## NARRATIVE:

On Monday June 11, 2018 at 0920 hours, Deputy Duttenhoeffer #6387 responded to the District 7 Lobby, located at 17901 South State Road 7, unincorporated Boca Raton FL, 33498 in reference to a delayed theft. Upon arrival, he met with complainant/victim Wesley Sheperd, who stated someone has stolen several pieces of jewelry from his store.

Wesley stated he owns of a jewelry booth at the Jewelry Exchange store, located at 8221 Glades Road, unincorporated Boca Raton FL, 33434. Wesley stated on Thursday June 7, 2018, he discovered the jewelry, mentioned in the crime property section, was missing. Wesley said he and his wife last saw the jewelry on Wednesday June 5, 2018, while they were closing their booth for the day. Wesley said the jewelry was last seen on a tray and sitting on top of the booth counter. Wesley said his booth is located near the front entrance of the store. Wesley said he believes while they were closing their booth and securing other trays of jewelry, someone possibly walked out of the Jewelry Exchange store, with the tray of jewelry.

Wesley said he notified management of the incident and he was told the surveillance video at the Jewelry Exchange store was not working last week and there is no video of this alleged incident. Wesley said other booth tenants at the store did not observe anything as well. Wesley said the jewelry taken amounted to \$110,670.00 dollars. Wesley completed a sworn written statement and he is willing to testify in court and prosecute. Wesley provided Deputy Duttenhoeffer with photographs and appraisals for

all the jewelry, which he stated was stolen. A property receipt was completed and the previously mentioned items were placed into evidence.

On June 12, 2018 this case was assigned to me for criminal investigation. On June 27, 2018 I left a message for victim, Wesley Sheperd to return my call. Since I am familiar with this case which is similar to a previous theft incident, I checked the pawn system in reference to Anthony Bedoyan with no success. The previous case number is 17-051826 and there was \$435,402.30 in stolen jewelry.

On July 11, 2018 I left a message for Sheperd to return my call.

On July 17, 2018 I spoke to Sheperd whose back from vacation and he said Bedoyan is working upstairs with his brother-in-law. He said he is a setter and has been doing so while working for him. He does not believe his jewelry is upstairs. I told him I will make an attempt to talk to him. He also said that Bedoyan quit right after the incident.

On August 3, 2018 I spoke to Sheperd and he said he spotted his stolen jewelry with another vendor at the Jewelry Exchange. He confronted him and told him he knows it is his jewelry and he has documentation for the jewelry. The vendor told him that he bought the jewelry from the Anthony the guy that was working for him. I contacted Deputy Martinez #7501 and explained the case to him. He said he will make contact with Shepperd, get a statement from the vendor with the stolen jewelry and advised him not to sell the jewelry.

On Saturday August 04, 2018 at approximately 1050 hours Deputy Martinez #7501 responded to the Jewelry Exchange located at 8221 Glades Road, Boca Raton, Florida, in reference to supplementing this case. He met with Mr. Sheperd who stated one of the other vendors who are his friend had some of the jewelry that was stolen from him. He said that his friend, identified as Zare Kantarjian, would sell him his items back but, would not give them back. Deputy Martinez made contact with Mr. Kantarjian who brought out a bag from his safe with eight individually packed jewelry items which Mr. Sheperd identified as his jewelry. Mr. Kantarjian completed a sworn written statement. He said that last year he purchased the jewelry from an Anthony Bedovan. who used to work for Mr. Sheperd. He paid between \$8,000 to \$10,000 for the jewelry. Mr. Kantarjian said he did not know the items were stolen and would have not bought them if he knew. I advised him to put a hold on the jewelry and that Det. Woodie would come in to speak to him this week in reference to the items in which he stated he understood. Mr. Sheperd was advised to go to the courthouse and get a writ for his items. Deputy Engel #9576 took photographs of the jewelry. The memory card was placed into PBSO evidence.

## NARRATIVE CONTINUATION

Post Miranda interview, Bedoyan did not admit to stealing jewelry from Wesley Sheperd Jewelry. He said he designed jewelry exactly like the jewelry Sheperd has identified as his jewelry.

Based on the above investigation probable cause exists for the arrest of Anthony Bedoyan who is in violation of FSS 812.014 (2)a1, Grand Theft and FSS 812.019, Dealing in Stolen Property.
