


On the above date & time while conducting a traffic stop at the intersection of West Atlantic Blvd and Lyons Road which is located in unincorporated Delray Beach, Palm Beach County, I observed a white Kia traveling in lane two(2) westbound in my lane quickly approaching my marked PBSO patrol car which had its emergency lights activated. This white Kia almost rear ended my patrol vehicle coming to an abrupt stop. The driver, a W/F who was later identified by her Florida driver license as "BETH ABRAMSON GOLDEN" pulled out from behind my vehicle and up along side looking directly at me with a blank stare. The driver and sole occupant then drove off, continuing westbound. I gave the driver of the initial stop his paperwork back and elected to initiate a traffic stop on the white Kia Optima bearing Florida tag JZE-F76. The Kia would drive side to side within its lane and come into contact with the fog line numerous times. I elected to initiate a traffic stop by activating the emergency lights on my vehicle getting the Kia to yield near the intersection of West Atlantic Blvd and South State Road 7.

Upon making contact with the driver, I immediately detected an obvious and strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from her person and face area. This odor intensified as I spoke to Golden. Golden had glassy, glazed, and blood shot eyes. Golden's speech was slurred, slow, thick, and at times difficult to understand. Golden's movements were slow and deliberate, and lethargic with poor coordination. Golden was wearing a print dress and no shoes. All the clothing appeared neat. With Golden showing articulable sign of impairment, Investigator P. Zeitz was requested to the scene to conduct a DUI assessment.

The report is for supplemental purposes only and this ends my involvement in this case.

D.U.I. PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On 11/8/18 at approximately hrs, I was called to the scene of a traffic stop near the intersection of Atlantic Ave and SR 7, which is located in unincorporated Delray Beach within Palm Beach County, Florida. I arrived at the scene at approximately 2330hrs. Inv. Schaefer #8777 relayed to me, and completed a written signed sworn supplemental Probable Cause Affidavit, that he had stopped the defendant's vehicle, a white Kia bearing FL tag JZEF76, because the defendant almost struck his marked patrol vehicle while on a traffic stop. Inv. Schaefer stated that he had his red and blue emergency lights activated and the white Kia still almost rear-ended his vehicle. The white car then pulled up next to him and the driver stared at him with a blank stare. The vehicle continued Westbound while driving side to side within the lane coming in contact with the fog line numerous times. Inv. Schaefer initiated a traffic stop on the Kia and identified the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle as W/F Beth Abramson Golden by her Florida driver's license. Inv. Schaefer observed articulable signs of impairment while making contact with Golden. At that time, he requested I come to the scene to conduct further investigation and assessment.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Upon making contact with the driver who was identified by her Florida driver license as W/F Beth Abramson Golden, I immediately detected an obvious and strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from her person and breath. This odor intensified as I spoke to her. She had glassy, glazed, and bloodshot eyes. Golden's speech was slurred, extremely slow, thick, and at times difficult to understand. Golden's movements were slow and deliberate, and lethargic with poor coordination. She had an unsteady gait while walking to my patrol vehicle and had difficulty following directions given to her. Golden was wearing a multicolored dress and no shoes.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Pre-Miranda: She said that she was coming from a work function and only had one (1) drink.

Post Miranda: Admitted to drinking one (1) drink but said that she did not make it, a friend made the drink for her.

ODORS:

A strong and obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage was emitting from her breath which got stronger as we spoke.

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

SPEECH: Golden's speech was slurred, extremely slow, and thick, and at times difficult to understand.

ATTITUDE: talkative, sleepy, polite, emotional, pleading, argumentative,

CLOTHING: multicolored dress with no shoes.

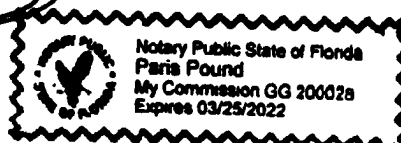

Other Observations:

Golden would sway roughly in a side to side front to back pattern throughout the task. She touch the tip of the pen as directed to positively identify the point to be tracked, although she had to search for the tip of the stimulus. Golden was reminded numerous times to track the pen with her eyes only. Golden failed to keep her head still while tracking the stimulus and had to be reminded not to move her head. VGN was observed.

WALK & TURN:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Walk & Turn" to Golden who stated that she understood. During the task, I observed Golden to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. She could not maintain her balance while listening to instructions. Golden stepped out of the instructional stance during the demonstration to catch her balance. She started the task before being instructed to do so. She would stop walking to steady herself and would pause to regain her balance. Golden missed all heel-to-toe steps and stepped off the line multiple times. Golden took 21 steps and did not make a turn as instructed. She had to be stopped or she would have continued to walk past my vehicle. She also raised her arms more than 6 inches to help maintain her balance.

ONE LEG STAND:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "One Leg Stand" to Golden who stated that she understood. During the task, I observed Golden to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. When told to begin, Golden began lifting her legs high and started marching forward. She was stopped and given the instructions again. When told to begin a second time, she again began marching forward. She could not follow instructions and the task was not completed.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Finger to Nose" task to Golden who stated that she understood. During the task, I observed Golden to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. Golden's index finger did not touch the tip of the nose on 4 of 6 attempts. Golden searched for the tip of her nose using the finger to find their nose prior to touching the tip. The sequence used for this task was L, R, L, R, R, L.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Rhombert Alphabet" task to Golden who stated that she understood. During the task, I observed Golden to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. She would sway more than 2 inches. Golden incorrectly recited the alphabet.

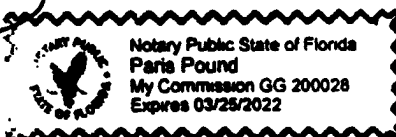
