On the 25TH day of NOVEMBER 20 19 at 1630 ☐ A.M. ☒ P.M. (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.) On 11/25/2019, I was dispatched to a crash that occurred in the area of North Dixie Highway and 4th Ave North in the city of Lake Worth Beach. Upon my arrival, I met with D/S Cruz 9990, who advised that one of the drivers of the crash may be intoxicated. D/S Cruz advised me of the driver and he was identified by the driver's FL DL, Christopher James Stellas. D/S Cruz advised that she observed the driver to have red eyes and obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from the driver's mouth area and breath she was speaking with him. I observed the driver on the sidewalk close to D/S Cruz's vehicle and observed the driver to have red, bloodshot and watery eyes. While speaking to D/S Cruz, I observed Christopher approach me at the driver's side door of D/S Cruz, and he began speaking. Once doing so I observed Christopher to have an obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his mouth area and breath. I also observed Christopher to have a discolored tongue with yellow film on top. D/S Cruz advised me that she had concluded her crash investigation. I then made contact again with Christopher and asked him to step towards my marked patrol vehicle and he agreed to do so. Upon reaching my marked patrol vehicle, I advised him that D/S Cruz had concluded her crash investigation and that I will be conducting a criminal investigation. I then read Christopher his constitutional warnings from a card and he advised that he understood. I asked Christopher what happened today and he advised that he was driving and there was the other vehicle that was weaving in and out of traffic and then that same vehicle collided with his vehicle. He advised that he was driving and the only occupant of the vehicle. I asked Christopher if he had anything to drink today and he advised that he did have some to drink at his shop. I advised Christopher of my observations of the obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his mouth area and breath and he advised that it may be because he had an alcoholic beverage earlier. Christopher advised that he had 2 drinks today, one at about 6:00 hours and the other at 1:00 hours. I asked Christopher if he has any medical problems and he advised that he does not have any. I then asked Christopher if he would be willing to perform roadside exercises and he agreed to do so. Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus - Left eye - lack of smooth pursuit - Right eye - lack of smooth pursuit - Left eye - distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation - Right eye - distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation - Left eye - onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees - Right eye - onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees - Observed subject to have red bloodshot and glossy eyes. Observed subject to have an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his mouth area and breath. Observed subject to have equal pupil size and equal tracking. Observed subject to have onset of nystagmus at approximately 30 degrees in each eye. Observed subject to have lack of convergence. Walk and Turn - Subject was provided a yellow line for the exercise. Subject advised that he did not have any physical injuries that would prevent him from performing the exercise. Subject was placed into the starting position and was provided the instructions. Subject advised that he understood and did not have any additional questions. Subject could not keep balance while in the starting position and came out of the position. Subject missed heel to toe on several steps. Subject did not turn as instructed by not taking several small steps to turn rather only taking one step to turn. Subject stopped off of the line. Subject took the correct number of steps for each nine heel to toe steps. One Leg Stand - Subject advised that he did not have any physical injuries that would prevent him from performing the exercise. Subject advised that he understood the instructions and did not have any questions. Subject advised that he was going to lift his left foot. Subject raised his left foot. Subject swayed during the exercise. Subject placed foot on the ground several times. Subject was advised to look down at his foot. Subject hopped during the exercise. Subject used arms for balance. Subject would not start from where he stopped when he placed his foot down and would restart from the beginning of his count. Finger to Nose - Subject identified his left, right, and index fingers correctly. Subject advised that he understood the instructions and did not have any questions. Subject had to be told to return to the starting position several times. Subject performed the task as follows, left, touched pad of index finger to tip of nose. Right, touched tip of right index finger to tip of nose. Left, touched left index finger to tip of nose. Right, touched pad of right index finger to tip of nose. Left, touched pad of left index finger to tip of nose. Romberg Balance - Subject advised that he understood the instructions and did not have any questions. Observed subject to have orbital sway forward and back about 2 inches both ways. Subject stopped the task at approximately 30 seconds. After roadside exercises were completed, Christopher was placed under arrest and advised that he was under arrest for DUI. He advised that he understood. I then searched him and placed him in the rear of my marked patrol vehicle and placing a safety belt on him prior to leaving the scene. Upon arrival to the Palm Beach County Jail, I escorted Christopher to the Breath Alcohol Testing center and conducted a 20 minute observation to ensure he did not take anything by mouth or regurgitate. After the 20 minute observation, Christopher was escorted to the testing room and was requested to submit to a breath test of his breath. Christopher advised initially that he does not want to and was advised of the implied consent. Upon reading him the implied consent, he advised that he will provide a breath sample. Shortly after agreeing to submit to a breath test, he advised that he does not want to provide a breath sample and will work it out with an attorney. I asked him again if he wanted to provide a sample of his breath and he declined to do so. This was taken as a refusal to submit to a sample of his breath to determine if alcohol content at approximately 1626 hours. Christopher was again advised of his constitutional warnings and he advised that he understood. He also agreed to answer questions (see questions and answers sheet). Christopher was then placed in a holding cell upon the completion of paper work. It was discovered that Christopher has a prior refusal to submit to a sample of his breath urine or blood through D.A.V.I.D. system. Christopher was later taken to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office jail for booking. Christopher was charged with DUI FSS 316.193(1) and DUI - Refusal to submit breath, blood, or urine 2nd refusal FSS 316.1939(1).

