NARRATIVE:

On April 20th, 2018, Detective Liriano and I met with Nicolas Frias, a Medical & Health Care Analyst for the Health Care Administration Agency. Frias requested our assistance to investigate a complaint that originated from his agency. We met at an undisclosed location to briefly discuss the details of this investigation.

Frias explained he received an anonymous complaint indicating that a resident at BP Assisted Living Facility II (1174 Wynnewood Drive in West Palm Beach, FL) was being restrained to the bed with sheets to prevent the resident from getting up. A caregiver had to untie this resident from the bed when she started her shift at 9 a.m. Additionally, Frias received several pictures showing a white elderly female restrained to a bed. The female in the photographs was later identified as Mary Foster (1/23/1928) and these photos appeared to be taken during day light hours.

We responded to 1174 Wynnewood Drive in West Palm Beach, FL at approximately 6:00 a.m. During our investigation, interviews were conducted with the residents and the facility's main caregiver, Bibi Parsaram (Bhoodram Parsaram's wife).

Bibi stated she normally works every day from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. She is responsible for the resident's care to include their meals and medicines. When she was asked if she ever tied up Mary she replied "absolutely not" . She was shown the photographs of Mary being tied up and Bibi said "I don't know how that would happen, I don't know when that would've been". She said she has never seen Mary being tied up

and would never do this to her, not even for her safety. Bibi suggested the private health aid did it and took these pictures to later accuse them of abuse.

I later made contact with Tequillia Mays, a health home aid that is privately hired to care for Betty Weber. Mays stated she has been a fill in for regular caregiver Jessica Brown. She has been caring for Ms. Weber since late March and has been with her every day since April 12th, 2018 until 04/20/18.

Mays' work hours include seven days a week from 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. and from 4:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. Her duties include providing care for only Betty Weber as she needs complete assistance with her activities of daily living. Ms. Weber shares a room with Mary Foster. Mays also stated the only people that care for the residents are Bibi Parsaram from 7:00 a.m. - 07:00 p.m. and Bhoodram Parsaram from 7:00 p.m.-7:00 a.m. Therefore, she does not interact with Mr. Parsaram as much.

Mays stated that during her time at the B P Assisted Living Facility, she witnessed Bibi Parsaram tie up Mary by using a bed sheet. Mays told me Bibi would place it across Mary's waist and tie it up to the railings on both sides of the bed. Additionally, Bibi would place socks/mittens to Mary's hands and then tie these with a "ribbon" to restrain her from removing them and untying the sheets herself.

Mays stated that on at least two occasions, Mary was also tied up to the dining room chair. She said Bibi would remove Mary's shoes as she knew she would not try to walk without them, but then later would use sheets to tie her up to the bottom of the chair. Mary would stay in the dining room from breakfast time (9:00-10:00 a.m.) until about 5:00 p.m. when it was time to get her changed and ready for bed.

Mays also informed me that on Saturday April 14th, 2018, she observed Bibi tie up Mary to the bed from 6:00 p.m. until she returned on Sunday at 09:00 a.m. Mary remained tied up to the bed all day Sunday until approximately 5:00 p.m. when Mays told us she could not take it anymore and decided to untie Mary. Mays said that during almost 24 hours, Mary was not fed. She had also urinated herself and was never cleaned up.

Mays said that Mary requires assistance to be taken to the bathroom and she wants to be taken a lot even though sometimes she doesn't have to go. Mays told me she believed Bibi was doing this for her own convenience so she didn't have to take her. Mays also advised me on this date, Bibi had to leave the facility and go to the bank. She told Mays that while she was gone, if anyone would come up to the door, to untie Mary before opening the door.

When Bibi saw Mays helping Mary out after almost 24 hours of being tied up, they got into an argument. Bibi told Mays that "Doctor Joe" told her she needed to tie Mary to the bed for her safety. Mays told us she had never heard about anyone by that name.

Mays told us that after she untied Mary, she cleaned her up, changed her clothes, and brought her out to the dining room to have dinner. Mays said after Mary took a few bites off her food, she fell face down into her plate. Bibi insisted Mary was fine, but Mays insisted she needed to call 911. Mary was transported to St. Mary's hospital and returned to the facility the next day. It is unknown the cause of her fall.

Mays also stated that during her time at the facility, she witnessed Bibi being verbally abusive towards the residents by calling them names and telling them they are "stupid, lazy and stink of shit". Mays confirmed Mary is not a threat to herself or others and she had never seen Mary try to get up from the bed on her own.



I later met with Jessica Brown, full time HHA for Betty Weber. She has been working at this facility since November of 2017. Brown told me that since approximately February of 2018, she has witnessed Bibi Parsaram tie Mary Foster to the bed "almost every other day". When asked about a number of times, Brown said about twenty- times. She also confirmed Mary was being tied up to the dining room chair and later told me that sometimes she was even tied up to the toilet for periods of 30 minutes. Brown also had no concerns for Mary hurting herself.

I also made contact with Nurse Practitioner Ivory Joe Christian. He stated Bibi refers to him as "Doctor Joe". He has been attending the BP ALF for approximately ten years. He is the owner of "Mobile Practitioners Services". He and Dr. Richard Dellerson care for all residents at this facility. Ivory stated he had no firsthand knowledge of any abuse or neglect towards the patients at this facility and denied ever recommending Bibi to restrain Mary Foster to the bed or chair.

Contact was made with Dr. Dellerson. He also denied ever witnessing or authorizing for Mary to be restrained to the bed or chair. He explained that by Mary being restrained for such extended periods of time (24 hours) it could cause circulatory issues resulting in an injury to the area that was compromised. For example, If the restrain was too tight or in a manner that restricted the movement of her torso and chest area, it could limit the ability for her to breathe properly and she could potentially develop pneumonia and work of breathing which could cause her problems. Additionally, he confirmed Mary was never combative or aggressive or had any management problems. He also said Mary did not pose a threat to herself or others.

Based on my investigation, Bibi Nazeela Parsaram did knowingly or willfully inflict intentional physical or psychological injury upon Mary Foster, an elderly person or disabled adult, {or} did an intentional act or actively encouraged another to do an act that resulted or could reasonably be expected to result in physical or psychological injury to Mary Foster, an elderly person or disabled adult, contrary to Florida Statute 825.102(1). (3 DEG FEL) (LEVEL 6).
