PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)
Officers responded to the area of S.R. 809 (Military Trl.) and Indian Creek Parkway in reference to a suspicious vehicle stopped on the median, just south of this location. Officers arrived on scene and observed a black 2012 Hyundai Elantra bearing FL tag # Y55GJP stopped, facing southwest, on the positive median barrier. The vehicle had both driver tires on the grassy median, the rear passenger tire on the median, and the front passenger tire was in the inside southbound lane of S.R. 809. Officer Fandrey advised me he observed Christian Velasquez (w/m; 06/21/1985) sitting in the driver seat of the vehicle. Officer Fandrey advised the vehicle was running, the transmission was in reverse, and Velasquez appeared to be sleeping behind the wheel. Officer Fandrey further advised Velasquez was the sole occupant of the vehicle. See supplement from Officer Fandrey.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Upon arrival, Velasquez was standing in front of Officer Fandrey's patrol vehicle. I observed Velasquez had extremely bloodshot, glassy eyes. Velasquez appeared to have slurred speech, although he spoke broken English. I attempted to converse with Velasquez however, due to the language barrier, I was unable to hold a conversation with him. Due to my observations of Velasquez and the fact that he was in actual physical control of a motor vehicle at the time of his contact with the initial responding officer, I requested a Spanish-speaking officer respond to the scene in order to assure Velasquez understood what I was requesting and why I was requesting he complete roadside tasks. PFC Quiros arrived and provided translation.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Velasquez advised he was coming from Colombia and appeared to be unsure of what I was asking him about when I initially asked where he was coming from. Eventually, Velasquez advised he was coming from a party where he consumed approximately 3 alcoholic beverages. Velasquez advised he did not know how his vehicle ended up stopped on top of the grass median and stated his friend was driving the vehicle, despite the fact that Velasquez was observed in the driver seat with the vehicle in gear and running.

ODORS:

Strong odor of unknown alcoholic beverage on breath which intensified as Velasquez spoke.

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

SPEECH: Broken English, Roadsides translated by fluent Spanish-speaking officer (PFC Quiros)

ATTITUDE: Calm, Cooperative, Respectful

CLOTHING: Black/red/yellow striped collared shirt, blue jeans, orange shoes.

MEDICAL/OTHER: None stated.

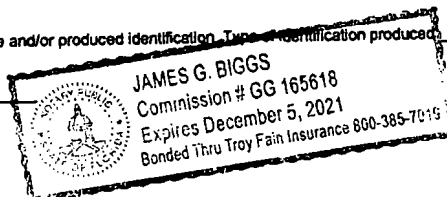

Other Observations:

During the administration of the task, I observed Velasquez swaying from side to side while I administered the task. I observed lack of smooth pursuit in both Velasquez' left and right eyes. I observed distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both Velasquez' left and right eyes. I observed the onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in Velasquez' left eye but was difficult to tell if it occurred in Velasquez' right eye because he would slightly move his head to the right as I was checking.

WALK & TURN

Velasquez stood in the correct starting position and remained in that position during the Instructions Stage. When advised to begin, Velasquez took 12 steps in one direction, missing heel-to-toe on every step. Velasquez continued past the instructed 9 steps, taking an incorrect number of steps. Velasquez shuffled both his feet to turn around, instead of taking a series of small steps with his trailing foot, as instructed. After turning improperly, Velasquez paused for several seconds, looking at me, as if he was waiting for my approval or waiting for a response from me. Velasquez began walking back down the line, again taking an incorrect number of steps (8). Velasquez missed heel-to-toe on each step back down the line. Velasquez stepped off the line, to the right, on step 7.

ONE LEG STAND:

Velasquez raised his right foot off the ground. I observed Velasquez swaying from side to side while completing the task. Velasquez appeared to be confused as to how he was supposed to count during this exercise, although the instructions were explained to him in both English and Spanish. Velasquez eventually began counting after approximately 15 seconds and placed his foot down on his count of "1012".

FINGER TO NOSE:

Although Velasquez was explained the instructions to this task in both English and Spanish, Velasquez appeared to be confused as to how to conduct the task, at first. On the first call of left, Velasquez touched the pad of his finger to the tip of his nose and did not return his hand to his side. On the first call of right, Velasquez raised his left hand initially, then touched the pad of his right finger to the tip of his nose. On the second call of left, Velasquez touched the pad of his left finger to the tip of his nose. On the second call of right, Velasquez touched the pad of his finger to the tip of his nose. On the final call of right, Velasquez raised his left hand and almost touched his left finger to his nose before correcting himself and touching the pad of his right finger to the tip of his nose, not returning his arm to his side. On the final call of left, Velasquez appropriately touched the tip of his finger to the tip of his nose.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

Velasquez did not recite the alphabet in a slow, non-rhythmic manner. Velasquez recited the alphabet in Spanish. Velasquez quickly began reciting the alphabet and mis-spoke several times during the exercise. Velasquez was reciting the alphabet so fast that the translating officer was unable to write down exactly what Velasquez was saying. See body camera video for exact recitation. Velasquez was unable to recite the entire alphabet and appeared to forget the order of the letters around the middle of the alphabet. Velasquez advised he had completed college and further stated that the alphabet was difficult for him to remember at the time.
