PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On the aforementioned date at approximately 0140 hours, I was stopped, facing north on S Central Blvd., in the outside left turn lane to turn west on S.R. 706 (W Indiantown Rd.). I observed a white 2014 BMW stopped, facing south, in one of the left turn lanes of N Central Blvd. with its left turn signal activated. At the time, the vehicle was across the intersection from me and I could not see which lane it was in. I observed the vehicle execute a right turn across the southbound through lanes of N Central Blvd. and travel westbound on S.R. 706 (turned inconsistent with signal). Due to the light cycle, I was unable to follow the vehicle before it parked in the parking lot at IHOP (6773 W Indiantown Rd.) and 2 vehicle occupants exited the vehicle. I drove behind the parked vehicle and obtained the tag number (FL tag # D8CAD). I noted the vehicle was registered to Brian Davenport (w/m; 05/18/1978) and his address was in Palm Beach Gardens. I waited for the vehicle to leave and followed the vehicle east on S.R. 706 (away from the registered owner's address) until it turned into Jupiter Plantation. I lost sight of the vehicle inside the neighborhood but waited east of both exits to the community on Center St. Approximately 5 minutes later, I observed the vehicle exit the community and travel eastbound on Center St. I followed the vehicle and observed it activate its brakes for no apparent reason near the intersection of Center St. and Loxahatchee River Rd. I continued following behind the vehicle as it traveled westbound on S.R. 706. I activated the front antenna of my Raptor RP-1 vehicle-mounted radar unit in moving mode and received a digital speed readout of 55 MPH in a posted 45 MPH speed zone, as the vehicle continued westbound past 67th Rd. N. The radar unit emitted a clear audio doppler tone (indicating no outside interference), which was consistent with a vehicle traveling the aforementioned speed. At the time, the BMW was the only vehicle within my radar unit's operational range. I followed the vehicle as it entered the southbound on-ramp to Interstate 95 from S.R. 706. I activated my overhead emergency lights and siren to conduct a traffic stop on the vehicle and the vehicle did not give any clear indication that the driver observed my police vehicle with emergency lights activated behind it for several seconds (no brakes or turn signal for several seconds). The vehicle was slow to stop and the driver pumped the brakes of the vehicle several times before pulling off the right shoulder of the roadway. After pulling off the roadway, the vehicle continued slowly traveling south for approximately 300 yards before coming to a stop on the shoulder.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I observed a single occupant inside the vehicle, identified to me as Brian Davenport (w/m; 05/18/1978), by his valid Class E Florida driver license. Davenport was wearing a red collared shirt and tan shorts. I observed Davenport had bloodshot glassy eyes and slightly slurred speech. When I requested he provide his driver license, registration, and proof of insurance, Davenport removed a group of papers from the glove compartment of the vehicle. Davenport slowly sorted through the paperwork to locate the requested documents. Davenport's movements were slow and deliberate and he was not actively thumbing through or searching for the documents I requested. After approximately one minute had elapsed, Davenport advised he was "the worst at finding stuff" and continued sorting through the paperwork for approximately another minute. When asked to exit the vehicle, Davenport appeared to slightly lose his balance, to the left, using his left hand to steady himself on his vehicle. After Davenport exited the vehicle, I could smell the definitive odor of alcohol coming from his person, which intensified as he spoke.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Davenport advised he had just got off work. Davenport initially stated he came straight from work to where I stopped him. When asked, Davenport advised he had consumed a couple beers (two) at Johnny Mango's (local bar in Jupiter) after leaving work. Davenport later confirmed that he left work, consumed 2 beers at Johnny Mango's, then when to IHOP, before I stopped him (omitting his stop in Jupiter Plantation). When requested to complete SFSTs, Davenport immediately provided his consent.

ODORS:

Slight odor of unknown alcoholic beverage on person which intensified as Davenport spoke.

