I responded to 1690 Renaissance Commons Boulevard #1225, Boynton Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida 33436 in reference to a dating dispute. BBPD Communications received a phone call from the complainant, George Kleier, advising that his ex-girlfriend whom he dated for four (4) years, April Gnoinsky, (never resided together) was kicking his residence door and screaming. BBPD Communications personnel was able to overhear the yells made by April.

Upon arrival, April had departed from the premises into an unknown direction of travel. A canvas of the parking garage and surrounding units was conducted in an attempt to locate April, met with negative results.

Furthermore, contact was made with George who was within his residence unable to open the door because it had been damaged by April. A visual inspection of the door yielded several dents, black in color residue, and the bottom locking component was non-functional and stuck in the activated position (Total Estimated Value Loss: \$900.00 USD).



According to George, he and April ended their intimate relationship approximately two (2) months ago; however, April has continued to badger George with numerous phone calls and text messages. Tonight; however, upon hearing loud banging on his door, he looked through the peephole, at which time he observed April screaming profanities and demanding entry. When George refused, she continued to kick the door before departing from the premises.

Contact was then made with neighbor, Stephen Denavea, who witnessed the above incident. Stephen advised that he opened his front door when he heard loud knocking and yelling coming from the general area of his front door. At this time he observed a W/F wearing a pink blouse and white pants, who he later identified as April, kicking the front door of George's residence. Both Stephen and George completed sworn audio statements with my BWC attesting to the above incident.

Let it be noted George's two (2) vehicles were parked within a nearby parking garage. Upon observing George's silver 2011 BMW sedan bearing temporary tag CFT3729 there appeared to be paint transfer (black) on the rear center bumper, possibly from another vehicle making contact with it (Total Estimated Value Loss: \$1,000.00). Additionally, George's white 2012 BMW SUV bearing Florida tag WJC7G had similar damage, to include a scratch causing paint elimination on the rear bumper (Total Estimated Value Loss: \$1,000.00). Let it be noted neither George or Stephen witnessed April damage either vehicle. Additionally, George last observed his vehicles unscathed at approximately 0000 hours on today's date.

I attempted to make phone contact with April several times, met with negative results. A voicemail with my name and contact information was provided.



On 08/26/2018 at approximately 1900 hours I made contact with April within the BBPD lobby, at which time an interview was conducted. Post Miranda, April advised that during the aforementioned incident she was so enraged that she did in fact kick George's front door causing damage. Upon leaving the parking garage April was still ill-tempered therefore she drove a vehicle recklessly in the direction of George's two (2) BMW vehicles causing damage to the rear bumper of each. (Total Estimated Value Loss: \$2,000.00 USD). April's statement was captured on my department issued BWC.

In conclusion, based upon April's statement, as well as George and Stephen's observation's, I have Probable Cause to arrest and charge April Shantel Gnoinsky with 1F count of Criminal Mischief in violation of F.S.S. 806.13.1B3 as she willfully and maliciously damaged George's front door and motor vehicles (Over \$1,000.00 USD). April was placed into handcuffs, checked for tightness and double-locked, and transported to BBPD for processing before later being turned over to the care, custody, and control of the Palm Beach County Jail.
