PROBABLE CAUSE

On the above date and time, I was traveling southbound on State Road 9 (I-95) near the area of 10th Ave. While traveling on I-95, I observed a white vehicle in the outside travel lane ahead of me. I observed the white vehicle to be failing to maintain a single travel lane. The white vehicle continued to do this for approximately a mile. I then activated my emergency lights and sirens to initiate a traffic stop on the white vehicle. Shortly after, the white vehicle traveled to the right paved shoulder on I-95 and came to a controlled stop. I then exited my patrol and approached the driver side of the white vehicle bearing Florida License Plate number "Y30GTX".

Once to the vehicle, I introduced myself to the driver; who was later identified by her Florida Driver's License number U-240-006-94-926-0 as AMEDEA FLOR UCCELLI. I explained to Ms. Uccelli the reason for the stop and asked her was there anything wrong with her vehicle. Ms. Uccelli advised no. I asked Ms. Uccelli where she was coming from. Ms. Uccelli advised a friend's house. While speaking to Ms. Uccelli, I observed an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from the inside the vehicle. I further observed Ms. Uccelli to have red glassy eyes. I asked Ms. Uccelli if she consumed any alcoholic beverages prior to/while driving. Ms. Uccelli advised she had a bottle of champagne not long ago. I then asked Ms. Uccelli to exit her vehicle. Ms. Uccelli complied and did so. Once out of the vehicle, I observed Ms. Uccelli to have issues balancing. I then began to speak with Ms. Uccelli on her comments about consuming a whole bottle of champagne. While speaking to Ms. Uccelli, I observed an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from the mouth and breath area of Ms. Uccelli. When asked, Ms. Uccelli agreed to submit to Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE's).

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus exercise

Prior to beginning the exercises it was determined Ms. Uccelli was wearing contacts. Ms. Uccelli eyes were checked and her eyes displayed equal tracking and her pupils were equal sizes. Ms. Uccelli was instructed to following the stimulus with her eyes only, keeping her head still. After stating she understood the instructions Ms. Uccelli attempted this exercise.

The results of this exercise displayed 6 of the 6 possible clues.

- A lack of Smooth Pursuit in her left eye.
- A lack of Smooth Pursuit in her right eye.
- A distinct and sustained nystagmus in the left eye at maximum deviation.
- A distinct and sustained nystagmus in the right eye at maximum deviation.
- An onset of nystagmus in the left eye prior to 45 degrees.
- An onset of nystagmus in the right eye prior to 45 degrees.

The exercise further revealed the presence of vertical nystagmus. Vertical nystagmus is an indicator of high doses of alcohol, other central nervous system (CNS) depressants or inhalants, and the consumption of the drug phencyclidine (PCP).

While performing the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus exercise, it was observed that Ms. Uccelli:

- Had difficulty following and responding to instructions.
- Swayed while standing.

Walk and Turn exercise

Prior to attempting this exercise, Ms. Uccelli indicated she did not have any medical problems that would have prevented her from performing the exercise. Ms. Uccelli advised that she was able to walk a straight line. Ms. Uccelli was instructed to put her left foot on the imaginary line and her right foot in front of it with her right heel touching the toe of her left foot. She was instructed to stand in this manner with her hands to her sides until the exercise instructions were completed and the exercise demonstrated. Ms. Uccelli was instructed not to begin the exercise until told to start. She was instructed to take nine steps along the imaginary line in a heel-to-toe manner. After the ninth step she was to stop and turn around keeping her lead foot on the ground, taking several small steps with the other foot to turn around. After turning around she was to take nine steps in a heel-to-toe manner back along the line, in the direction she had come from. Ms. Uccelli was further instructed to watch her feet at all times while walking, keep her arms down to her side, and to count her steps out loud. After the exercise was demonstrated Ms. Uccelli stated she understood the instructions and was instructed to begin the exercise.

- After attempting the Walk and Turn exercise Ms. Katz displayed 3 of 8 possible clues.

