PROBABLE CAUSE

On the above date and time, I was patrolling Palm Beach County in my marked State patrol vehicle. I was stationary southbound, on State Road 9 (I-95), south of State Road 882 (Forest Hill Blvd) on the left paved shoulder. A passing motorist (witness) called our Lake Worth Regional Communication Center (LWRCC) dispatch officer to advise them that there was a gray vehicle traveling southbound, on I-95 around the area of 6th Avenue, swerving all over the road and failing to maintain a single travel lane. I then advised LWRCC dispatch officer that I would be enroute to the area in search of the gray vehicle. Shortly after, LWRCC dispatch officer advised that the witness was still landline, advising where the gray vehicle was location.

*Reference the CAD notes and witness statement

Moments later, I caught up to the witness around the area of southbound I-95 and Woolbright Rd. I then observed a gray SUV bearing Florida License plate "IESH24" straddling the inside travel and inside center travel white broken lines. I then positioned my patrol vehicle in the center travel lane to observe the driving pattern of the gray SUV. The gray SUV then traveled from the inside center travel lane, to the outside center travel lane, almost colliding with a vehicle while doing so. Due to the driver's dangerous driving pattern, I then activated my emergency lights and sirens to initiate a traffic stop on the gray SUV. The gray SUV took several moments to pull over, but finally came to a controlled stop on the right paved shoulder on I-95, south of Woolbright Rd. The witness traveled behind my patrol vehicle.

I then exited my patrol vehicle and approached the gray SUV on the passenger side. Once to the SUV, I introduced myself to the driver; who was later identified by Georgia driver's license number 0258861042 as Alexander S Byars. I asked Mr. Byars was there anything wrong with his vehicle. Mr. Byars advised me no, that he was just getting used to it. I asked Mr. Byars if that was the reason why he was driving the way he was. Mr. Byars advised he was not aware of how he was driving. I advised Mr. Byars that he was failing to maintain a single traffic lanes several times, almost causing a crash. Mr. Byars advised he was not aware of that. While speaking to Mr. Byars, I observed Mr. Byars to have red glassy eyes, and slow movements. I asked Mr. Byars if he was okay. Mr. Byars advised yes. I asked Mr. Byars if he has consumed any alcohol and or taken any medication. Mr. Byars advised the he took Adderall. I then walked back to my patrol vehicle to run Mr. Byars information. After doing so, I returned to the gray SUV.

I then asked Mr. Byars to exit the SUV. Mr. Byars complied and did so. I instructed Mr. Byars to walk back to my patrol. While doing so, I observed Mr. Byars to have trouble balancing. I then began to speak with Mr. Byars on his comments about taking Adderall. While speaking to Mr. Byars, I further observed Mr. Byars to have droopy eyelids, slow movements, and appeared impaired. Mr. Byars advised that he took an unknown amount of Adderall earlier in the evening. Due to Mr. Byars comments about taking Adderall and observations of Mr. Byars, I asked Mr. Byars to participate in a series of field sobriety exercises to determine his impairment level. When asked, Mr. Byars agreed to submit to a series of field sobriety exercises.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus exercise

Prior to beginning the exercise it was determined Mr. Byars was not wearing contacts. Mr. Byars's eyes were checked and his eyes displayed equal tracking and his pupils were equal sizes. Mr. Byars was instructed to following the stimulus with his eyes only, keeping his head still. Mr. Byars stated he understood the instructions Mr. Byars attempted this exercise.

The results of this exercise did not reveal any of 6 possible clues.

While performing the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus exercise, it was observed that Mr. Byars:

- Swayed while standing.
- The instructions for the exercise had to be repeated before Mr. Byars would respond
- Also observed eye tremors

Walk and Turn exercise

Prior to attempting this exercise, Mr. Byars indicated he did not have any medical problems that would have prevented him from performing the exercise. Mr. Byars was instructed to put his left foot on the imaginary line and his right foot in front of it with his right heel touching the toe of his left foot. He was instructed to stand in this manner with his hands to his sides until the exercise instructions were completed and the exercise demonstrated. Mr. Byars was instructed not to begin the exercise until told to start. He was instructed to take nine steps along the line in a heel-to-toe manner. After the ninth step he was to stop and turn around keeping his lead foot on the ground, taking several small steps with the other foot to turn around. After turning around he was to take nine steps in a heel-to-toe manner back along the imaginary line, in the direction he had come from. Mr. Byars was further instructed to watch his feet at all times while walking, keep his arms down to his side, and to count his steps out loud. After the exercise was demonstrated Mr. Byars stated he understood the instructions and was instructed to begin the exercise.

