PROBABLE CAUSE

On October 10, 2017, I was on patrol in Palm Beach County. Dispatch advised me that the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office had a vehicle stopped and they needed assistance. When I arrived on scene, I observed a red in color HYUN, with a Florida plate of BLQ6J. I observed a white male wearing pink button up shirt and blue pants. Upon speaking with CPL. B. PARENT he informed me of why he stopped the vehicle. He performed an HGN test on the driver, Chad Ashley Wakefield. He informed me that he had observed HGN. While talking to Mr. Wakefield, I observed the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath. I also observed that she had blood shot eyes and a slight orbital sway. Mr. Wakefield repeated himself multiple times and would ask repetitive questions. I requested that he conduct field sobriety exercises. He consented.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus

I checked his eyes and observed equal tracking and equal pupil size. During the exercise I observed 6 of the 6 possible clues.

- Lack of smooth pursuit, left eye
- Lack of sooth pursuit, right eye
- A distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in the left eye
- A distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in the right eye
- An onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in the left eye
- An onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in the right eye

During the exercise Mr. Wakefield had to be told to stay in the proper position and not to move his head during the exercise. Mr. Wakefield kept closing his eyes. He said the sun was to bright, we relocated positions away from the sun. Mr. Wakefield still continued to close his eyes. I also observed Mr. Wakefield to have an orbital sway.

Walk and Turn Exercise

The area was level and free of debris. Mr. Wakefield indicated that he observed the dark line on the ground. Mr. Wakefield began the exercise too soon and had to be told to wait and to get back into the starting position multiple times. He kept asking me why he was doing these exercises. He began the exercise and all steps were not heal to toe. He used her arms for balance and raised them higher than 6 inches. After the first nine to heal steps Mr. Wakefield did not return nine steps back, he stated he has a bad knee. I allowed him to try again, but he refused.

One Leg Stand Exercise

During instructions, Mr. Wakefield said he cannot perform due to the fact he has large thighs. Mr. Wakefield began and raised his right foot. During the exercise Mr. Wakefield displayed an orbital sway and had to use his arms multiple times to keep from losing balance. He raised his arm approximately 10 inches away from his body. He also did not raise his foot six inches off the ground. He raised her foot approximately 3 inches. He did not look down at his foot during the exercise. After nine seconds he stopped the exercise. He kept stating he was being set up.

Finger To Nose

He was instructed to raise his hand in the following order, left, right, left, right, and right, left. He started the exercise before being asked to begin. When told to begin, he did not start right away.

- Left: Used his Right hand. Missed nose slightly.
  - Right: Used his Left hand. Missed nose.
  - STARTED OVER: He said he could not hear.
  - Left: Missed nose slightly. Did not return immediately to side
  - Right: Missed nose slightly. Did not return immediately to side
  - Left: Missed nose slightly. Did not return immediately to side
  - Right: Missed nose slightly. Did not return immediately to side
  - Right: Went to raise left hand. Missed nose slightly. Did not return immediately to side
  - Left: Missed nose slightly. Did not return immediately to side
- While conducting the exercise I observed an orbital sway.

At approximately 3:37 PM, I placed Mr. Wakefield in handcuffs and under arrest for DUI (F.S. 316.193.) he was searched. He was then secured in my patrol car. I then transported him to the Palm Beach County jail. Once arrived at the jail, I conducted a twenty minute observation of Mr. Wakefield. At no time did he regurgitate or take anything by mouth. He was asked to provide a breath sample on camera. Mr. Wakefield Refused at approximately 5:00 PM.

<p><b>On above date and time I was south bound on I-95 from North Lake Blvd merging on to I-95 into the center lane, when I saw in my rear view mirror a 2013 red Hyundai traveling at high rate of speed coming up behind me merging to the third lane of travel, almost side swiping me on the left side of my patrol vehicle. I then got behind the vehicle and called in the tag #BLQ6J and activated my blue lights and pulled the vehicle over south bound on I95 about a 1/4 mile north of Blue Heron Blvd. onto the right shoulder of the roadway. A records check through Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office revealed that the subject had a suspended driver's license issued on 08/07/17 financial responsibility and a seize tag order. I then made a passengers approach for officer safety and had the driver of the vehicle roll his passenger window down, the driver's window was already down. The driver was identified by his Florida driver's license as Chad A Wakefield DOB 08/12/1975, W/M. I then told Wakefield that he almost side swiped the left side of my vehicle causing me to due a evasive maneuver to keep from crashing. The driver could not produce a insurance card, a records check from DAVID showed that USAA had canceled his insurance policy in May 2017. I then issued Wakefield three traffic citation, careless driving, DWLS, no proof of insurance. When I returned to the vehicle to have him sign the traffic citations, I had Wakefield roll up the drivers window, I then could smell a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the cab of the vehicle. I could also see that Wakefield was chewing gum frantically and had watery blood shots eyes. I then called for a back up officer so the I could check his eyes. I performed a Horizontal gaze nystagmus in both left and right eye there was a lack of smooth pursuit. Both the left and right eye there was a distinct jerking at maximum deviation and an angle of onset prior to 45 degrees. Based on my training and experience I requested that Florida Highway Patrol Trooper Petti # 4198 perform roadside tasks and perform a DUI investigation.</b></p>