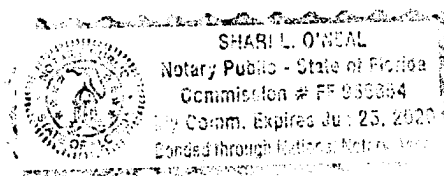

Other Observations:

During the administration of the task, Davenport would anticipate the location of the stimulus by moving his eyes to where he thought the stimulus would move prior to the stimulus moving to that position. While checking for Distinct and Sustained Nystagmus at Maximum Deviation, Davenport snapped his eyes back to me after approximately 3 seconds before the stimulus was moved and he had to be reminded to continue watching the stimulus and keep his head still. Davenport was swaying from side to side during the administration of the exercise.

WALK & TURN

Davenport advised he was not comfortable walking in his sandals and removed them prior to this exercise for the remainder of the SFSTs. Davenport had difficulty standing in the starting position (left foot on the line with right foot in front - heel touching toe with arms down at his sides). Davenport stepped off the line multiple times and began complaining (which continued for the remainder of the exercise) that the shoulder of the roadway was slanted. It appeared as though Davenport was having a difficult time standing in the starting position while the instructions were given to him. It should be noted there was a slight slant (to the west) of the shoulder but there were no other nearby locations that were not elevated or slightly slanted to conduct roadsides. While demonstrating the task, Davenport started walking before being instructed. Davenport intermittently raised his arms to balance himself throughout the entirety of the exercise. Davenport began counting and did not count any of his steps out loud. Davenport stepped off the line, to the right, on step 8 and missed heel-to-toe on step 9. Davenport continued past the instructed 9 steps and took a total of 16 steps all the way to the end of the blue tape line. Davenport turned improperly by taking one large step with his trailing foot to turn around. Davenport lost his balance, to the left, on step 6 and stepped approximately a foot and a half off the line to the left. Davenport paused and complained about the slant in the roadway before continuing on. Davenport missed heel-to-toe on steps 8 and 9. Davenport stepped off the line, to the right on step 8. Again, Davenport continued past the instructed 9 steps and continued walking until the end of the blue tape line (ultimately taking a total of 18 steps back down the line). Davenport did not count his steps out loud while walking back down the line.

ONE LEG STAND:

Davenport raised his right leg off the ground for this exercise. Davenport had to be reminded to watch his foot twice during the exercise. Davenport swayed to his left and placed his foot on the ground after approximately 5 seconds had elapsed (Davenport's count was at "1003" when his foot was placed on the ground to steady himself). Davenport appeared to have lost his balance, to his left, as he took small steps to his left after placing his foot on the ground. Davenport raised his right leg off the ground again and counted from "1001" again, instead of continuing from where he left off as instructed. Davenport placed his foot back down on the ground at his count of "1010", approximately 19 seconds into the exercise. Davenport looked at me as if he was waiting for instruction and I instructed him to continue until told to stop. Davenport raised his right leg off the ground a third time and again began counting from "1001." At approximately the 30 second mark, when Davenport was on his count of "1005", he placed his foot back on the ground for the third time before the exercise was completed.

FINGER TO NOSE:

On the first call of left, Davenport touched the pad of his left finger to the bridge of his nose (slightly above the tip of his nose - approximately 3 millimeters). On the first call of right, Davenport touched the pad of his right finger to around the same area of his nose, missing the tip of his nose high by approximately 3 millimeters. On the second call of left, Davenport touched the pad of his finger to the tip of his nose. On the second call of right, Davenport touched the pad of his finger to the tip of his nose. On the final call of right, Davenport raised his left hand up about half the distance from his side to his face before putting his left arm back down at his side and touching the pad of his right finger to the tip of his nose. On the final call of left, Davenport touched the pad of his left finger to the tip of his nose.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

Davenport recited the entire English Alphabet from A to Z in a slow and non-rhythmic manner, as instructed. However, while Davenport was completing the task, I observed him swaying slightly to his left and right.

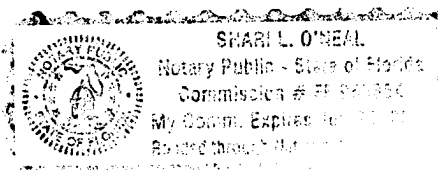
