

On the 2 day of January, 2019 at 23:32 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On 01/02/19 at 2311 hours, PBPB Communications advised of a License Plate Recognition (LPR) on a stolen vehicle traveling eastbound over the Flagler Memorial Bridge. Officers responded to canvas the area for a 2002 White Mercury 4dr bearing FL tag# IZEA30 that was reported stolen out of Pompano Beach, FL.

PBPB Communications advised they observed the vehicle on a town camera traveling eastbound on Main Street towards The Breaker's Hotel property. Officer Bido located the vehicle parked in the area and advised it was occupied by two females. As she approached it, the vehicle fled the scene. Moments later, I observed a vehicle matching the description with no lights on pull out of the Breaker's Hotel main entrance. The suspect vehicle headed south on South County Road. With my emergency patrol lights activated, I began to follow the vehicle from a distance. The vehicle was traveling southbound in the northbound lane (facing oncoming traffic). The vehicle then failed to stop at the red light at Royal Palm Way and South County Road as it continued southbound in the northbound lane of a divided roadway.

I remained in the proper southbound lane and observed the vehicle make a sharp right turn to travel westbound in the 200 blk of Worth Avenue. When the vehicle made a sharp turn, it struck a parked vehicle. Moments later, when I turned on Worth Avenue, I observed two occupants that were fleeing from the vehicle. The driver had left the vehicle in drive and it was still traveling westbound down Worth Avenue as the two occupants were fleeing the scene. The vehicle struck several curbs and two streets signs before coming to a rest. I immediately used verbal commands to stop the closest suspect from fleeing. She was later identified as Bianca Carleyn Cruz H/F DOB 12/25/2000. I immediately placed Cruz in handcuffs and detained her in the rear of my patrol vehicle. I gave a verbal description of the other subject I saw running from the driver's side of the vehicle as she continued westbound on Worth Avenue but responding officers were not able to locate her.

Cruz had a strong odor of marijuana emanating from her person. During a search of the crashed stolen vehicle, a plastic bag of marijuana and a used rolled cigarette was found on the passenger floorboard. Cruz was read her Miranda rights from a PBPD pre-printed Miranda card that she signed and acknowledged she understood. Post Miranda, she took ownership of the marijuana inside the vehicle. She advised she did not know the vehicle was stolen and why her friend was fleeing from the police. At the PBPD station the marijuana weighed a total of 4.2 grams. Based on the above facts, Cruz was arrested for Possession of Marijuana Under 20 grams pursuant to FSS 893.13(6) (B), and Resisting Without Violence pursuant to FSS 843.02.
