D.U.I. PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

PERSONAL CONTACT/DRIVING PATTERN/OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

During the night of Sunday, February 24th, 2019 at 0040 hours I was patrolling the 1600 block of South Seacrest, (Boynton Beach, FL) when I observed a Black Volkswagen sedan without headlights on, turn left from Woolbright RD to travel northbound on South Seacrest. As the vehicle was traveling northbound in the left lane Officer Brown (ID 1103), and myself observed the vehicle failing to maintain its lane, by crossing the solid traffic control line to the left of the vehicle greater than 5 times and crossing the broken white traffic control line to the right of the vehicle greater than 5 times. Officer Borrero (ID 1101) drove up next to the vehicle on the right side to try and determine if the driver was having a medical episode. While doing so the vehicle had drifted to the right and had almost crashed into Officer Borrero's marked BBPD vehicle.

Pursuant to FSS 316.217(1) a and FSS 316.089(3), Officer Brown (ID 1103), and I conducted a traffic stop (Emergency lights initiated) at the 300 South Seacrest on the Black Volkswagen bearing FLtag ISRE08. While behind the vehicle I chirped by emergency siren four times as the vehicle came to a stop at the 200 block of North Seacrest. As I was exiting my patrol vehicle, the vehicle abruptly continued through the intersection and turned right to head Westbound on Boynton Beach Blvd. I quickly initiated my emergency lights and sirens till the vehicle came to a stop at 100 West Boynton Beach Blvd in the right lane.

Officer Brown made approached the driver's side door as I approached the front right passenger side door of the vehicle with the windows rolled up completely. As I was approaching the vehicle I observed that the vehicle was solo occupied by a W/F that was later identified by Florida DL as Bridget Tierney (8/19/83). I asked Tierney to roll down the window as she did and she was asked for license registration and insurance at which point she informed me that he black purse was in the truck. I observed and described a similar purse that was located in the rear passenger seat. I pointed to the rear passenger seat and Tierney was able to confirm that her purse that she stated was in the trunk is actually in the rear passenger seat. Tierney gathered her purse and proceeded to gather her documents. While doing so Tierney was asked if she knows whys she was stop at which point she stated, for the suspicion of driving under the influence of alcohol. I declined and I informed Tierney that the reason she was stopped is because she was operating a motor vehicle without headlights on and for failing to maintain proper lane. Tierney provide her driver's license and proof of insurance. I informed her that she was missing her vehicle registration and she informed me that she provided it to me already. While Tierney was gathering her documents I asked if she had any injuries or medical disabilities at which point she stated that she does not. Tierney was later able to find and provide her vehicle registration.

While speaking with Tierney, I smelled the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from her breath and from within her vehicle. Tierney also had glossy eyes.

Tierney agreed to step out of her vehicle as I requested. As Tierney stepped out of the vehicle she started to sway and relied heavily upon on the door to gain her balance. While outside of her vehicle Tierney stated that she came from Delray Beach approximately 10 minutes ago. Tierney stated that while in Delray she was eating and drinking. Tierney stated that she knows she above the legal limit because she has had approximately 4 to 5 shots alcohol. Which included shots and vodka seltzers. I then requested Tierney to move to the front of my marked patrol vehicle so I may check her eyes. While walking to the font of my vehicle from the rear left passenger door of her vehicle Tierney needed to utilize her vehicle for support to hold her person up. While in front of the vehicle Tierney performed the following task:

Tierney refused to perform field sobriety tasks. Tierney was informed Taylor warnings by informing her that with her refusal I will she will be arrested based on my findings thus far. Tierney was asked again at which point she refused. Tierney was handcuffed (D/L) and taken into custody without incident.

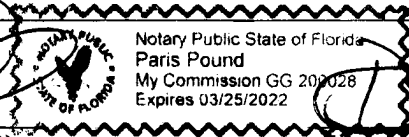
I then transported Tierney to the Palm Beach County Jail's Breathalyzer. Upon my arrival I completed the required. I then requested Tierney provide a sample of her breath for the purpose of determining the alcohol content. Tierney refused my request, at which time I read her Implied Consent, which she stated she understood. A second request was made to Tierney to provide a sample of her breath, at which point Tierney complied and attempted to provided the requested breath samples but she started to regurgitate. Another 20-minute observation was conducted. I then requested Tierney provide a sample of her breath for the purpose of determining the alcohol content. Tierney complied and was unable to provide the requested breath samples due to the machine detecting the odor of alcohol from Tierney regurgitating. Another 20-30-minute observation was conducted. I then requested Tierney provide a sample of her breath for the purpose of determining the alcohol content. Tierney refused my request, at which time I read her Implied Consent, which she stated she understood. A second request was made to Tierney to provide a sample of her breath, which was again refused.

At this time, due to the above mentioned information I have established probable cause to charge Tierney with one count of DUI pursuant to FSS 316.193(1). I issued Tierney the following citations: AAW2SCE, AAW2SDE, 2069XBH

Upon completion of the booking process, Tierney was turned over to Palm Beach County Jail.
