On December 29, 2018 I was on routine patrol in my marked patrol in Palm Beach County. I responded to the scene of a traffic stop that occurred on I-95 (State Road 9) northbound south of Blue Heron Blvd. I was briefed by Sgt. Handzik when I arrived on scene. She stated to me that as she was traveling northbound she observed a vehicle that was traveling at a high rate of speed. She then stated that she initiated a traffic stop for a speed violation. She continued to state that as she talked to the driver she observed the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from her breath as he talked. She also stated that he had bloodshot glassy eyes and a dazed appearance. I then arrived on scene and began a possible DUI investigation. I approached the vehicle and observed that the driver was the sole occupant of the vehicle. I also observed that the driver had bloodshot glassy eyes, allured speech and the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage was emitting from his breath as he talked. I then requested that the driver step out of the vehicle and walk towards my patrol car. As he stood in front of me I observed that he had bloodshot glassy eyes, slurred speech and the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage was emitting from his breath as he talked. I then requested that he conduct field sobriety exercises and he agreed.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus

Before beginning the exercises, I checked to see if Opritsa was wearing glasses or contact lenses. It was determined that Opritsa was not wearing glasses. I then checked Opritsa's eyes and observed equal tracking and equal pupil size. Opritsa was instructed to place his feet together and place his hands down at his side. He then was instructed to keep his head still and follow the stimulus with his eyes and his eyes only. He was also instructed to keep looking at the stimulus until told not to. Opritsa verbally indicated that he understood.

- Lack of smooth pursuit, left eye
- Lack of smooth pursuit, right eye
- A distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in the left eye
- A distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in the right eye
- An onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in the left eye
- An onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in the right eye

Walk and Turn Exercise

The area was level and free of debris. Opritsa verbally indicated that he saw the line on the ground. Opritsa was instructed to put his left foot on the line, then place his right foot on the line ahead of the left foot in a heel to toe manner. I then demonstrated this position. Opritsa was instructed not to begin untold to do so. Opritsa verbally indicated that he has understood all instructions up to this point. Opritsa was then instructed to take 9 heel to toe steps on the line when told to do so. I then demonstrated this. Opritsa was then instructed to turn on the ninth step and to keep the front foot on the line and to take a series of small steps with the foot on the line. I then demonstrated this for Opritsa. Opritsa was also instructed to keep his arms at his sides and to watch his feet during the exercise. Opritsa was also instructed to count aloud and to not stop once he begins the exercise. He was also instructed to keep his arms at his sides at all times.

He had to be told to remain in the instructional position and began the exercise too soon. He took 9 steps forward and 10 steps back. Mr. Opritsa showed difficulty keeping balance during the instructions and the exercise. I observed that he stepped off the line on multiple steps. He also stopped during the turn and improperly completed the turn. He also did not count out loud as instructed.

One Leg Stand Exercise

Mr. Opritsa was instructed to stand with his feet together and to place his arms down at his side. Mr. Opritsa was instructed to maintain that position until told to do so. Once told to do so, Mr. Opritsa was instructed to raise one foot approximately tinches off the ground and to keep both legs straight with both arms at his side. He was also instructed to look at the elevated foot and count aloud in the manner of one thousand-one, one thousand-two and so on until told to stop. Mr. Opritsa verbally indicated that he understood the instructions after I demonstrated to him.

Mr. Opritsa was told to begin and raised his right foot. During the exercise Mr. Opritsa displayed an orbital sway and did not look down at his foot. He also raised his foot approximately 4 inches off the ground and placed his foot down during the exercise. He also swayed around during the exercise and did not keep both legs straight.

Finger To Nose

Mr. Opritsa was instructed stand with his feet together and arms at his side and to have his index fingers pointed out. He was instructed to not start and stay in that position until told to do so. He stated that he understood. I then demonstrated the position. Mr. Opritsa was then instructed to when told to start to close both eyes and tilt his head back. When told to do so he was instructed to bring the hand I directed upward, touching the tip of your finger to the tip of his nose. I then demonstrated this. He was then instructed to after touching the tip of the nose to immediately bring his hand down to his side. He stated that he understood. I then demonstrated and he stated that he understood. He was instructed to raise his hand in the following order, left, right, left, right, and right, left.
