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NARRATIVE CONTINUATION

Devaleix provided copies of checks drawn on the Bank of America and JPMorgan Chase accounts of Coastal allegedly representing kickbacks to multiple addiction treatment centers or their affiliates. One of the treatment centers whose owners or representatives allegedly received one or more payments was Whole Life Recovery, LLC ("WLR".) During 2016, WLR's Sunbiz records listed KKMD, LLC and GEM-KAM, LLC as Managers. Sunbiz records also show KKMD was established in 2015 listing James Kigar, Kevin Koshi, Matthew Driscoll, and Brian Mangines as Managers.

In a September 26, 2017 interview with Devaleix, he provided me with a 7-page document detailing Jesse Peters' marketer list and spreadsheet (collectively referred to as the "spreadsheet.") Peters later confirmed in subsequent interviews that he maintained the spreadsheet to calculate and track payments to marketers and treatment center owners for UA referrals.

In an October 19, 2017 interview of Julie Stagmiller, former employee of Coastal, she reviewed the spreadsheet with me and said that she helped Peters maintain the spreadsheet. She said Tom Stanley was also fully aware of the spreadsheet and the payments referenced therein, and she had met with Stanley and Peters together to review this spreadsheet in 2016. The spreadsheet includes "Whole Life" entries for insurance receipts collected in 2016 by Coastal. Under this heading, it also references amounts due to "Salesperson Coastal Commission-KKMDB LLC 20%." Florida Sunbiz records show that KKMDB was established July 6, 2016 with JKBM, LLC and Another Chance, LLC as Managers. In 2016, James Kigar and Brian Mangines were the listed Managers of JKBM, and Kevin Koshi, Matthew Driscoll, and Mike Buley were listed as the Managers of Another Chance.

Certified JPMorgan Chase Bank records show a posted check number 10448 drawn on the Coastal Laboratory, LLC account ending in [REDACTED] and payable to KKMDB, LLC dated 7/20/16 in the amount of \$5,401.40. In the column identified by Peters and Stagmiller as the June 2016 column, the Peters' spreadsheet shows a payment of \$5,401.40 due on the KKMDB commission line. This amount equals exactly 20% of the combined amounts listed on the "Collected by Coastal..." line for the periods May and June, 2016. The endorsement signature on the back of this check appears to match the signature of Matthew Driscoll in Florida's DAVID records.

Stagmiller said that Peters and Stanley paid numerous people a percentage of the monies collected from insurance companies for UA testing that they referred to Coastal. She explained that the percent listed on the spreadsheet represented the amount that marketers got for their referrals. And, she said, in many cases the marketers were the owners of the treatment centers. Stagmiller said that KKMDB was affiliated with WLR, and that they got 20% of insurance receipts for WLR UA tests referred to Coastal.

In a review of emails obtained pursuant to an email search warrant dated November 2, 2017 and signed by the Honorable Judge Keyser, correspondence was identified among Peters, Driscoll, Kigar, Koshi, and Mangines. In a July 8, 2016 email from Driscoll to Peters, Driscoll requests to pick up a check from Coastal. Peters replies, cc'ing Mangines, Kigar, and Koshi, that Coastal cuts "marketing checks" on the third Thursday of the month. Later that day Mangines emails Driscoll asking if they will use a "MA or OA", apparently referring to a marketing agreement or operating agreement. Then on July 15, 2016, Mangines emails Peters providing him with the LLC name of KKMDB and promising to send a signed "MA" shortly.

An "Independent Contractor's Agreement" between Coastal and KKMDB signed by Mangines and dated July 15, 2016 was emailed from Mangines to Peters, Koshi, and Driscoll at 3:50 PM on July 15, 2016. That contract provides that Coastal will pay KKMDB 20% of amounts collected by Coastal in exchange for "marketing, advertising, and customer relation services" to Coastal. As noted above, a check dated July 20, 2016 was payable from Coastal to KKMDB. On July 25, 2016 Koshi sent out an email to attorney Mike Buley saying "...Iberia Bank should be contacting you to fill out forms so we can open an account for the lab business (KKMDB LLC...). Subsequently, the above noted check was deposited to that Iberia Bank account and posted by JPMorgan Chase Bank on August 8, 2016. That check appears to relate only to collections by Coastal for WLR Life UA's, and WLR was owned by essentially the same principals as KKMDB, thus making any marketing, advertising, or customer relations services appear irrelevant or even non-existent.

In a June 29, 2018 interview, Peters said that he knew Driscoll, and in April or May of 2016 Driscoll met with Peters and brought Kigar and possibly Koshi with him. Peters said that Driscoll told him they were "bleeding money", and Peters told them "you could make money off urines." Peters and Driscoll first met in a diner in Boca Raton, FL, and then met (along with Kigar and one other individual) to do the contract at an office in Palm Beach County, FL. Peters said he shook hands with Kigar and Driscoll on a deal to send the WLR UA's to Coastal. We reviewed the July 20, 2016 check from Coastal to KKMDB. Peters said he recognized the check as a Coastal check but wasn't sure who signed it. He thought the endorsement signature was Driscoll's. Peters said Stanley was aware of this agreement.

In an August 30, 2018 interview with Peters, he reconfirmed his recollection of the above meeting with Driscoll and Kigar, but he said the 3rd attendee may have been Brian Mangines. Upon again reviewing the July 20, 2016 check for \$5,401.40, Peters said "this was a payment for commissions for their specimens."

In an October 9, 2018 meeting with Peters, we reviewed a series of text messages between Peters and Tom Stanley that occurred between October of 2015 and



December of 2016. We also reviewed some of the emails referenced above. Peters explained that OA and MA referred to an operating agreement or marketing agreement. We reviewed the July 15, 2016 contract signed by Mangines referenced above, and Peters confirmed his knowledge of that agreement. He said that KKMDB never brought in any client other than WLR. Peters reviewed the following text messages, and said that the "John Henry guys" referred to Driscoll and Koshi:

- In a 5/31/16 text from Peters to Stanley, Peters said "Please review the redlines on email labeled blank OAs from last week. John Henry guys want to know..."
- In a 7/18/16 text, Peters said to Stanley "...Also owe a new account Wednesday that isn't on the chart... John Henry guys..."

In an October 18, 2018 interview with Paul Materia, he explained that his Apex Billing, LLC did all of the insurance claims billing for Coastal during 2016. A review of the Apex Billing records of Coastal provided by Materia on January 8, 2019 shows that for 2016 Coastal billed insurance companies more than \$2.1 million for UA tests of WLR's patients.

Based on all of the above, probable cause exists to issue a warrant for the arrest of:

1. James Kigar, Matthew Driscoll, Brian Mangines, and Kevin Koshi for one (1) count of Patient Brokering under §§ 817.505(1)(b) and 777.011, Fla. Stat., a 3rd deg. Felony, for soliciting or receiving a kickback in the amount of \$5,401.40 for the referral of patients or patronage to or from a health care facility (from Whole Life to Coastal) on or about July 20, 2016.
2. James Kigar, Matthew Driscoll, Brian Mangines, and Kevin Koshi for one (1) count of Conspiracy to Commit Patient Brokering under §§ 817.505(1)(b) and 777.04(3), Fla. Stat. for agreeing, conspiring, combining, or confederating with each other, and/or Jesse Peters and/or Thomas R. Stanley, II to commit Patient Brokering under § 817.505(1)(a), (b), and (d), Fla. Stat. between May 6, 2016 and August 8, 2016.
