PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On 12/3/19 I responded to State Road 80/ Pine Ave, in Palm Beach County, in reference to a single vehicle crash (PBSO case 19143846), with a possibly impaired driver. Upon arrival I observed a white Nissan Altima, bearing FL tag IFJJ57, in the outside westbound lane. Both driver side tires were blown out and there was damage to the lower portion of the vehicle.

I spoke with a witness to the crash, Wade Aruz. Wade advised that he observed the Nissan traveling west. The Nissan then drifted left and struck the center median and then stop in the middle of the roadway. Wade made contact with the driver, Carlos Rojas, who appeared dazed. Wade positive identified Rojas as the driver.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I met with Rojas, who was seated in the driver seat of the car. I attempted to have Rojas exit his vehicle but he refused while he was calling his neighbor, who is a police officer. Rojas then handed me his phone, wanting me to speak with his neighbor. I advised Rojas's neighbor that I was conducting an investigation and handed the phone back to Rojas. Rojas then exited the car and stood in front of my patrol car. I advised Rojas that the crash investigation was complete. Rojas then spontaneously stated that he had struck the median. I advised Rojas that I was going to conduct a criminal DUI investigation and advised him of Miranda warnings, which he advised he understood. I observed Rojas's eyes to be glassy and there was an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his breath, which got stronger when he spoke. Rojas's speech was slurred and he was difficult to understand at times. Rojas advised he was coming from city place, where he had been drinking. Rojas advised he had 1 glass of wine approximately 4 hours prior. Based on my observations and Rojas's admission to drinking I asked him to perform standard field sobriety tasks. Rojas then asked if he could refuse to perform standard field sobriety tasks. I advised Rojas that he could and advised him of Taylor warnings, which he advised he understood. I gave Rojas a second opportunity to perform standard field sobriety tasks and he agreed.

Rojas admitted to drinking 1 glass of wine approximately 4 hours prior.

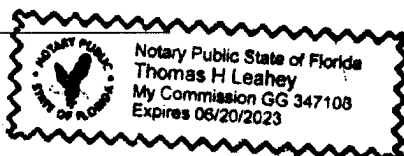

Other Observations:

Rojas was asked to stand with his feet together and place his hands by his sides. Rojas was asked to focus on the stimulus and follow it with his eyes. Rojas was told not to move his head to assist in following the stimulus. Rojas showed equal pupil size that tracked equally. Both eyes lacked a smooth pursuit. I saw distinct and sustained Nystagmus at maximum deviation and onset of Nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. I saw no vertical nystagmus in either of Rojas's eyes. Rojas exhibited a slight sway while performing this task and had to be reminded multiple times to follow the stimulus and not to move his head or body.

WALK & TURN:

I utilized yellow duct tape to make a straight, level line, free of debris, that Rojas advised he could see. I explained and demonstrated the task to Rojas. During the instructions Rojas was unable to maintain the instructional stance. Rojas attempted to begin the task, prior to being instructed to do so. After completing the instructions Rojas advised he understood and had no questions. During the task Rojas stepped off the line several times and paused to regain balance. On step 5 Rojas stumbled to his right and then returned to the start of the line to begin again. Rojas then began again. Rojas did not turn as instructed and failed to keep his arms at his sides. Rojas took the incorrect number of steps, taking only 7 steps down. When Rojas did not continue I asked if he had completed the task. Rojas stated no and then went back to the beginning of the line to take the 2nd 9 steps. Rojas again took the incorrect number of steps, taking only 8 steps.

ONE LEG STAND:

I explained and demonstrated the task to Rojas. After completing the instructions Rojas advised he understood and had no questions. During the task Rojas failed to keep his leg straight. Rojas lost his balance and put his foot down multiple times prior to 30 seconds elapsing. Rojas had to be reminded several times to look down at his foot during the task. After counting to 10 Rojas put his foot down and advised that he had completed the task.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I explained and demonstrated the task to Rojas. After completing the instructions Rojas advised he understood and had no questions. Rojas missed touching the tip of his nose several times, and used the pad of his finger to touch his nose. Rojas failed to return his hand to his side, after touching his nose, several times. I stopped the task and re-explained to Rojas that after touching his nose he was to bring his hand back down, without me telling him to, which he advised he understood. I then began the task again. Rojas again missed touching the tip of his nose several times and used the pad of his finger to touch his nose. Rojas again failed to return his hand to his side after touching his nose. On the third right command Rojas used his left hand first before correcting himself and using his right. Rojas exhibited a sway throughout the task.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

Prior to beginning Rojas confirmed he knew the entire alphabet in Spanish. I explained and demonstrated the task to Rojas. After completing the instructions Rojas advised he understood and had no questions. During the task Rojas exhibited a sway. Rojas incorrectly recited the alphabet, in English, making multiple errors. I then asked Rojas why he didn't recite the alphabet in Spanish and he stated that he did. I assured him that he recited the alphabet in English and asked him if he would like to try again, which he did. Rojas attempted to recite the alphabet in Spanish, again making multiple errors.

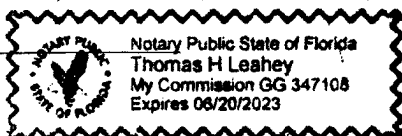

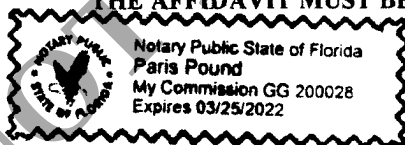
