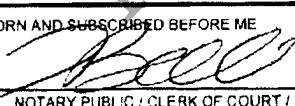
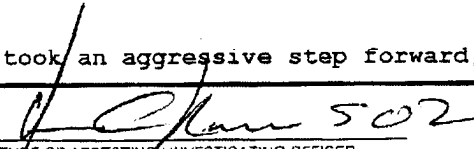

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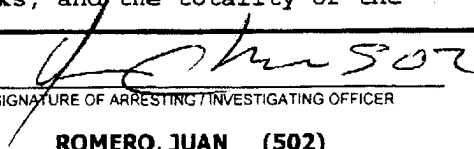

While standing next to the window, I smell the odor of alcohol coming from witting the vehicle. Since Ramirez had a passenger, I asked him to step out so I can speak to him. Outside of the car, and while speaking with Ramirez, I could smell the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from Ramirez' breath while at a conversational distance. I observed Ramirez's pupils be dilated more than a normal person, the sclera of his eyes to be reddened, his eyes to be watery, his face to be flushed, and his speech to be slurred. I asked Ramirez to perform a series of Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks (SFST's). Ramirez agreed. During this encounter, I noticed Ramirez' had an unsteady walk. Ramirez performed the tasks on a flat, dry surface that was well lit. striking this officer in the chest, knocking me of my stand, forcing me to retreat to keep my balance. Due to Ramirez `aggressive move, I came close to his person and grabbed Ramirez by his arms, and I began to guide him against his car to get control. After this incident, Ramirez proceeded to complete the pen exercise. I conducted a "pen exercise" and explained the instructions to Ramirez, who stated he understood. I first checked for equal pupil size, resting jerking of the eye (nystagmus), and equal tracking. I observed the pupils dilated normally in both left/right eye. I then conducted the exercise and observed a lack of smooth pursuit in Ramirez`s eyes. Ramirez had distinct and sustained jerking (nystagmus) at maximum deviation. Ramirez had onset of jerking (nystagmus) prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. Ramirez had vertical jerking/bouncing (nystagmus) in both eyes. Ramirez found it challenging to focus on the stimulus and continued to move his head after being directed not to. circumstances observed, I determined that Ramirez was impaired and could not operate a motor vehicle safely on the roadways of this state. I placed Ramirez under arrest for driving a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol.

While attempting to place Ramirez into handcuffs, Ramirez begin to resist and tense his body. Ramirez pulled his hands to the front of his body and refused to follow commands to place his hands behind his back. Ramirez then began to walk while tensing his body and resisting. Officer Yacinthe assisted in securing the Ramirez. Eventually, Ramirez was handcuffed behind his back with the cuffs double locked and checked for proper fit. Ramirez was transported to the Palm Beach County Breath Alcohol Testing Center (B.A.T.) where he was observed for 20 minutes and did not ingest anything or vomit. I brought Ramirez on camera and asked him to submit to the breath test, and he agreed to my request. Ramirez provided a breath sample to Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office Breathalyzer Technician #8656, blowing a 0.109 BrAC 0, 128 BrAC and 0.116 BrAC. Ramirez was read the results which he advised he understood.

Ramirez was read the Miranda Warnings from a pre-printed document. Ramirez agreed to answer questions from the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office Question and Answer sheet. During the question and answer segment, Ramirez admitted that he was drinking with friends. Ramirez stated that he drank 3 white Claw. Ramirez also stated that he had no medical conditions and had no issues with walking or keeping balance. The Question and Answer sheet was forwarded with this report.

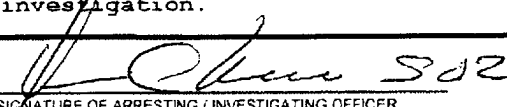
Based on the totality of circumstances from my investigation, I find Carlos Julio Ramirez, in actual physical control of and did operate a vehicle in and on the streets of Palm Beach Gardens, while under the influence of an alcoholic beverage. Ramirez was affected to the extent that his normal faculties were impaired in violation of Florida State Statute 316.193(1).

I also find probable cause to charge Ramirez with (1) count of assault on a Law Enforcement Officer. Ramirez knowing that I was in full police uniform and that I was a law enforcement officer who was engaged in the lawful performance of a duty, did actually and intentionally touch or strike this Officer against my will contrary to Florida Statutes 784.07(2) (a).

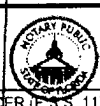
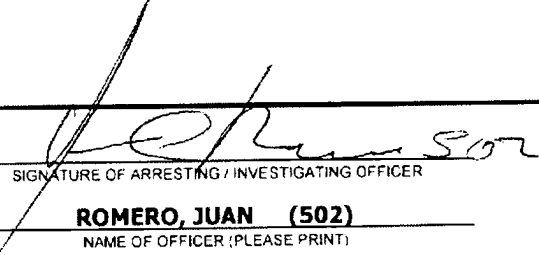
I also find that probable cause to charge Ramirez with (1) count for resist without violence based on Florida State Statute 843.02.

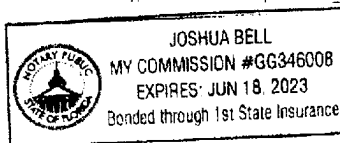

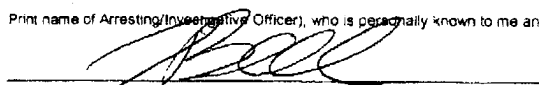

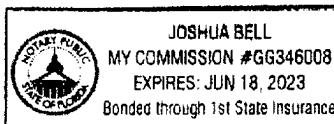
