The following incident occurred in the City of Riviera Beach, Florida:							
On Sunday, November 05, 2017 at approximately 10:49pm, I responded to the Riviera Beach City Marina located at 190 East 13th Street in reference to a domestic disturbance. Sgt. Menard (ID #5572) advised Riviera Beach Dispatch that a white male and white female were having a domestic dispute. Upon my arrival, I made contact with Sgt. Menard who was working an off-duty detail at the location who advised of the following to me which is a summary and not to be taken as verbatim:							
Shortly before notifying Riviera Beach Dispatch that he was inside of Newcomb Hall (190 East 13th Street) near the south side of the building when he heard shouting from outside of the building. He observed a white male and a white female arguing. Sgt. Menard stated that the female was trying to walk away from the male and he observed the white male run up to her and grab her with both arms in an attempt to stop her. The argument ensued and Sgt. Menard observed the male forcefully push the female, causing her to fall to the ground.							
I then made contact with the male, identified as Andrew Skowronek (11/03/1978), and female, [REDACTED] (02/18/1978), on the southwest corner of the building. Both parties were immediately separated and advised to me that no physical assault occurred and they were arguing over [REDACTED] issues. Neither Andrew nor [REDACTED] showed any signs of injuries. It should be noted that Andrew and [REDACTED] have been [REDACTED]. Andrew later stated to me that he grabbed [REDACTED] in an attempt to stop her from walking away from him.							
Based on the observed activity from Sgt. Menard and the above investigation, Andrew Skowronek (11/03/1978) was placed under arrest for one (1) count of Simple Battery (Domestic) pursuant to F.S.S. 784.03(1). After I affected the arrest, both parties became uncooperative. Andrew was transported to RBPD for processing and taken to the PB County Jail.
