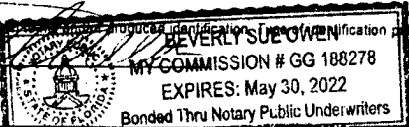

On Monday, September 23, 2019 at approximately 2039 hours, I responded to the Target parking lot, located at 10155 Okeechobee Boulevard, West Palm Beach (Palm Beach County) Florida to assist Deputy A. Tejada with a "hit and run" traffic crash with a possible impaired driver. While en route to this location I was advised to meet the deputies on the east side of the parking lot. Upon my arrival I noticed four Palm Beach County cruisers on scene. A dark pick up truck was stopped and occupying several parking spaces facing south. Deputies J. Vasquez and R. Smith were standing with a white male who was outside the truck. This subject was agitated and appeared to have been drinking. Another pick up truck was pulled into a parking space facing west. D/S Tejada was standing by his cruiser with a white female subject. I met with D/S Tejada who told me he was working a traffic crash that involved both pick up trucks. He located the crash scene at US 441 Ext. about 1.5 miles south of Orange Grove Bv. The pick up left the scene and drove to our present location. D/S Tejada directed me to the driver of the pick up that was struck on its rear side. I met with the driver who identified himself as Johnny Bermudez. Bermudez told me he was traveling south on US 441 Ext. when he was flashed several times by the vehicle behind him. Moments later he said the vehicle stuck his vehicle in the back. He reported the vehicle lost control after hitting him in the back and also hit a curve warning sign. He watched it drive into the northbound lanes and nearly strike an oncoming vehicle. It continued south and turned into the Target parking lot. He watched a female exit the vehicle. He described her as wearing pink bikini top. The passenger, who is the subject being watched by the deputies, spoke with him and told him not to call the police. Bermudez told him he was calling the police. He watched the vehicle leave with the white subject driving, only to return moments later. I met with the passenger who identified himself as David Vincent. I told him I was assisting with the "hit and run" crash where the female subject was seen as the driver. Vincent told me he did ask the driver of the other vehicle to allow him to take care of the damages. I also made contact with the driver who was standing next to D/S Tejada's patrol car. She was later identified as Andrea Vincent through the Driver and Vehicle Information Database. I explained to them D/S Tejada located a crash scene on US 441 where evidence of a vehicle leaving the roadway struck a sign. Additionally the driver of the vehicle that was struck witnessed their vehicle lose control after impact and left the roadway. He also saw it hit the sign. During my interview I noticed her eyes were red, watery and glossy. Her cheeks were flushed and her mouth was dry. She was unsteady while standing and stood with her feet more than shoulder width apart. She was wearing blue jean shorts, camouflage sweater with a pink bikini underneath, and brown sandals.

I could smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from her breath. I told the driver I had completed my assistance with the crash investigation. Moreover I told he I would be conducting a criminal investigation for DUI. I explained my suspicion was prompt from the previous mentioned indicators of impairment she exhibited after being witnessed as the person driving the vehicle after the crash. I asked if she needed medical assistance. I asked if she had any previous physical problems with her body and if she was taking medication. She told me she is not injured from the crash and does not have prior physical problems. She takes medicine for anxiety. I asked if she would consent to performing Standardized Field Sobriety Evaluations (SFSTs) for the purpose of determining if she was impaired while operating a motor vehicle. David ordered her not to do anything. She also said she was not doing anything. I asked David to wait by his vehicle and not to interfere with the criminal investigation. He walked toward his truck. D/S Tejada explained Taylor Warning informing the defendant that the SFSTs were voluntary and she did not have to perform them, however in the absence of her performance I would be only left with the physical evidence of impairment before me which could be strong basis for her being placed under arrest for DUI. She said she has a lawyer and was not doing anything. Based on the defendant being identified as the driver after the crash, coupled with the property damage that occurred to the sign and rear of the other driver's vehicle and my observation of personal indicators of impairment exhibited by the defendant, probable cause was established for DUI with property damage. I told the defendant she was being placed under lawful arrest for DUI with property damage. Deputy C. Miller assisted the defendant with changing to a pull over shirt. D/S Miller searched and handcuffed the defendant (double locked and checked for tightness) prior to seating her into the rear of my patrol car. David took custody of her personal effects. Afterward I transported her to the Good Samaritan Medical Center Emergency room for clearance. The defendant was treated and released back to my custody. I began transport to the main jail breath analysis facility for further processing. Upon our arrival I escorted the defendant into the facility and began a 20 minute observation period. During this time the defendant did not ingest anything into her body orally or otherwise. Neither did she regurgitate. I escorted her into the testing room and asked her to provide breath samples for the purpose of determining her alcohol content. She refused. Implied consent was read to her. When asked if she understood the consent she asked for her lawyer. She repeated this request. Since she was not cooperating I deemed her a "refusal". No Q&A was performed because of her invoking her "rights". The defendant was additionally cited for leaving the scene with property damage. She was booked into the main jail without incident.

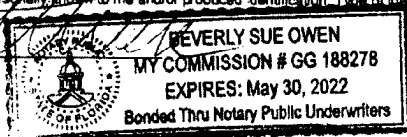

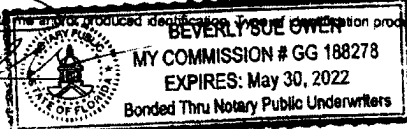