- After attempting the Walk and Turn exercise Mr. Byars displayed 3 of 8 possible clues.

Walk and Turn exercise observations:

- On the first set of steps Mr. Byars failed to walk in a heel-to-toe manner on 6 steps, failing to walk heel-to-toe on steps 2, 3, 6, 7, 8, and 9. - On the second set of steps Mr. Byars failed to walk in a heel-to-toe manner on 4 steps, failing to walk heel-to-toe on steps 2, 3, 5, and 6. - Raised arms for balance during the exercise.
- Turned incorrectly.
- Did not look down and watch his feet during the exercise.

One Leg Stand exercise

Prior to attempting this exercise, Mr. Byars indicated he did not have any medical problems that would have prevented him from performing the exercise. Mr. Byars was instructed to stand with his heels together and hands down to his sides while the instructions were given and during the exercise. Mr. Byars was instructed not to begin the exercise until he was instructed to start, and after the exercise had been demonstrated. When instructed to start, he was to raise the foot of his choice off the ground approximately 6 inches. While his leg was raised he was to keep his leg straight, watch his raised foot, and to count out loud by thousands (one thousand one, one thousand two, one thousand three...) and to continue the exercise until told to stop (30 seconds). After this exercise was demonstrated and indicating he understood the instructions Mr. Byars attempted this exercise.

When Mr. Byars attempted this exercise he raised his right foot.

The result of this exercise displayed 4 of the 4 possible clues.

During this exercise Mr. Byars:

- Swayed during the exercise.
- Used arms for balance.
- Hopped during the exercise
- Put his foot down (3 time(s) during the exercise).

I then demonstrated to Mr. Byars the Modified Romberg Balance exercise. I advised Mr. Byars when asked to begin, to stand with his feet together, keep his hands down by his side, lean his head back and close his eyes. After doing so, Mr. Byars was instructed to estimate the passage of 30 seconds in Mr. Byars head without counting out loud, and when finished to open his eyes, bring his head back to a neutral position and say done. Mr. Byars advised he understood. Mr. Byars then began the exercise. Mr. Byars advised he was done at 38 seconds.

After I completed the Standardize Field Sobriety Exercise observations on Mr. Byars, I then placed Mr. Byars under arrest for potential driving under the influence (DUI). I then placed Mr. Byars in the rear of my patrol vehicle. I then returned to the gray SUV to conduct an inventory for the tow truck. While doing so, I found a common pharmaceutical bottle with no label on it, containing an unknown amount of 20MG Adderall pills. I then removed the bottle for evidence. I then escorted Mr. Byars to the Palm Beach County Jail. Once there, I escorted Mr. Byars into the BAT center. Once there, I conducted a 20 minutes observation period on Mr. Byars. One 20 minutes where up, I escorted Mr. Byars into the BAT room. I requested Mr. Byars to submit to a lawful test of his breath for the purpose of determining its alcohol content. Mr. Byars agreed to submit at approximately 12:06AM. At 12:10AM, Mr. Byars provided his first breathe sample of .000. At 12:13AM, Mr. Byars provided a second breathe sample of .000.

After providing the breath sample, Mr. Byars was asked to provide a urine sample to for the purpose of detecting the presence of chemical or controlled substances. Mr. Byars refused to submit at 12:17AM. I then advised Mr. Byars of implied consent. After advising Mr. Byars of his implied consent, Mr. Byars continued to refuse. I then advised Mr. Byars of his constitutional warnings. Mr. Byars advised me he would refuse further questioning (See BAT room video). I then transported Mr. Byars to booking into the Palm Beach County Jail. Mr. Byars was booked into the Palm Beach County jail on 316.193.1 Florida Statue. After I placed the pharmaceutical bottle into evidence at the Lantana Substation. All events occurred in Palm Beach County.
