driver's License B-630-421-69-350-0. The driver of the gray in color Dodge Ram was later identified as Adam Christopher Walsh by his Texas Driver's License 44181116. Mr. Brito observed Mr. Walsh inside the vehicle and then exiting the vehicle. Mr. Brito stated that while talking to Mr. Walsh he was able to smell a strong odor of alcohol. When I arrived on scene Mr. Walsh was standing on the right shoulder and was talking to a fire fighter. I asked Mr. Walsh to provide me with his Driver's Permit, Vehicle registration and Vehicle insurance. Mr. Walsh had trouble getting his Driver's License out of his wallet. Mr. Walsh was observed losing his balance multiple times, he walked to his vehicle to get the other documents was not able to maintain his balance. While at the proximity of Mr. Walsh I was able to smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from his mouth area. Mr. Walsh also presented with watery/ glassy eyes, flushed red skin and slurred speech. Mr. Walsh was not able to find the required documents inside his vehicle; he was observed fumbling with an envelope while searching for the documents. Mr. Walsh was asked multiple times if he was ok due to his lack of balance. Mr. Walsh walked towards his vehicle and hit his right arm after losing his balance. Mr. Walsh was told not to get inside his vehicle and to stand next to the concrete median wall for his safety. Mr. Walsh was not able to follow instructions and attempted to get inside the vehicle multiple times. After finishing the crash investigation and provided Mr. Walsh with the appropriate documentation I informed him that based on my observations I was going to conduct a DUI investigation. Mr. Walsh became defensive and stated that he was not drunk. I told Mr. Walsh that we were going to relocate to the Lantana Substation due to the hazardous conditions on the roadway at the time (wet roadway and traffic). Before putting Mr. Walsh in the back of my patrol car I asked him if he was willing to perform the Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises, he stated yes. While attempting to handcuff Mr. Walsh to relocate to a safe area Mr. Walsh was tensing his right arm and was not cooperating. Mr. Walsh stated that he needed to go to the Psychiatric Hospital and did not want to go to jail, he stated he was suicidal. I placed Mr. Walsh in the back of my vehicle and relocated him to the Lantana Substation located just east of Interstate 95 on Lantana Road. Mr. Walsh stated that he had a dog in the back seat of his truck, while doing the inventory of the truck I did notice dog hair but could find the dog. Later Mr. Walsh said that the dog was inside his camper. While performing the inventory of the gray in color Dodge Ram I was able to find four green cans of beer, three of them were closed and cold to the touch, one of them was open with

no contents inside but it was cold to the touch and had condensation on the surface of the can ( Cigar City Jai-Alai IPA/ American IPA) The other closed cans were found by the center console. Once at the Lantana Substation I released Mr. Walsh from the back seat of my vehicle and took of the handcuffs. I asked again if he was willing to perform the Standardized Field Sobriety exercises, Mr. Walsh stated that something inside him was telling him not to, but he was going to give it a try because he knew he was not drunk.

#### Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE):

The area for the following roadside exercises was a level hard surface and was free of debris. The weather was clear but rain most of the afternoon. The area was well lit and illuminated by surrounding ambient light and vehicle lights.

#### Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus:

I advised the subject to stand straight with his feet together and arms down by his side. I asked subject if he wore any glasses or contacts, he advised no. For the exercise I used my issued red in color pen light. I asked the subject if he could see the red pen light, he stated yes. The subject was asked about any current medical conditions, he stated that he had multiple. I advised the subject to follow the red pen light with his eyes, and to not move his head. I asked subject if he understood the instructions I gave him. He stated yes. I asked if he had any questions they stated no.

The following was observed during Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus:

The subject did have resting Nystagmus and dilated pupils.

While standing within close proximity of the subject, I could detect a strong and distinct odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage, and his eyes were watery. Subject was swaying.

The following was observed during Vertical Gaze Nystagmus:

The area for the following roadside exercises was level and free of debris. We used a white in color line the subject advised he could see. The line was illuminated by surrounding light and vehicle lights.

(Starting Position): I advised the subject to place his left foot on the white in color line and his right foot directly in front of it, touching heel to toe. I advised the subject to keep his arms down by his side and to stay in that position until I advise him to begin the exercise.

(Instructional Phase): This exercise was first explained to the subject then was demonstrated by me. Subject advised that he would be able to perform the exercise. Subject advised that he had no injuries that would affect the exercise. Subject advised me that he understood instructions and did not have any questions.

- The following was observed during the instructional phase of the exercise: The subject was not able to keep the starting position, the subject lost balance multiple times and started the exercise too soon. The subject did not follow instructions and interrupted the instructional phase, the subject had to repeat the exercise.


(Starting Position): I instructed the subject to stand with his feet together and keep his arms down by his side. I instructed the subject to stay in that position until I tell him to start the exercise.

Subject advised that he understood instructions and did not have any questions.

Subject displayed 3/4 clues specific to the one leg stand.

Based upon my observations and the totality of circumstances, Mr. Walsh was placed under arrest for DUI pursuant to Florida Statute 316.193.1 at 8:33PM. Mr. Walsh was then searched and placed in my patrol vehicle and transported to the Palm Beach County Jail. While in transport to the Palm Beach County Jail there was an obvious strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage within my vehicle that was not present prior to placing Mr. Walsh in the vehicle.

Mr. Walsh arrived at the Palm Beach County Jail at 9:04PM. I then conduct a 20-minute observation of Mr. Walsh. Mr. Walsh did not have any foreign objects in his mouth prior to the 20-minute observation. I made Mr. Walsh rinse his mouth with water prior to the 20-minute observation Throughout the observation Mr. Walsh did not take anything by mouth or regurgitated. After the 20-minute observation, Mr. Walsh was then given the opportunity to provide a sample of his breath which he consented to provide (On Video). Mr. Walsh first breath was given at 9:37PM and resulted in a .199 Mr. Walsh second breath was given at 9:40PM and resulted in a .206

Mr. Walsh was also issued a uniform traffic citations for careless driving, No registration, No insurance and DUI property damage.

Video of the traffic stop, roadsides and transport are available through the FHP custodian. The above incident did occur in Palm Beach County, Florida.


