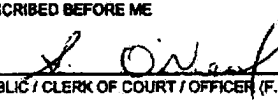
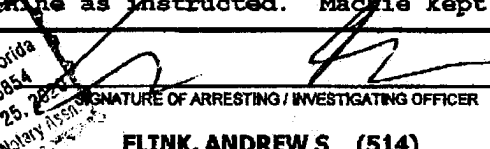

On 06/09/2019, at approximately 0322 hours, I arrived just north of the intersection of US Highway 1 and PGA Blvd, PBG, FL, to assist Ofc Witt 492 with a traffic stop. Body worn camera was used. Ofc Witt advised he paced the vehicle, a Volkswagen Jetta (IMLH71/FL) at 66 MPH in a posted 45 MPH zone. Ofc Witt also saw the vehicle almost strike a pedestrian on PGA Blvd. When the vehicle attempted to stop at the intersection of PGA Blvd and US Highway 1, the vehicle went past the stop bar, while the light was steady red. I made contact with the driver, identified via Florida Driver License, as Casey Mackie (white female 04/11/2001) (SU), while she was still in the driver seat of the vehicle, with the vehicle still on and running. Mackie had slurred speech, bloodshot watery eyes, flushed red face, and the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from her breath. Based on my observations, I asked Mackie to participate in Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises. The first exercise conducted was Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. The stimulus used was a Streamlight Stylus with an illuminated red-light tip. Mackie stated she did not have any medical condition which would affect her ability to participate. I noticed a lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes. I noticed sustained nystagmus, involuntary jerking of the eyes, in both eyes at maximum deviation. I also noticed the onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. The second exercise conducted was the Walk and Turn. During the exercise, Mackie raised her arms more than six inches while performing. Mackie took 10 steps rather than nine as instructed. After the tenth step, Mackie stepped off the line and executed an improper turn. Mackie spun around rather than taking several small steps. On the return set, Mackie took 10 steps rather than nine as instructed. Mackie kept her arm

raised more than six inches from her side. The final exercise conducted was the One-Leg Stand. Mackie began the exercise prior to being told to do so. Mackie raised her arms more than six inches during the instructional phase. Mackie swayed while balancing. I read Mackie her Miranda Rights on camera. Mackie waived her rights and agreed to speak with me. Mackie stated she was coming from a party on Forest Hill Blvd. Mackie admitted to consuming one alcoholic drink with vodka and cranberry juice. When asked how large the one drink was, she stated a red solo cup probably 16 ounces. I asked Mackie how much of that was vodka, to which she replied probably half. Based on my observations, I placed Mackie under arrest at 0333 hours. While gathering Mackie's property, I noticed a California Driver License (M1140690) inside of Mackie's purse. The DL had a photo which looked similar to Mackie and had Mackie's name on it. The birth date was 04/11/1996, rather than 04/11/2001. I asked Mackie about the California DL, to which she admitted it was hers and she received it while she was a student at Spanish River High School in Boca Raton, FL. Mackie admitted knowledge of the California DL being fake. The California DL was seized as evidence. While at the PBSO BAT, Mackie provided two breath samples resulting in the following: .099 and .104. Based on the totality of my investigation, I have probable cause to show Casey Mackie was Driving Under the Influence, in violation of FSS 316.193(1) and Mackie knowingly possessed a fictitious, counterfeit, and unlawfully issued driver license, in violation of FSS 322.212(1) (A).

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

Ofc Witt 492, originally observed the vehicle and provided me with the following details. The vehicle was observed traveling at an extremely high rate of speed which was visually estimated by Ofc Witt at 70 miles per hour in a posted 45 mile per hour zone. The vehicle then began to blow on its horn. The vehicle activated its horn due to a pedestrian which was crossing the roadway in the area. The vehicle never attempted to brake or take an evasive action. The pedestrian stopped walking and took evasive action to avoid being struck by the vehicle. The vehicle was also observed to have an extinguished headlight on the front passenger side. The vehicle was paced at 66 miles per hour in a posted 45 mile per hour zone. This pace was conducted in the area of Ellison Wilson Road on PGA Boulevard. At the intersection of PGA Blvd and US Hwy 1, the vehicle entered the northbound turn lane to turn left (north) onto US Highway 1. As the vehicle approached the intersection the vehicle passed the stop bar and entered the intersection on a visible red light. I observed Mackie in the driver seat of the vehicle, while the vehicle was still on and running.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Mackie had slurred speech, bloodshot watery eyes, flushed red face, and the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from her breath. Mackie would sway when asked to stand up straight.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Mackie stated she was driving friends home from a party on Forest Hill Blvd. Mackie stated she was the designated driver. Post Miranda, Mackie admitted to having a drink consisting of Vodka and Cranberry juice. Mackie said the cup was about 16 fluid ounces and roughly half of it may have contained vodka.

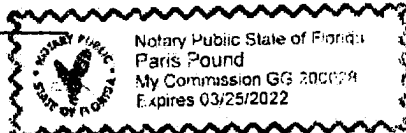

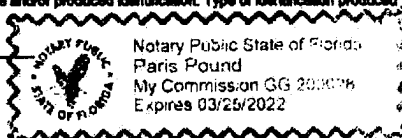
