On Thursday, May 31, 2018 at approximately 2355 hours, I was dispatched to Northlake Avenue and 140th Ave North, Loxahatchee (Palm Beach County) Florida to assist Deputy Albert Tejada with a traffic stop that involved a possible drunk driver. Upon my arrival I noticed D/S Tejad's patrol car stopped behind a black vehicle on the south shoulder of the roadway. His emergency lights were activated. D/S Gina Brown was also on scene as a back up officer. I met with D/S Tejada who told me the following regarding this incident: On Thursday May 31st, 2018, while on patrol near the; NORTHLAKE BLVD/140TH AVE N PBC, I noticed a black in color Dodge Charger (FL Tag 3360XQ) decreasing in speed to a stop on a posted 55 MPH zone. This area is extremely dark with no lighting. The vehicle pulled over to the south shoulder of the roadway and came to a stop. I initiated my emergency lights and stopped directly behind the vehicle. I approached the vehicle on the passenger side (r/h side) and made contact with the driver; Anabel Garrido Rojas W/M DOB 02/06/1969. As he lowered the window I detected the smell of an unknown alcoholic beverage and then saw a six pack of beer with 2 bottles missing inside a white plastic bag on the front passenger side floor of the vehicle. Later I determined those beers to be, PREDIDENTE. I asked Anabel why he slowed down and pulled over and he explained he was lost. I went to the driver's side of the vehicle to try and better understand Anabel, his speech was slurred. While speaking with Anabel I suspected him to be drinking an unspecified amount of unknown alcoholic beverages. I asked that a DUI Unit to respond to my location to assess the driver for DUI. Due to a possible language barrier for the DUI investigator I further assisted with translation (Spanish). During the roadside tasks Anabel began to have a conversation with me in Spanish, reference him needing a cane to walk and balance. I asked Anabel when was the last time he saw his cane, since he specified it was not in his vehicle. Anabel did not remember the last time he saw the cane. Anabel continued to converse with me reference having illnesses to which he could not remain balanced. Anabel stated in Spanish; "Estoy enfermo, man! por eso no tengo balance". Note: Prior to stepping out of the vehicle, Anabel was asked about his medical health and/or if he takes any type of medication. Anabel clearly stated that he was not on any kind of medication or that he had any medical issues: D/S Tejada wrote a sworn witness statement on a probable cause affidavit.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I made contact with the driver who was currently sitting in the driver seat of the previously mentioned vehicle. D/S Tejeda assisted with translation. The driver was later identified as Anabel Garrido Rojas by his Florida driver license. During my interview I noticed the driver's eyes were red, watery and glossy. His cheeks were flushed and mouth was dry. I could smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from the inside of the vehicle. I told the driver I had a suspicion that he had been drinking an unspecified amount of alcoholic beverages. I later discovered a six pack of Presidente beer lying on the passenger side floor board. Two of which were missing from the container. The existing beers had condensation on the outside of the bottles and cold to the touch. I asked if he would consent to performing Standardized Field Sobriety Evaluations (SFSTs) for the purpose of determining if he was impaired while operating a motor vehicle. He consented to performing the SFSTs. Prior to exiting the vehicle I asked if they had any physical problems with their body that would inhibit them from performing light physical movements. I also asked if they were on medication. The defendant said he has a problem with his voice. He told us he was not taking medication, however. I asked him to exit the vehicle. I escorted him to a smooth and level surface that was free from obstructions and debris. The area was well lit by the lights from my patrol car. The defendant was asked to identify the white edge line on the roadway. He successfully did so by placing his feet on the line when requested. I could not smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath that intensified when he spoke. The following SFSTs were explained, demonstrated, translated and acknowledged by him prior to his performance: HGN, The Walk and Turn, The One Leg Stand, The Finger to Nose and The Romberg Alphabet Recitation (Spanish). His deficiencies were recorded on another form on this worksheet. At the conclusion of the SFSTs, coupled with the deputy's observation of the defendant's vehicle in motion and my observation of personal indicators of impairment exhibited by the defendant, probable cause was established for DUI. The defendant was searched and handcuffed (double locked and checked for tightness) prior to being seated into the rear of my patrol car. Subsequent to a search I observed two (2) receipts from the Cater Shack located at 5088 Seminole Pratt and Whitney Rd. The receipts were dated for 05/31/2018 and time stamped 2321 and 2325 hours. Two purchases were made for doubles on Jack Daniels.

Subject said he had one beer and then admitting to drinking two

STRONG ODOR OF AN UNKNOWN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE COMING FROM SUBJECT'S BREATH.

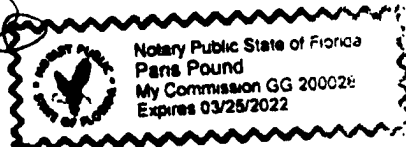

Other Observations:

Subject was asked to stand with their feet together and place their hands by their side. They were asked to focus on the stimulus and follow it with their eyes. Lastly they were told not to move their head to assist in following the stimulus with their eyes. Subject showed equal pupil size that tracked equally. Both eyes lacked a smooth pursuit. I saw distinct and sustained Nystagmus at maximum deviation. I also saw an onset of Nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. Subject swayed while performing this task.

WALK & TURN:

THE DEFENDANT WAS PLACED IN THE INSTRUCTIONAL STANCE FOR THE WALK AND TURN. THIS TASK WAS EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED TO THE DEFENDANT. THE DEFENDANT ACKNOWLEDGED THE INSTRUCTIONS PRIOR TO PERFORMING THIS TASK: Subject was unable to maintain his balance while placed in the instructional position. He swayed and ultimately abandoned the position. He attempted the task too soon. During the task subject did not touch heel to toe. He stepped off the line. Could not maintain his balance while walking on the line. Turned improperly and took incorrect number of steps.

ONE LEG STAND:

THE DEFENDANT WAS PLACED IN THE INSTRUCTIONAL STANCE FOR THE ONE LEG STAND. THIS TASK WAS EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED TO THE DEFENDANT. THE DEFENDANT ACKNOWLEDGED THE INSTRUCTIONS PRIOR TO PERFORMING THIS TASK: Subject said he needed the use of his cane. During the task subject was unable to maintain his balance while his leg/foot was elevated. He hopped and leaned. He dropped his foot on the pavement twice.

FINGER TO NOSE:

THE DEFENDANT WAS PLACED IN THE INSTRUCTIONAL STANCE FOR THE FINGER TO NOSE. THIS TASK WAS EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED TO THE DEFENDANT. THE DEFENDANT ACKNOWLEDGED THE INSTRUCTIONS PRIOR TO PERFORMING THIS TASK: Subject swayed during this task. He did not keep his eyes closed as instructed. He failed to touch the tip of his finger to the tip of his nose on all six attempts. Rather he touched the sides of his nostrils and underneath his nose. He flinched on one occasion.

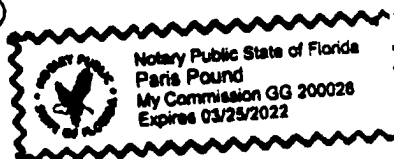
