PERSONAL CONTACT

NARRATIVE:

I responded to 1550 Apt #1 Forest Hill Blvd, Lake Clarke Shores in reference to unknown subject(s) engaged in a fight. Upon arrival I observed several subjects yelling at each other, with bloody faces and tattered and bloody clothing. I also noticed two young children in the vehicle, which were found to be unharmed. Subject Senia was lying on the ground hyperventilating but was later found to have medical issues not related to the alleged battery. Fire Rescue #39 was summoned to the scene to assess injuries.

Subject Alina was aggressive in her demeanor towards myself despite my attempts to tell to go inside, and was thus handcuffed to prevent escalating an already volatile situation. She was temporarily secured in my patrol car.

I spoke to subject Castillo, who stated they were all drinking celebrating the New Year, when the subject came up of subject Castillo sending/receiving suggestive texts from Alina. It should be noted subject Castillo is in a relationship with subject Nicole, who is Alina's sister. Subject Castillo stated his girlfriend, Nicole started arguing with subject Castillo and her sister Alina and called Alina a whore. Subject Castillo alleges subject Alina threw the first punch at her sister, and both Alina and Nicole starting brawling in the living room of the residence. Subject Castillo alleges him, and subject Senia tried to break up the fight due to the fact there were small children present. At one point subject Nicole was throwing lawn chairs around and broke the living room window. Subject Castillo stated that subject Alina came out of her residence with a machete but was taken away from her by subject Castillo and subject Senia and discarded in the bushes. Due to conflicting statements, Subject Alina's intent with the machete could not be determined as to who or what it was intended for.

Subject Castillo further advised that when he secured his two boys in the vehicle and was ready to drive home, subject Nicole began to batter him inside the vehicle, causing scratches along his neck, face and bit him on his inner right elbow. Subject Castillo stated he sought had to defend himself against Nicole and head butted as his only recourse. I spoke to subject Nicole who stated also subject Alina threw the first punch and began the physical confrontation corroborating subject Castillo's statement.

I noticed both defensive and offensive wounds on both Nicole and her sister Alina. Both had bruised knuckles and bloody mouths. Alcohol may have likely played a role as its stench was prevalent.

Based on the above I find probable cause to charge Alina with battery in a domestic setting as upon the conclusion of this investigation determined to be the primary aggressor.
