DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On Tuesday, October 11, 2016 at approximately 2228 hours, I responded to Jog Road and Northtree Boulevard (Bv), Lake Worth (Palm Beach County) Florida to assist Sgt. A Lin with a traffic stop that involved a possible drunk driver. Upon my arrival I noticed three (3) police cruisers stopped in the left turn lane on Jog Rd at the intersection of Northtree Bv. with their emergency lights activated. I also observed a black Chevrolet pick up truck stopped ahead of the cruisers with its engine running. I made contact with Sgt. Lin who told me the following regarding his traffic stop: While on patrol in the area of 7894 S. Jog Rd, unincorporated Boynton Beach, Palm Beach County, FL, I observed a black Chevrolet Avalanche, bearing FL Tag D4APZ, traveling northbound on S. Jog Rd. The Chevrolet failed to stop for the steady red light at the intersection of S. Jog Rd and Park Vista H.S. Rd (bus access road). I conducted a traffic stop with my marked PBSO patrol car using its emergency lights at the intersection of S. Jog Rd and Northtree Blvd. The driver and only occupant identified himself by FL DL as Brent T. Braunworth. While speaking to Brent, I could smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic substance coming from his breath in high wind. I stepped away from the vehicle and upon contact the second time, I could still smell the alcohol odor coming from Brent and/or interior at the rear of his truck. Brent advised he was heading home from playing poker at Alabama Joes (Boynton Beach Blvd & Hagen Ranch Rd). Brent further advised he only had a few drinks while playing poker at the bar/restaurant. Brent appeared confused while requesting his vehicle paperwork by handing me a vehicle registration from Georgia. Brent speech was slightly slurred and eyes were glassed over. Due to the strong smell of alcohol and physical characteristics noted, I requested a PBSO DUI investigator to respond.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I made contact with the driver who was sitting in the driver seat of a black pick up truck that is registered to Mary Braunworth. The driver was later identified as Brent Taylor Braunworth by his Florida driver license. During my interview I noticed his eyes were red, squinted and glossy. His speech was slightly slurred and his cheeks were flushed. I could smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from the inside of the vehicle. I explained to the driver that I had a suspicion he had been drinking an unspecified amount of unknown alcoholic beverages. He smiled and told me I just met him and how could I determine that. Moreover I asked if he would consent to performing Standardized Field Sobriety Evaluations (SFSTs) for the purpose of determining if he was impaired while operating a motor vehicle. The defendant refused, so I gave the Taylor Warnings and explained the evidence that I already had against him (His squinted red and glossy eyes, his flushed cheeks and slight slur in his speech, the strong smell of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from the inside of the vehicle, along with Sgt. Lin's observation of his vehicle in motion) would be strong basis for him being arrested. The driver said he did not want to perform the SFSTs because I would be evaluating him. The driver later changed his mind and said he would perform the SFSTs. Prior to exiting the vehicle I asked if he had any physical problems with his body that would inhibit him from performing light physical movements. I also asked if he was on medication. The defendant conveyed he has high blood pressure and takes several medications. He said he had a problem with his back that he treats with Icy Hot. He also told me he is seen by a doctor for this condition. I asked them to exit the vehicle. When he exited I noticed he was unable to maintain his balance. He swayed from side to side while standing. I escorted him to a smooth and level surface on the roadway that was free from obstructions and debris. The area was well lit by the lights from my patrol car and ambient lighting. I could now smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his breath which intensified when they spoke. The following SFSTs were explained, demonstrated and acknowledged by him prior to his performance: HGN, The Walk and Turn, The One Leg Stand, The Finger to Nose and The Romberg Alphabet Recitation. His deficiencies were captioned on another part of this worksheet.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

I am lucid and almost home. You guys can follow me home. Why can't I get some professional courtesy. I was a fire chief and police officer. I am sorry for running the light but I was on the phone with my son who was going to put down a dog.

ODORS:

Strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from subject's breath.

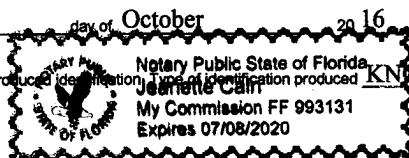

Other Observations:

Subject was asked to stand with their feet together and place their hands by their side. They were asked to focus on the stimulus and follow it with their eyes. Lastly they told not to move their head to assist in following the stimulus with their eyes. Subject could not maintain his balance while performing this task. He did not keep his head straight and turned his head to follow the stimulus.

WALK & TURN:

The def was placed in the instructional stance for the Walk & Turn and given instructions. The def stated that they understood my instructions. Subject could not maintain his balance while placed in the instructional position. He immediately stumbled and abandoned the position. He attempted to get in the position a second time and once again stumbled out of it. He later said he has balance issues and could not do it. He then told me to just take him jail. I asked if he wanted to perform other tasks and said he would.

ONE LEG STAND:

The def was placed in the instructional stance for the One Leg Stand and given instructions. The def stated that they understood my instructions. Subject said he has a knee injury. I told him not to support his weight on that leg. During this evaluation subject was unable to maintain his balance while his leg/foot was elevated. He leaned and swayed before dropping his foot on the roadway three times. Based on his performance I deemed it unsafe for him to continue.

FINGER TO NOSE:

The def was placed in the instructional stance for the Finger to Nose and given instructions. The def stated that they understood my instructions. Subject failed to maintain his balance during this evaluation. He swayed throughout it. He failed to touch the tip of his finger to the tip of his nose on 5 attempts. He was successful on one. On his failed attempts he touched the bridge of his nose with the pad of his finger. On one occasion he touched the bridge of his nose and slid his finger to the tip of his nose.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

The def was placed in the instructional stance for the Romberg Alphabet and given instructions. The def stated that they understood my instructions. Subject did not recite each individual letter as instructed, but sang the alphabet when he reached the letter "L". As we traveled to the breath facility he became upset from being arrested and attempted the alphabet on his own volition. In his attempt he failed to successfully recite the alphabet.

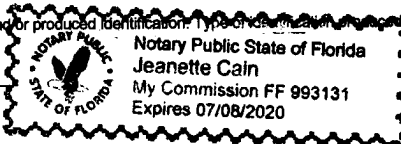
