Probable Cause

***Rough Arrest Report

On 2/9/2018 I was traveling north on Interstate 95 and took the exit to westbound Indiantown Road. Just after exiting the off ramp while traveling westbound on Indiantown Road in the far right travel lane I observed a black Ford SUV pass me at a high rate of speed in the far left travel lane. I changed lanes from the far right travel lane to the far left travel lane and accelerated to overtake the black Ford SUV. The driver of the black Ford SUV changed lanes from the far left to far right travel lane continuing to move at a high rate of speed. I paceclocked the vehicle at 68mph in a posted 50mph zone. I got behind the vehicle and activated my emergency equipment to conduct a traffic stop. The vehicle pulled to the right shoulder of the roadway just west of Cortona Boulevard. The stopped vehicle was a black Ford

SUV with an attached Florida tag of MBU389. I approached the front right passenger window and spoke to the driver. After identifying myself I asked the driver for her license, registration and proof of insurance. She provided the requested documents along with a Florida drivers license which I used to identify her as Chelsea Elizabeth Hughes (FL DL: H220105917560). I informed her that the reason why I stopped her was her excessive speed. As I stood next to the passenger side window I smelled the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the interior of the vehicle. I also noticed a red plastic cup with an orange colored liquid (small amount at the bottom and droplets along the interior sides) resting inside a purse that was in plain view on the front right passenger seat. Later upon closer examination the plastic cup had the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the remnants of the orange liquid. I asked the driver where she was coming from and she stated she was driving home from work. I asked her where she worked and she stated that she worked at a law office. I returned to my patrol vehicle and ran the driver through FCIC/NCIC to confirm that her license was valid which it was. I exited my patrol vehicle and approached the drivers side window to speak with the driver. While standing next to the driver side window I continued to smell the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the interior of the vehicle. The driver was wearing sunglasses which I asked her to remove and she complied removing the sunglasses. While speaking to the driver I observed that her eyes were red and glassy. Her face was red and flushed as well. I also noticed that her speech was slightly slurred. I informed her that I smelled the strong odor of alcohol coming from the vehicle. She stated that what I was smelling was alcohol coming from the red plastic cup and that she poured it out but denied drinking any of it. I asked her if she had anything to drink today and she stated that that she didn't. I returned to my patrol vehicle and notified Dispatch about my status and location. I returned to the driver side window of the vehicle and asked the driver if she would perform standardized field sobriety exercises which she agreed to perform. I had her exit the vehicle and stand along the north sidewalk area of Indiantown Road while I moved the black Ford SUV off the roadway and up the curb into the grass. I then moved my patrol vehicle to the grassy area behind the black Ford SUV. I placed blue colored ducktape on the ground of the sidewalk in a straight line in preparation for the exercises. I asked the driver if she agreed that the area where the field sobriety exercises would be performed was relatively flat and free of obstructions and she agreed based upon the area we were in. Before starting the exercises I asked her if she had any medical conditions and she stated no. I asked if she wore glasses or contacts and she stated no. I asked if she had any injuries and she stated no. The results of those exercises are summarized below. Each exercise was explained and demonstrated when applicable prior to the subject attempting the exercise.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus

- Horizontal gaze nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes
- Unsmooth, jerky tracking of the stimulus in both eyes
- Eyes appeared red and glassy

Walk and Turn Exercise (subject was barefoot during exercise)

- Did not stay in starting position as instructed
- Started exercise before being instructed

The driver then refused to complete the exercise and stated that she wanted a breathalyzer test performed immediately. She stated that she wouldn't blow a 0.00 but it wouldn't be over a 0.08. Based upon the totality of the circumstances I determined that there was probable cause to believe that Chelsea Elizabeth Hughes committed the offense of driving under the influence by being in actual

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physical control/operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol or any controlled substance per Chapter 893, while their normal faculties were impaired. I then placed the Ms. Hughes under arrest for DUI and handcuffed her behind her back. Florida Wildlife Commission (FWC) Officer Morrow (female) arrived on scene and patted down the subject before she was placed in the backseat of my marked patrol vehicle. The driver's father arrived on scene and took possession of the black Ford SUV. I then transported the driver to the Palm Beach County Breath Alcohol Testing (BAT) Facility. After a 20 minute observation period where the driver did not ingest anything by mouth I asked her to provide a breath test to test for the alcoholic content of her breath. She refused. I then read the Florida Implied Consent warning and again asked her for a breath test sample. She refused a second time. Ms. Hughes was issued a DUI citation along with a citation for the excessive speed. She was booked without incident. All events occurred in Palm Beach County, FL.

Note: A more detailed probable cause statement will be submitted to the State Attorney at a later time.


