

<p>Taylor warnings and explained that it was his right to refuse, but his refusal would be used against him in court. He verbally stated he understood and when I asked him again about completing roadsides the defendant stated, "I can't do it. I don't want to do them and if I do them I'm gonna fail".</p> <p>I advised the defendant that I concluded my DUI investigation and, based on the crash, the strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath and the defendant's admission of consuming alcohol, determined that he was too impaired to operate a motor vehicle. I placed the defendant under arrest for DUI. The defendant verbally stated that he understood. I placed him in handcuffs that were checked for proper fit and tightness and double locked and placed the defendant in the rear of my PBSO marked patrol vehicle. I transported the defendant to the B.A.T. (Breath Alcohol Testing) facility.</p> <p>Once at the B.A.T. the defendant was observed for a period of twenty minutes, during which time he did not ingest anything, place anything in his mouth regurgitate or vomit. After the twenty minute observation period the defendant was placed on camera and asked if he would submit a breath sample for the purpose of determining its alcohol content and he consented. the defendant stated, " I'm drunk. Yes". The defendant then provided two breath samples and the results were .180 for the first sample and .186 for the second sample. The results were given, and explained to the defendant and he verbally stated that he understood. I read the defendant his Constitutional warnings on camera and he verbally stated that he understood his rights. The defendant cooperated with Q&A.</p> <p>Based on the above set of facts and circumstances, probable cause exists to find BYRON THEODORE CRISPELL did drive or be in actual physical control of a vehicle while under the influence of alcoholic beverages, or chemical substances as set forth in Florida Statute 877.111, or any substance controlled under Chapter 893 or any combination thereof, to the extent that his normal faculties were impaired, or while having a blood alcohol level of .08 or more grams of alcohol per 100 milliliters of blood or breath alcohol level of .08 or more grams of alcohol per 210 liters of breath.</p> <p>I issued the defendant DUI citation A2FUFNP and citation A9K7VUE for Leaving the Scene of an Accident Involving Property Damage. I then transported him to the main detention center, without incident, for booking and processing.</p> <p>This case is cleared by arrest.</p>

After concluding my DUI investigation, while placing the BYRON THEODORE CRSPELL under arrest, he was searched incident to arrest prior to being placed in the rear of my patrol car. I located two small clear plastic bags containing a white powdery substance, presumed cocaine, in his front left pant pocket of his jeans with his money. The white substance field tested positive using a Scott Reagent that reacted by turning blue indicative of cocaine.

Based on the above set of facts and circumstances, BYRON THEODORE CRSPELL was knowingly in actual or constructive possession of cocaine or ecgonine, including any stereoisomer, salt, compound, derivative or preparation of cocaine or ecgonine, a controlled substance, contrary to Florida Statute 893.13(6)(a). (3 DEG FEL) (LEVEL 3).

PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On 03/10/2018, at approximately 21:23 hours, I responded to 1701 Lake Worth Road in The City of Lake Worth, located in Palm Beach County, Florida to assist with a vehicle crash. Upon arriving on scene I made contact with Deputy Alfonso Miranda #26971 who relayed to me, as well as completed a sworn probable cause affidavit, the following: "On March 10, 2018, at approximately 2043 hours, I was dispatched to 1701 Lake Worth Road, in the City of Lake Worth, Palm Beach County, Florida in reference to hit and run. Upon my arrival I observed a brown pick-up truck, bearing FL Tag 817RIJ occupied by a white male wearing a blue shirt over a black under shirt, Blue jeans, and Black shoes, stopped on top of the median in front of 1701 Lake Worth Road. I approached the vehicle on the driver side, and made contact with the white male, later identified by his Florida driver's license as Byron T. Crispell. Crispell was behind the wheel of the brown pick-up truck trapped inside the vehicle by a palm tree which did not allowed the driver door to open. While speaking to Crispell I smelled a strong smell of an unknown alcoholic beverage being emitted from his mouth. At this time I asked Crispell for his driver's license, Crispell picked up a brown wallet which he fumbled a few times attempting to take out his driver's license. Crispell had blood shot, glassy eyes, slurred speech, and was unable to speak complete sentences". I independently evaluated the crash scene and assisted with the crash investigation. Deputy Miranda completed the crash report under PBSO case # 18048547.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

When I arrived on scene BYRON THEODORE CRISPELL (defendant), identified by his Florida issued driver license, was seated in the driver seat of the vehicle and unable to get out. The driver's side door was pinned up against a palm tree in the center median of Lake Worth Road. I made contact with the defendant and observed a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from within the vehicle and the defendant's speech was very slurred, heavy and slow. The defendant was slow to respond and his eyes were bloodshot and glassy. I asked the defendant to get out of the vehicle and he had to climb over to the passenger seat and exit the vehicle through the passenger side door of his pick-up truck. Once out of the vehicle I relocated the defendant to the parking lot of Lake Worth High School, located directly across from where the crash occurred. Through the crash investigation it was discovered that the defendant struck a parked vehicle on Lucerne Avenue, continued west on Lake Worth Road and then struck the center median. Once out of the vehicle I could see the defendant stumble as he walked, his speech was incoherent, he swayed in a front to back motion and there was a strong and obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath that became stronger as he spoke with me. He made several spontaneous statements such as, "I'm fucked up" and "I was drunk". The defendant was unable to recall any details about the crash. I advised him that the crash investigation

was complete and that I was initiating a separate DUI investigation. I then read him his Constitutional warnings from a PBSO issued Miranda card and he verbally stated he understood. Post Miranda the defendant stated that he was "coming from a bar" and he consumed "four tequilas and a couple of beers". When I asked him specifically how many beers he stated, "two to three Budweisers". I asked the defendant if he would submit to voluntary SFST's and he stated, "I'll do whatever you want". I then advised him of SEE Probable Cause PAGE 2 for further.....
