Probable Cause

On August 31st, 2018 I Trooper Lucas M. Tavares (3913/1421) with the Florida Highway Patrol was on active patrol in Palm Beach County, Florida. I was in a jurisdictional marked FHP unit equipped with overhead emergency lights and external siren. At approximately 10:53 p.m. I was traveling southbound on Bee Line Highway, when I observed a red in color GMC pick-up truck in the outside travel lane. The pick-up truck had tinted rear tail lights and was slightly swerving outside its travel lane. The vehicle then changed lanes to the inside travel lane and again veered to the left, crossing over the lane divider. I then observed a lit cigarette tossed from the driver's side of the vehicle and hit the pavement causing orange sparks. After observing these violations, I activated my emergency lights in order to stop the vehicle. The vehicle then turned into the Shell Gas Station located at 14680 Park of Commerce Blvd, Jupiter, FL 33478.

Suspect Vehicle: 2004 Red GMC Sierra Pick-Up with Florida Tag: (Z61DWH) attached.

The vehicle then pulled into a parking spot in front of the store. I then approached the driver's side of the vehicle. While approaching the vehicle I observed a male laying down in the bed of the truck and appeared to be sleeping. I then made contact with the driver of the vehicle. Immediately, upon making contact, I could detect a very strong odor of raw marijuana and an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from within the vehicle. I made this observation based upon my training and past experiences. I then asked the driver for his information and asked if there was any marijuana in the vehicle. He stated no.

I then had the front right passenger, the driver, and the rear passenger in the bed of the truck step out of the vehicle. Based upon the odor of marijuana I then conducted a probable cause search of the vehicle and their persons.

The probable cause search of the vehicle resulted in the following:

-Under the driver's seat of the vehicle, towards the rear floor board: Green leafy substance scattered. (Approximately 1.0 gram).

-On the rear right passenger floor board: A black in color E-cigarette with a brown/yellow tip.

-Under the driver's seat: An open can of Millers beer, the can was cold to a touch, open, and contained liquid.

-Rear of the truck (truck bed): Black bag/cooler that contained a crown royal bottle that was half full and was cold to the touch.

The liquid in the Black in color E-Cigarette was tested utilizing a THC test kit. A sample was placed in the kit and the kit was activated. The sample indicated positive for THC.

At approximately 11:10 p.m. I advised all three subjects the Miranda Warning and all three stated they understood and would like to talk.

Mr. Tomaras stated that he had the weed and placed it in the back of the vehicle. He subsequently showed/pointed out the marijuana in the vehicle to me. When asked about the vape/e-cigarette and stated it belonged to Mr. Moore, the rear passenger.

Mr. Rostveit stated that he was smoking weed earlier that night and was leaving the race track. He stated that Mr. Moore was seated in the rear right passenger seat prior to leaving, but due to Mr. Moore's intoxication he placed him in the rear of the truck. Mr. Rostveit stated that the E-cigarette belonged to his cousin Mr. Moore.

Mr. Moore stated that he did not know about the e-cigarette and that he was drinking at the race track.

At approximately 11:19 p.m. I placed Caleb Moore under arrest for possession of a controlled substance (THC), possession of paraphernalia, and for possession of alcohol of someone under the age of 21.

Keylan Tomaras and Jordan Rostviet were both issued a notice to appear for possession of marijuana under 20 grams and possession of alcohol of someone under the age of 21.

Mr. Rostviet was also issued a uniform traffic citation for littering.

The above incident did occur in Palm Beach County, Florida.


