<p>On Saturday 11/12/16 at approximately 2105 hours I was dispatched to the rear parking lot of Double Roads Tavern (251 S US Hwy 1), In reference to suspected drug activity. Upon my arrival I viewed Officer M. Quiros speaking with a subject in the driver's seat of a 2004 blue Lexus bearing FL #CRNM69.</p> <p>As I began approaching the left side of the vehicle Officer M. Quiros told me he viewed the subject in the driver's seat attempting to do a "line" of suspect cocaine. Officer R. Kolenich approached the vehicle from the right side and stoodby with the front right passenger. I then opened the back left door, and asked the male subject in the back left passenger seat (later identified as W/M Arnold Geiger 6/11/80) to step out of the vehicle. Due to the suspected drug activity, Geiger was immediately placed into protective custody. I then had the subject in the driver's seat (later identified as W/M James Reger 12/27/84) exit the vehicle. As Reger opened the driver's side door, I viewed a small plastic bag containing a white powdery substance on the floorboard by his feet. Due to my training and experience I know this white powdery substance to be suspected cocaine. After Reger stepped out of the vehicle, he was placed into handcuffs and escorted to the backseat of my patrol vehicle #1613. Officer R. Kolenich assisted the front right passenger (later identified as W/F Christie Barbato 2/27/87) out of the vehicle and placed her into handcuffs.</p> <p>After seperating, and placing all three subjects into handcuffs, I approached Geiger. I read Geiger his miranda rights as witnessed by Officer M. Quiros, and Geiger confirmed he understood them. I asked Geiger if he knew of the drug activity in the vehicle and he stated "I am drunk, I was just trying to get a ride home". I asked Geiger if he was friends with Reger and Barbato and he stated he was introduced to them by a mutual friend and they agreed to give him a ride home.</p> <p>I then spoke with Reger, and read him his miranda rights. I asked Reger if he understood</p>

the miranda rights to which he replied "yeah, I just dont want to lose my job". I told Reger an officer on scene witnessed him with the suspected cocaine and I asked Reger the investigative question, "that is cocaine in that bag, correct?". To which Reger replied "yes, I just wanted to do a little bit to wake me up for the ride home". I asked Reger if there was any other drugs in the car and he replied "I dont know man, I work at Harbourside I dont want to lose my job".

While walking towards Barbato (now sitting on a curb to the right of the vehicle) I was informed by Officer R. Kolenich he read Barbato her miranda rights. Officer R. Kolenich also told me, prior to removing Barbato from the vehicle he asked her if she had anything illegal on her, and Barbato removed two small plastic bags from her bra and placed them on the center console. At this time, in addition to the small clear plastic bag containing suspected cocaine on the driver's seat floorboard, laying on top of the center console I viewed a small clear plastic bag containing suspected cocaine, and a small clear bag with a seal, containing a portion of a white pill. I asked Barbato if the two bags on top of the center console were hers and she stated "yes". I then asked Barbato the investigative question, if the "if the powder is coke, what is that pill", to which she replied "its a piece of my xanax I take it for anxiety". I asked Barbato her relationship with Reger, and Geiger and she stated she has never met Geiger before, but she was just trying to get home from work. I asked Barbato "where do you work" and she replied "I just got out of work at Sunset Cigar Bar".

While conducting a search incident to arrest of the vehicle, I opened the center console and found a sandwich sized clear plastic bag containing seven individually wrapped clear plastic bags of suspected cocaine.

I asked Geiger again if he knew of any cocaine in the vehicle and he replied "I cant use cocaine I have a bad heart". Due to Geiger not being in either actual or constructive possession of any illegal drugs, he was removed from handcuffs and left the area. A field interview report (FIR) of Geiger was completed.

Due to Reger being the registered owner of the vehicle, I grabbed the sandwich sized bag containing the seven bags of suspected cocaine and showed it to Reger while stating, "I found this in the center console of your car, is this yours". To which Reger replied yeah, that can be mine too.

Officer K. Pope responded to the scene and searched Barbato. Barbato was then placed into the back of patrol vehicle #8015. I notified Northcom that Reger and Barbato were both under arrest for felony drug possession and Officer R. Kolenich and I drove Reger and Barbato to the Jupiter Police Department Holding Facility.

After placing Reger and Barbato into separate holding cells, Officer K. Pope used a cocaine testing kit on the suspected cocaine on the driver's seat floorboard, and the




<p>suspected cocaine on the center console. Both cocaine test kits turned a blue/pink color, indicating the white powdery substance was in fact cocaine. I then used an online drug identifier website to view a picture of a xanax pill. The color, and what appear to be markings on the white pill were a match to xanax, but I did not have enough of the xanax to perform a drug test.</p> <p>Officer K. Pope weighed the cocaine belonging to Reger and I was informed the opened clear plastic bag containing cocaine on the driver's side floorboard weighed 0.6 grams, and the seven individually wrapped bags of cocaine weighed 5.99 grams.</p> <p>Officer K. Pope also weighed the small clear plastic bag of cocaine belonging to Barbato (0.33 grams), and the xanax (0.11 grams). The cocaine and xanax were submitted into Jupiter Police Department Evidence by Officer K. Pope.</p> <p>Based on the above described investigation, I believe probable cause exists to charge Reger with possession of cocaine with intent to sell (within 1000 feet of a business) contrary to FSS 893.13(1)(E)1.</p> <p>In addition, probable cause exists to charge Barbato with possession of cocaine contrary to FSS 893.13, and possession of a controlled substance.</p>