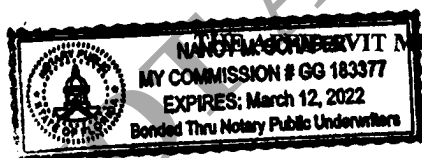

D/S Cruz advised that she observed the driver to have red eyes and obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from the driver's mouth area and breath she was speaking with him. I observed the driver on the sidewalk close to D/S Cruz's vehicle and observed the driver to have red, bloodshot and watery eyes. While speaking to D/S Cruz, I observed Christopher approach me at the driver's side door of D/S Cruz, and he began speaking. Once doing so I observed Christopher to have an obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his mouth area and breath. I also observed Christopher to have a discolored tongue with yellow film on top.

D/S Cruz advised me that she had concluded her crash investigation.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I then made contact again with Christopher and asked him to step towards my marked patrol vehicle and he agreed to do so. Upon reaching my marked patrol vehicle, I advised him that D/S Cruz had concluded her crash investigation and that I will be conducting a criminal investigation. I then read Christopher his constitutional warnings from a card and he advised that he understood.

I asked Christopher what happened today and he advised that he was driving and there was the other vehicle that was weaving in and out of traffic and then that same vehicle collided with his vehicle. He advised that he was driving and the only occupant of the vehicle. I asked Christopher if he had anything to drink today and he advise that he did have some to drink at his shop. I advised Christopher of my observations of the obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his mouth area and breath and he advised that it may be because he had an alcoholic beverage earlier. Christopher advised that he had 2 drinks today, one at about 0900 hours and the other at 1300 hours. I asked Christopher if he has any medical problems and he advised that he has [REDACTED] He advised [REDACTED] not taken it. Christopher advised that he does not [REDACTED]

I then asked Christopher if he would be willing to perform roadside exercises and he agreed to do so.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

After roadside exercises were completed, Christopher was placed under arrest and advised that he was under arrest for DUI. He advised that he understood. I then searched him and placed him in the rear of my marked patrol vehicle and placing a safety belt on him prior to leaving the scene. Upon arrival to the Palm Beach County jail, I escorted Christopher to the Breath Alcohol Testing center and conducted a 20 minute observation to ensure he did not take anything by mouth or regurgitate. After the 20 minute observation, Christopher was escorted to the testing room and was requested to submit to a lawful test of his breath. Christopher advised initially that he does not want to and was advised of the implied consent. Upon reading him the implied consent, he advised that he will provide a breath sample. Shortly after agreeing to submit to a breath test, he advised that he does not want to provide a breath sample and will work it out with an attorney. I asked him again if he wanted to provide a sample of his breath and he declined to do so. This was taken as a refusal to submit to a sample of his breath to determine its alcohol content at approximately 1826 hours. Christopher was again advised of his constitutional warnings and he advised that he understood. He also agreed to answer questions (see questions and answers sheet). Christopher was then placed in a holding cell upon the completion of paper work. It was discovered that Christopher has a prior refusal to submit to a sample of his breath urine or blood through D.A.V.I.D. system.

ODORS:

Christopher was later taken to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office jail for booking. Christopher was charged with DUI FSS 316.193(1) and DUI - Refusal to submit breath, blood, or urine 2nd refusal FSS 316.1939(1).

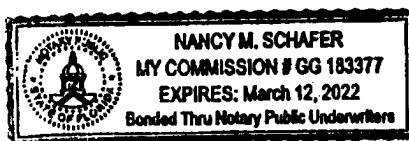

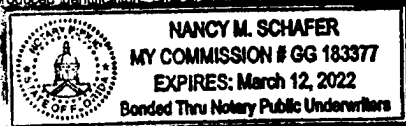
