Sayih activated his emergency lights and stopped behind the crashed vehicle facing north. Tpr. Sayih exited his patrol vehicle and checked on the passenger's for injuries. Tpr. Sayih moved the occupants to the East grass shoulder for safety. Tpr. Sayih set up some flares in the right lanes to alert approaching traffic. When trooper Sayih returned to his patrol vehicle for another flare he was standing at the rear of his patrol vehicle. Tpr. Sayih heard squealing Tires noises coming from behind him. The vehicle struck Tpr. Sayih knocking him to the ground and then striking his patrol vehicle. This caused his patrol vehicle to roll forward and strike the first crashed vehicle that was stuck in the roadway. The vehicle that struck Tpr. Sayih rolled forward and came to final rest north of his patrol vehicle in the middle lane facing north.

Tpr. Sayih got up from the ground and went to the suspect vehicle that rear-ended his vehicle. He checked on the condition of the driver and advised me that the driver is possibly impaired.

I responded to the scene and met with Tpr. Aime who was also on scene by this point. Tpr. Aime also advised me that he spoke with the driver and it appeared that he was impaired. I conducted my crash investigation and spoke with the driver of the suspect vehicle. While talking with him and obtaining his statement regarding the crash he commented that he had been drinking and was very apologetic for crashing into the Trooper. Upon completing my crash investigation I advised the suspect driver who was identified as Andrew Boisvert by his Florida License that I had completed my crash investigation and now I was going to be conducting a possible DUI investigation. Boisvert advised me that he had been drinking. I asked Boisvert if he would submit to Field Sobriety Exercises and he agreed to perform the exercises. Mr. Boisvert advised me there was no need for the test as he was drunk. I then advised Boisvert that I would still like to check him to see if he was to be impaired to be operating a vehicle. Boisvert advised me that he would do anything we asked. I read Boisvert his Constitutional Warnings and asked if he understood his rights. Boisvert advised he understood. I then began the Field Sobriety Exercises.

I first checked his eyes for Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus and observed that he had lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes and that he had distinct jerking of the eyes at maximum deviation and he also showed onset of jerking of the eyes prior to 45 degrees.

I then moved on to the next task which was the Walk and Turn Exercise. I explained how to perform this task and demonstrated the task. Boisvert was unable to touch heel to toe on several steps down the line and back. He miss counted and turn incorrectly. Boisvert commented on how difficult the task was by saying "wow this is hard when you've been drinking".

The last exercise that I asked Boisvert to perform was the One-Leg Stand. I again demonstrated and explained this exercise. Boisvert attempted the exercise and lost his balance several times and had to put his foot down several times.

Boisvert failed to perform the task correctly and I then placed Boisvert under arrest for DUI. Boisvert crashed at 01:56am and was arrested for DUI at 03:57am. Boisvert was transported to the Jail and provided 2 breath samples, the first was collected at 05:18am and gave a reading of 0.068, the second was collected at 05:21am and gave a reading of 0.062. Both samples were collected approximately 3 hours after the crash.

Boisvert was transported to Wellington Medical Center where he was cleared and returned to the Palm Beach County Jail for booking.

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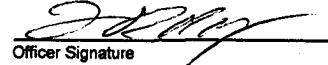

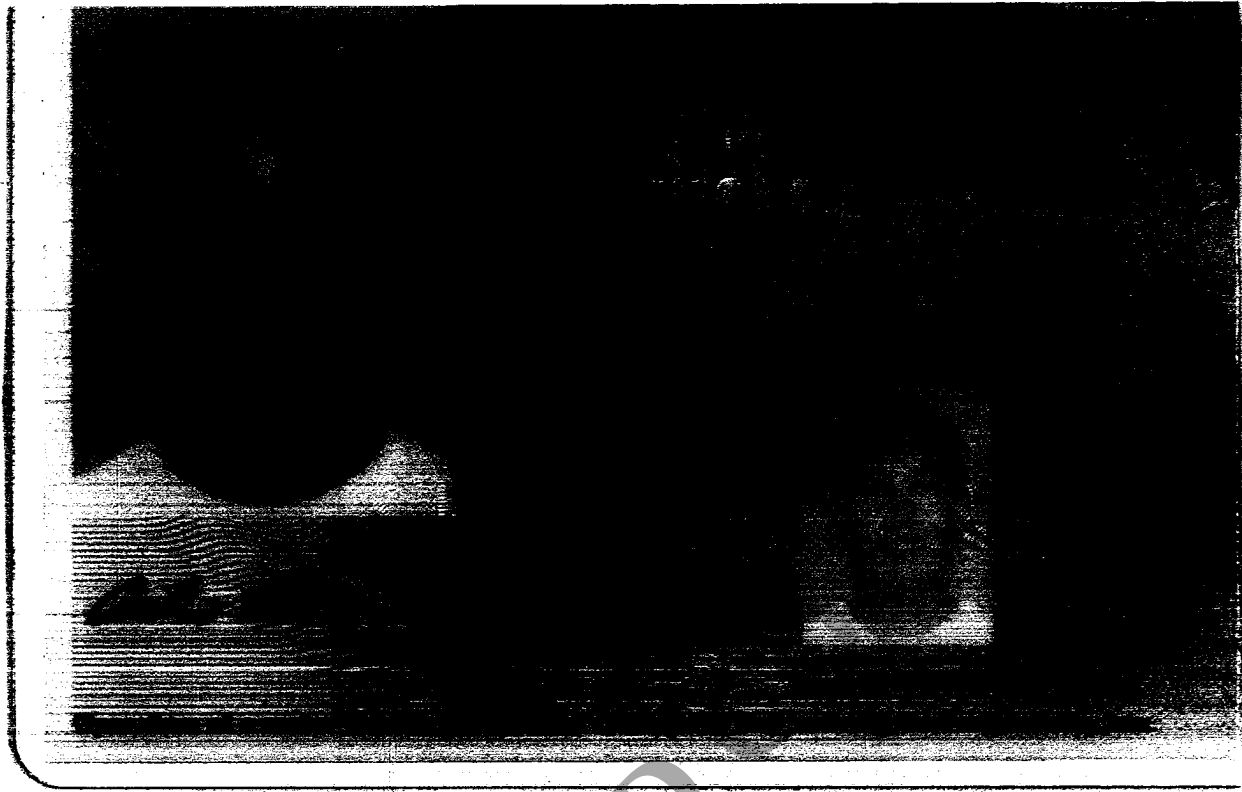