Walk and Turn exercise observations:

- On the first set of steps Ms. Katz failed to walk in a heel-to-toe manner on 1,4,7,8,9 steps, - On the second set of steps Ms. Katz failed to walk in a heel-to-toe manner on 3,4,5,6,7,8,9 steps, -
- Turned incorrectly.
- Took too many steps (16 up and 16 back)

One Leg Stand exercise

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Prior to attempting this exercise, Ms. Uccelli indicated she did not have any medical problems that would have prevented her from performing the exercise. Ms. Uccelli was instructed to stand with her heels together and hands down to her sides while the instructions were given and during the exercise. Ms. Uccelli was instructed not to begin the exercise until she was instructed to start, and after the exercise had been demonstrated. When instructed to start, she was to raise the foot of her choice off the ground approximately 6 inches. While her leg was raised she was to keep her leg straight, watch her raised foot, and to count out loud by thousands (one thousand one, one thousand two, one thousand three...) and to continue the exercise until told to stop (30 seconds). After this exercise was demonstrated and indicating she understood the instructions Ms. Uccelli attempted this exercise.

When Ms. Uccelli attempted this exercise she raised her right foot.

The result of this exercise displayed 2 of the 4 possible clues.

During this exercise Ms. Katz:

- Swayed during the exercise.
- Used hands for balance

Modified Finger to Nose

I asked Ms. Uccelli to place her hands out to her side at a 45 degree angle close her palms, except her index finger. After doing so, I advised Ms. Uccelli when asked, to close her eyes and lean her head back. I will then call out left, or right (hand). Once I call out left or right hand, she was to touch the tip of her nose. Not her nostril, or bridge of her nose. Once Ms. Uccelli touched the tip of her nose, she was to return her hand to starting position (to the side at approximately 45 degrees) Ms. Uccelli advised she understood. Once started, Ms. Uccelli touched the bridge of her nose, sliding her index finger down to the tip of her nose. Also, Ms. Uccelli had to be told to return her hand to starting position.

Once I concluded the Finger to nose exercise, I asked Ms. Uccelli to perform the Modified Romberg Balance.

I then demonstrated to Ms. Uccelli the Modified Romberg Balance exercise. I advised Ms. Uccelli when asked to begin, to stand with her feet together, keep her hands down by her side, lean her head back and close her eyes. After doing so, Ms. Uccelli was instructed to estimate the passage of 30 seconds in Ms. Uccelli head without counting out loud, and when finished to open her eyes, bring her head back to a neutral position and say done. Ms. Uccelli advised she understood. Ms. Uccelli then began the exercise. Ms. Uccelli advised she was done at 23 seconds.

After I completed SFSE observations on Ms. Uccelli, I then placed Ms. Uccelli under arrest for suspected DUI of alcohol. I then escorted Ms. Uccelli to the rear of my patrol vehicle and secured her in. I then waited approximately 45 minutes for the tow truck to arrive. Moments later, I departed the scene enroute to the Palm Beach County Jail. Upon arrival at the jail, I escorted Ms. Uccelli to the BAT center. There, I conducted a 20 minute observation period of Ms. Uccelli. Once the 20 minutes were up, I escorted Ms. Uccelli into the BAT room. Once there, I requested Ms. Uccelli to submit to a lawful test of her breath for the purpose of determining its alcohol content. Ms. Uccelli agreed to submit. Ms. Uccelli provided an adequate breath sample of .079 another breath sample of .075. I then advised Ms. Uccelli of her Constitutional Rights. After doing so, Ms. Uccelli advised she understood. No Q&A was conducted. Ms. Uccelli was booked into the Palm Beach County jail on 316.193.1 Florida Statue Misdemeanor. All events occurred in Palm Beach County.

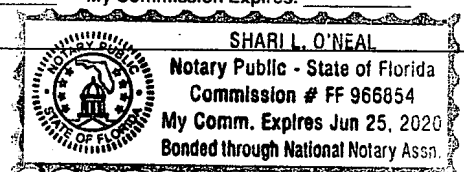

Refusal to submit to the test I have requested of you is admissible into evidence in any criminal proceeding.
