On 07/28/2017 at approximately 6:28p.m., I was in service in Palm Beach County, Florida. I was traveling northbound on Interstate 95 (State Road 9) south of Woolbright Road when a Be On the Look Out (BOLO) was issued through the Florida Highway Patrol (FHP) Communication Center for a White in color newer model BMW SUV failing to maintain lane and almost hitting other vehicle. As I was traveling northbound on Interstate 95 (State Road 9) I observed a vehicle matching the description of the vehicle in the far right lane just south of Gateway Boulevard with the driver unable to maintain her lane. I then got behind the vehicle and began to follow the vehicle to establish a driving pattern. While driving behind the vehicle just north of gateway the vehicle began to drive off of the roadway and into the right paved shoulder where it almost collided with the concrete barrier wall (see FL UTC A7PRLYE). I then continued to follow the vehicle to 10th Ave N, throughout that driving period, the driver failed to maintain her lane multiple times obstructing other passing motorist. As the driver approached the intersection 10th Avenue North and northbound Interstate 95 (State Road 9) exit ramp. The vehicle was in the outside turn lane to travel westbound on 10th Avenue North (Left Turn Only Lane, see Florida UTC A7PRM0E). When the traffic signal turned green the driver made an improper right turn to travel east bound on 10th Ave North (See in-car video). After establishing what I felt to be sufficient probable cause to conduct a traffic stop. I continued to follow the vehicle eastbound on 10th Avenue North to establish a safe location to conduct my traffic stop. As the driver and myself approached Dixie Highway, I noticed a Walgreens parking lot on the north side of the roadway. I then activated my emergency lights and siren prior to passing the Walgreens driveway entrance. The driver continued to slowly drive eastbound on 10th Ave N stopping approximately 10 feet prior to the stop bar.

As I exited my patrol vehicle the driver also exited her vehicle from the driver side in a careful like fashion using the driver side of the vehicle for support. I observed that the driver was wearing a cast on her left foot and appeared to have a slight limp. I also observed that the driver had bloodshot and glassy eyes. While talking with the driver I noticed that the driver had a front to back sway as well as orbital. I then instructed the driver to enter back into her vehicle for her safety to be away from traffic. The driver looked at me appearing to be confused and reluctant to enter back into her vehicle. When the driver entered back into her vehicle I asked her where she was going to which she stated she was going home.

Upon talking to the driver, I asked the driver where home was, she stated that she lives in the Weston, located in Broward County, Florida. When I asked the driver where she was coming from, she stated she was coming from Hollywood, also located in Broward County, Florida. I then asked the driver, based off of my observation, if she would be willing to perform roadside exercises to check for impairment and the driver agreed.

No obvious odors of unknown alcoholic beverages. Subject was having a difficult time keeping head still during task. I also observed that the driver had bloodshot and glassy eyes. Subject had equal tracking and equal pupil size.

Driver did agree to perform roadside exercises on scene. Based off of the totality of the circumstances I believed that there was enough probable cause for arrest. Driver was then arrested and advised on scene that she was being arrested for Driving under the influence. I then placed the passenger in hand restraints, which I secured and double locked, for his safety and mine. The vehicle was then secured by the other assisting officers.

The Driver was identified by her Florida Photo Driver's License as ANGELA MARIA URREA and was ran through FCIC/NCIC and was clear of any warrants. The white BMW SUV with TAG# HWRD09 was also ran through FCIC/NCIC and was not missing or stolen.

This incident occurred in Palm Beach County, Florida.

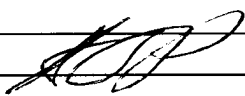

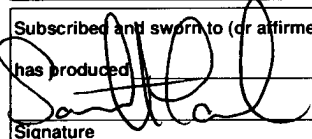

-Subject was having a difficult time keeping head still during task. I also observed that the driver had bloodshot and glassy eyes. Subject had equal tracking and equal pupil size.

WALK & TURN:

Subject advised that although her foot was in a cast she would be willing to try and felt that she would be able to conduct exercise and the cast did not really affect her too much. Subject could not keep balance while listening to instructions and came out of starting position. Subject started too soon before I finished giving instructions. Subject walked with a normal gate missing heel to toe on the majority of steps. Subject stepped off line multiple times and upon returning down the line, missed the line with right foot for majority of exercise. Subject did not turn as instructed. Subject took an incorrect number of steps, 10 steps going down line and 12 steps on return and stated that was more than 9 steps. Subject also used arms for balance. The subject conducted the exercise two times.

ONE LEG STAND:

Subject advised that she would have some difficulty performing this exercise on either foot do to her having on a cast but would try the exercise anyway. Subject started before told to do so. Subject also used her arms for balance. Subject also hopped on foot on the ground. Subject swayed during exercise and put foot down multiple times during exercise. The subject then began to complain that she was experiencing pain after attempting exercise with both legs.

FINGER TO NOSE:

This task was conducted due to the fact that the subject was complaining of experiencing pain in her leg. The subject did not keep her eyes closed throughout exercise, opened eyes after approximately 15 seconds. The subject also did not return her arms back to her side each time instructed which finger to raise. Subject touched the pad of her finger to the tip of her nose, not the tip of the finger to tip of the nose as instructed. Subject became agitated during this exercise and stated she did not care and began before instructed. Subject started multiple times before instructed to begin.

Subject did not keep eyes closed throughout exercise, opened eyes at approximately 15 seconds. Subject also swayed throughout exercise.
