Probable Cause

Defendant was driving southbound on SR-9 / I-95, entering from SR-706 / Indiantown RD in Palm Beach County. She was driving her dark blue 2014 Cadillac SUV, FL tag ESQK21. I was on the mainline and noticed defendant passing a car at a high rate of speed while still on the entrance ramp. The roadway was wet from earlier rain. Defendant continued to accelerate and swerved to the right center, then center lane without signal. She continued to accelerate, and was clocked by radar at 100 (posted 70) before I lost the signal to the car she passed. Defendant mover to the left center lane and slowed slightly again, then accelerated to 114 mph (FHP1437), then drifted / changed to the center lane. Defendant stopped for my emergency lights on the right shoulder without issue.

I approached the passenger side of the car. There was a passenger (later identified by PE ID as Nima Michael Traynham). I could smell a strong odor of alcoholic impurities coming from the car.

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defendant why I stopped her, and asked her why she was so fast, and she looked astounded and began to visually look around the passenger compartment of the car. Her eyes were bloodshot and watery. I asked for her DL and she said that's what she was looking for. There were two purses on the passenger side front floor, she said she does not carry a purse. Defendant said she was out with her friend all night and was just trying to get home.

I had Defendant come out of the car so I could determine if the odor was from her or the passenger. She looked at me, so I repeated my request. Defendant stepped out of the car and stood next to the travel lane. I noticed she was barefooted. I told her to get away from traffic, and escorted her to the rear of her car. I told her to stand behind her car and not move, so I could move my car to better facilitate FSEs. As I was getting into my car Defendant began to walk toward the passenger side of her car. I told her in a loud voice to stop and not move. She said "I'm not moving" as she continued to move, so I told her again not to move.

When I walked back to Defendant I could still smell the odor of alcoholic impurities. I asked her how much she'd had to drink and she said she didn't know. I told defendant I wanted her to perform some exercises to determine her ability to drive. She would not give me a direct answer at first, and said she just wanted to go home. Defendant finally agreed to perform FSEs. She said had no physical defects and was not using any medication or drugs. I asked if she had shoes, and she said with four inch heels. After insuring there was no debris or injurious substance on the shoulder, I opted to continue without shoes.

FSEs were performed on the shoulder as follows:

HGN: noticeable orbital sway when standing, Lack of smooth pursuit, onset prior to 45 degrees and very distinct at maximum deviation in both eyes.

W&T: Did not maintain balance during instructions, stepped to the left and rear with left foot. Re-assumed the starting position then ignored my asking if she understood, and began to walk, even as I told her to stop. Only first step was heel-toe, weaving to both sides as she walked. Was on step 17 when I stopped her, then pivoted on both feet and stopped. I told her to walk back, she took two normal strides and I reminded her "heel-toe". She then took 13 steps, approximately 6-8" before I told her to stop again.

OLS: Raised right foot while I was still giving instructions. I told her to put it down until I finished, and she said she was practicing. Otherwise performed.

Based upon my training (I am a DUI instructor) and 34 years of experience, I considered her driving pattern, extreme speed, the odor of alcoholic impurities, bloodshot watery eyes, inability to follow instructions and performance on FSEs, I concluded that Defendant was under the influence of alcoholic beverages. I secured her in handcuffs and placed her in my car.

I spoke to the passenger, who had also been drinking, and had no DL. I had her make arrangements for a ride, and spoke to her boyfriend to give him driving instructions. North County towing was dispatched by rotation for the car.

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When I got back in the car I noticed the front passenger window was partially lowered, and there was sand on the mechanism. I said something to Defendant about reaching up with her dirty feet to lower the window, and she said "I might have". While I completed the speeding citation and Information Sheet for the BAT, Defendant kept arguing her innocence. She asked if I had a body camera, and kept saying she passed my tests.

Trooper Sendziak arrived and waited for the tow truck & ride for the passenger. I transported Defendant to the PBSO BAT. When we arrived at the BAT I conducted a required 20 minute observation, then went to the test room with PBSO DUI Tech P. Pound. I asked Defendant if she would take a breath test and she refused. I read Implied Consent, and she verbally refused to submit. I then read her Constitutional Warning, and Defendant refused to answer questions.





I requested that the driver submit to a breath and/or urine test to determine his or her blood alcohol level and/or the presence of chemical or controlled substances. I informed the driver that the refusal to submit to such test(s) would result in the suspension of his or her driving privilege for a period of one (1) year for a first refusal, or for a period of eighteen (18) months if his or her driving privilege had been previously suspended for refusing to submit to a breath, urine or blood test. I also informed the driver that he or she commits a misdemeanor by refusing to submit to a lawful test as requested above if his or her driving privilege has been previously suspended for refusal to submit to a lawful test of his or her breath, urine, or blood. Additionally, I informed the driver that if he or she holds a CDL, or was operating a CMV, refusal will result in the disqualification of the Commercial Driver's License/driving privilege for a period of one (1) year in the case of a first refusal or permanently if he or she has previously been disqualified as a result of a refusal to submit to any such lawful test. Nonetheless, the driver refused to submit to the test(s) requested.
