DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

Ofc Witt 492, observed Brenden Belser unconscious in the driver seat of a vehicle while it was on and running in the east bound travel lanes of Northlake Blvd. Officers were concerned that Belser may have been having a medical episode and thus made forced entry into his vehicle to determine if he needed medical attention. I observed Ofc Witt break the front passenger window of the vehicle to ascertain the drivers' status. I made contact with Belser while he was still in the driver seat of the vehicle while it was on and running.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Belser appeared disoriented, had bloodshot watery eyes, flushed red face, slurred speech and the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage. Belser's movements appeared to be lethargic and deliberate.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Belser said he was coming from Loxahatchee and had not consumed any alcohol or narcotics

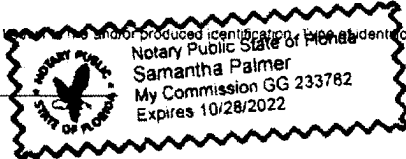

Other Observations:

Swayed while standing in one position. Also lack of convergence was observed in right eye.

WALK & TURN:

Belser was unable to maintain his balance in the starting position. He stepped off line and had difficulty lining up his feet. The first two attempts, Belser only took three steps. During both of those attempts, he raised his arms in a "T" manner, stepped off the line and missed heel-to-toe. I again explained the instructions to Belser. On the third attempt, he raised his arms more than six inches from his sides for a majority of the attempt. Belser stepped off the line four times. Belser missed heel-to-toe six times. After taking his tenth step, rather than nine as instructed, I had to instruct Belser on what to do next. Belser then conducted an improper turn around, then stopped to regain balance. Belser kept his arms raised more than six inches from his sides for almost the entire attempt. Belser again stepped off the line on multiple steps. Belser also missed heel-to-toe on half of the steps. On the fifth step, Belser lost his balance and almost fell on the ground.

ONE LEG STAND:

During the exercise, when Belser first raised his foot, he raised his arms in a "T" manner. Belser then continued the exercise, with his foot raised less than three inches off the pavement. Belser swayed throughout the exercise and placed his foot down twice.

FINGER TO NOSE:

During the exercise, for each attempt, Belser would touch the bridge of his nose rather than the tip. Belser also would not lower his hand until told to do so. Lastly Belser raised his left arm when told to raise his right arm for a second consecutive attempt.

HAND COORDINATION:

Not conducted.

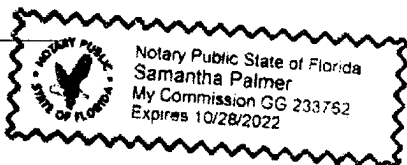
