I was on routine patrol in the area of Lake Ave. and S. Dixie Hwy. located in the City of Lake Worth, Palm Beach County, Florida when I observed a small, four-door, grey vehicle traveling westbound in the eastbound lanes of travel on Lake Ave. The vehicle made a left hand turn and began traveling southbound in the northbound lanes of travel of S. Dixie Hwy. I immediately drove my patrol vehicle behind the vehicle, and activated my blue and white emergency lights to initiate a traffic stop. As I did so, the vehicle immediately swerved to the right and drove up and over the median, and then back down onto the roadway before coming to a complete stop in the middle of the southbound lanes of the 200 block of S. Dixie Hwy. I provided PBSO dispatch with the Florida license plate of EFPH92, which came back as clear and not stolen.

I exited my patrol vehicle, and approached the driver side of the vehicle where I located a white female passenger. She was reaching for her cell phone, and visibly shaking while doing so. I asked her to put her phone down, but she appeared to either not hear me or chose to ignore me. A strong odor of some kind of air freshener was emanating from within the interior of the vehicle, as if it was just recently sprayed throughout the car as if to mask the odor of anything else. I was able to see the female sending a text message to someone asking to come pick her up before she locked her phone and set it down. I asked the female for identification, to which she provided a Florida driver's license identifying herself as the registered owner of the vehicle, Christina George. I asked George where she was coming from, to which she replied that she had just left Willie's Sports Bar (located at 127 N. Federal Hwy). I asked her what she had been doing there, to which she stated "I was hanging with some friends, having a few drinks". It should be noted that while speaking to George, I noticed her eyes appeared bloodshot, and she was continuing to shake even minutes into the traffic stop. Each time I asked a question, she would hesitate to answer, and it appeared as if it took a great amount of effort to both formulate a response as well as vocalize such an answer. Multiple times, George spontaneously uttered "please, don't arrest me. I can call my boyfriend and ask him to come pick me up". I asked George if she believed she felt as if she should be driving at this time, to which she responded "I don't want to talk anymore".

Based on the facts and circumstances presented to me at this time, I made contact with investigator Frey #9658, who responded to the scene and took over this investigation.

PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On 20Apr19 at approximately 0357hrs I arrived in the area of Dixie Highway and 2nd Ave S, in the City of Lake Worth, Palm Beach County, in reference to a Driving Under The Influence (DUI) investigation.

Upon arrival I met D/S A. Reyka (17180). She told me she was on patrol in the area of Lake Ave and Dixie Highway when she observed a gray sedan (FL tag EFPH92) traveling westbound in the eastbound lanes of Lake Ave. She observed the vehicle make a left turn (southbound) into the northbound lanes of Dixie Highway. She got behind the vehicle and activated her emergency lights to initiate a traffic stop. As she activated the lights on her marked patrol vehicle, the vehicle immediately swerved to the right. The vehicle drove up onto the raised median and into the inside southbound lanes of Dixie Highway where it came to a stop in the inside lane.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

D/S Reyka approached the driver's side of the vehicle. In the vehicle was a white female, later identified as Christine George by her Florida Driver's license. She said she was reaching for her cell phone and was "visibly shaking". D/S Reyka asked Christine to put the phone down but it appeared Christine did not hear her or was ignoring her. She told me there was a "strong odor of some kind of air freshener" coming from inside the vehicle. She stated it appeared that it was recently "sprayed". She observed Christine text an unknown person to come pick her up and then immediately locked her phone. She asked where she was coming from and Christine told her she was coming from Willie's Sports Bar (127 N. Federal Highway). D/S Reyka asked her what she was doing there and she responded "I was hanging with some friends, having a few drinks". D/S Reyka stated Christine's eyes were bloodshot and she was continuing to shake even after several minutes into the traffic stop. D/S Reyka stated that when she asked her a question she would "hesitate to answer, and it appeared as if it took a great amount of effort to formulate a response as well as vocalize such answer". Christine had made the spontaneous utterance several times of "please don't arrest me... I can call my boyfriend and ask him to come pick me up". She asked her if she should be driving at this time, to which she responded "I don't want to talk anymore". D/S Reyka completed a supplemental probable cause affidavit.

I then made contact with Christine. She was still sitting in her vehicle. The vehicle was running and the keys were still in the ignition. Her eyes were bloodshot and watery. She was swaying while sitting. Her speech was slurred when she spoke. I could smell the odor of an air freshener or fragrance coming from inside the vehicle. I asked her to step out the vehicle to talk to me. She had difficulty unlocking and opening the door. She stumbled and staggered as she walked to the front of my patrol vehicle. At the front of my patrol vehicle I could smell the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from her person and her breath. The odor got much stronger over time. She had difficulty standing with her feet together and had to keep wide stance to maintain her balance. Her body swayed when she did stand with her feet together. Although it was cool outside she was sweating.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

She told D/S Reyka she was with friends drinking at Willie's Sports Bar. She made the spontaneous utterance that she drank "3 hours ago" prior to the arrest.

ODORS:

The odor of an air freshener or fragrance coming from the vehicle and the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from her breath and person.

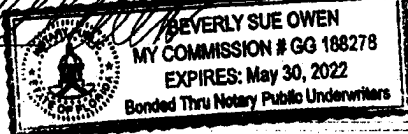

Other Observations:

I checked her eyes for Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN). She had bloodshot and watery eyes. She had equal tracking and equal pupil size. Her body swayed; she had difficulty standing with her feet together and had to keep widening her stance to maintain balance. In both eyes she had lack of smooth pursuit, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation, and the onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees. She had Vertical Gaze Nystagmus (VGN) but did not have Lack of Convergence (LOC). The task was completed on a dry and visually level surface.

WALK & TURN:

I instructed and demonstrated the walk and turn; she acknowledged she understood. She could not stand as instructed; she kept stepping off the line and raising her arms from her side for balance. She began to walk before instructed to do so. She walked 11 steps forward failing to maintain heel to toe and stepping off the line several times. She raised her arms from her side for balance. She turned incorrectly. She walked 9 steps back failing to maintain heel to toe and stepping off the line several times. She had to raise her arms from her side for balance. The task was completed on a dry and visually level surface using a yellow tape line.

ONE LEG STAND:

I instructed and demonstrated the one leg stand; she acknowledged she understood. She placed the right foot down several times. Her body swayed and she raised her arms from her side for balance. She hopped on her left foot. The task was completed on a dry and visually level surface.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I instructed and demonstrated the finger to nose; she acknowledged she understood. Her body swayed. On each command she touched the underside of her nose, the side of her nose, or completed missed her nose. The task was completed on a dry and visually level surface.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

She stated her highest level of education with a Bachelor's degree from FIU and her primary language was English. She stated she knew the English Alphabet. She recited the alphabet skipping and repeating several letters. During the task she opened her eyes and tilted her head forward attempting to remember the letters. The task was completed on a dry and visually level surface. I instructed the modified Romberg. She acknowledged she could estimate 30 seconds but could not do it while counting thousands (one-one thousand, two-one thousand,). She had to complete the task by counting normal. Her estimate of 30 seconds was approximately 30 seconds; her body sway. The task was completed on a dry and visually level surface.

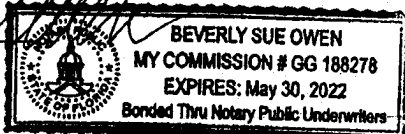
