PERSONAL CONTACT/DRIVING PATTERN/OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

While conducting routine patrol, I observed an occupied white in color Buick Lesabre parked facing southbound in front of the closed Tropical Island Restaurant located at 400 East Boynton Beach Boulevard, Boynton Beach, FL 33435 (business operation hours are 0830 hours to 2230 hours). Upon sight of my marked Boynton Beach Police Department vehicle #4521, the vehicle abruptly started its engine and exited the business parking lot to travel southbound onto SE 3rd Street. I was eventually able to catch up to the vehicle at the 100 block of NE 3rd Street where I conducted a traffic stop and I made contact with the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle, W/M Adam Matthew Hanley (DOB: 12/15/75). As I approached Hanley's vehicle he held his Florida driver's license and car insurance out his rolled down driver's side window and yelled, "Here you go!". I retrieved the aforementioned documents from Hanley through his rolled down driver's side window. While conversing with Hanley, I observed his eyes to be blood shot and the strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage could strongly be smelled emanating from within the vehicle's interior. I then asked Hanley if he had anything inside his vehicle that could hurt me to include drugs, guns, or weapons at which point he replied, "Possibly". I then requested Officer Hanley remove himself from his vehicle at which point he stated he wanted to walk home and hung his head down by letting his chin touch his upper chest. Let it be noted, during this interaction with Hanley he continued to mumble and slur words that could not be comprehended. At this point, I opened Hanley's driver's side door and I along with other Officer's on scene assisted Hanley in stepping out of his vehicle. I then placed Hanley in handcuffs (which were double locked and checked for tightness) due to his previous statement of being unable to notify Officers if there was anything in his vehicle that could possibly hurt us. Let it be noted, as I placed Hanley in handcuffs he continued to slump over needing the assistance of officers on scene to stand. Officers were then able to assist Hanley to the front of my patrol vehicle where he sat down on the front bumper. At this time, I uncuffed Hanley and I informed him that I was switching hats and now would be conducting a DUI investigation. I then read Hanley his Miranda Rights on scene to which he verbally stated he understood. I then requested Hanley to perform the standard field sobriety tasks (SFST) to which he advised he would not. I then advised Hanley that if he refused to perform the task I requested of him that it can and would be used against him in a court of law. I requested Hanley a second time to perform the SFST, at which time he began to yell that he wanted his attorney. Hanley continued to yell that he wanted his attorney, therefore I then placed Hanley under arrest for driving under the influence (handcuffs were double locked and checked for tightness) and transported him back to the Boynton Beach Police Department for the standard twenty minute observation and processing. At this point, I requested Hanley submit to a lawful test of his breath at which point he refused and asked for his lawyer. I then read him implied consent, which he stated that he understood. I requested a second time for Hanley to submit to a lawful test of his breath at which point Hanley again stated no and requested his lawyer. At that point my investigation was seized.

Based on the above facts, I have established probable cause to charge Adam Matthew Hanley (DOB: 12/15/75) with driving under the influence which is pursuant to Florida State Statute 316.193(1). Hanley was then transported to the PBCJ without incident. Let it be noted, while Hanley was in the booking

facility cell at BBPD he began to yell and beat his fist against the window continuously, showing signs of impairment.

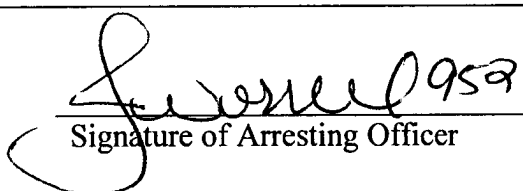
