 On the 27 day of January, 2018 at 17:41 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On the above date at approximately 1741 hours, I was on routine patrol in the area of Military Trail and Jupiter Lakes Boulevard, in the Town of Jupiter, Palm Beach County, Florida.

I was stopped in traffic traveling south on Military Trail at the intersection with Jupiter lakes Boulevard. I was in the right hand through lane behind one vehicle. I saw a 2015 Hyundai bearing Missouri License Plate DL2T1M in front of me to my left in the middle through lane. It was the first car at the light. The vehicle was stopped at the red light. A few seconds later, and for no apparent reason, the vehicle suddenly proceeded through the red light to travel south on Military Trail. When the light changed, I caught up to the vehicle and initiated a traffic stop.

I walked up and made contact with the driver, identified to me by Florida Driver's License as Daniel Patrick. Patrick was nervous and shaking visibly when looking through his documents. While standing outside his window, I caught the odor of marijuana coming from inside the vehicle. I also noticed what appeared to be a weapon of some sort between the door and driver's seat. It was black and had what appeared to be a taped handle. I recognized it as likely being a knife or club. I had Patrick open the door. I took possession of the object, which was a club that Patrick explained he uses to beat out the pocket on a baseball glove. I had seen a baseball glove in the back of the car. The club was light and did not pose any significant threat. While the door was open, I observed a dark container that is consistent with one commonly used to hold illegal narcotics in the driver's side door pocket. I continued to detect the distinct but fleeting smell of marijuana coming from the vehicle. I asked Patrick if there was any marijuana in the vehicle. He advised there was and pointed out the container I had seen in the door pocket. I had Patrick exit the vehicle. I searched Patrick but did not find any additional contraband. I removed the container and found it contained what I knew from my training and experience to be loose marijuana.



I then went to the passenger side and had the passenger, identified to me as Cassandra Yensi, exit the vehicle. I had Yensi leave her purse in the vehicle (which she tried to take with her) as I had probable cause to search the vehicle and its containers based on locating the marijuana. I subsequently searched the vehicle. I located another bag with marijuana in the center console. I checked Yensi's purse and located a small Ziploc style plastic bag with a small amount of white powder. I know from my training and experience that bags like this are often used to store illicit substances, usually cocaine. I located several pills which I suspected was Adderall, a Schedule II Controlled Substance. I took possession of one of the pills to confirm. I did not find any other contraband in the vehicle.

I tested a part of the powder in the bag using an NIK Field Test Wipe for Cocaine. It reacted positively for the presence of cocaine. I was unable to test the marijuana on scene but its odor, packaging and texture was consistent with marijuana which I have seen many times in my career. I also checked drugs.com and confirmed the pill was Adderall, a Schedule II Controlled Substance.

I read Yensi her Miranda Rights from a prepared text. She indicated that she understood and agreed to speak with me. Yensi stated that the pill was her Adderall and she has a prescription. I asked Yensi about the plastic bag. She denied that it was hers.

I advised Yensi that she was under arrest and had her put her hands behind her back. I secured Yensi in handcuffs, which due to Yensi's small wrists were put on the smallest settings. I was there for unable to double lock them. I transported Yensi to the Jupiter Police Department for processing and subsequently transported her to the Palm Beach County Jail where I charged her with Possession of Cocaine per FSS 893.13(6)(A).

The above investigation was captured on my department issued body worn camera and Officer Smith's BWC.
