Probable Cause

On Thursday, September 27, 2018 at approximately 12:11 a.m., our dispatch began receiving phone calls from passing motorist's regarding a S12W (Wrong way driver). The callers advised the vehicle was traveling southbound in the northbound lanes of travel. Our dispatched advised all units to "Be on the lookout". I was stationary working a detail within a construction zone northbound on Florida Turnpike (SR-91) north of Okeechobee Boulevard (SR-704). The inside travel lane was blocked off utilizing arrow boards, traffic cones, patrol vehicles. The workers were north of my location actively working.

The original caller advised the vehicle was possibly near the 107/106 mile marker. I began to be enroute northbound, then a S4 came out near the 99 mile marker, possibly related. I remained stationary due to the fact another unit was northbound approaching mile marker 97.

While stationary a construction supervisor pulled next to my patrol vehicle and advised he was just notified a vehicle crashed into his work crew near the 102 mile marker. Immediately advised our dispatch and was enroute. Upon my arrival I

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observed V01 at final rest, facing an eastern direction up against the right guardrail. All workers advised they were "OK" and advised the other driver was still within the vehicle. They advised no occupants exited the vehicle. I approached on the passenger side, the driver was sitting in the driver's seat. He opened the driver's door, and exited the vehicle holding a dog. As he was exiting, I walked and made contact on the driver's side. He advised he was by himself and no one else was in the vehicle. I verified and confirmed there were no passengers within the vehicle. During my traffic crash investigation, I was able to determine that this was the wrong way driver.

The driver advised he was not injured but Fire Rescue was still notified. The driver refused treatment by Fire Rescue on scene. The driver was identified by his Florida Driver License as Clifton Seosahai Jaikissoon, D.O.B. 04/25/1975. When Mr. Jaikissoon spoke, I smelt a strong unknown alcoholic beverage omitting from his breath. He was unsteady on his feet, and had slow lethargic movements. Based on all the physical indications observed, impairment was a factor in this traffic crash. After completion of the traffic crash investigation, I explained to Mr. Jaikissoon that the traffic crash investigation has been completed and he understood. He did not have any questions regarding the traffic crash. I explained to him that I was now going to conduct a DUI investigation, based on the indications of impairment. I read Mr. Jaikissoon his Constitutional Rights in which he acknowledged and understood. Mr. Jaikissoon advised he did not have any physical conditions that would prevent him from completing roadside exercises to check for impairment. I asked Mr. Jaikissoon if he was willing to perform roadside exercises to check for impairment, and he agreed.

I asked Mr. Jaikissoon if he had any alcoholic beverages today and he stated 3 drink which consisted of Captain, Grenadine and lime. He advised he departed High Spirits located on 45th Street and Military.

During the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Mr. Jaikissoon had lack of smooth pursuit in his left and right eyes, Nystagmus at maximum deviation in his left and right eyes, and Nystagmus onset before 45 degrees in his left and right eyes.

During the one leg stand Mr. Jaikissoon was unable to exercise. Put foot down more than 5 times.

For the walk a turn, the solid white edge line was used as a reference line. During the walk and turn Mr. Jaikissoon was unable to maintain the starting position, started before instructions were finished, doesn't touch heel to toe on any steps, and incorrect number of steps.

During the finger to nose, Mr. Jaikissoon touched his lower nostril, did not return finger back to starting position multiple times. When I advised right, he began to use his left before stopping and then using his right index finger.

After completion of the exercises Mr. Jaikissoon was placed under arrest and transported to the Palm Beach County BAT Center. While at the BAT center Mr. Jaikissoon provided two breath samples of .185 and .174. After completion of the paperwork, Mr. Jaikissoon was medically cleared at JFK and then was processed into the Palm Beach County jail.




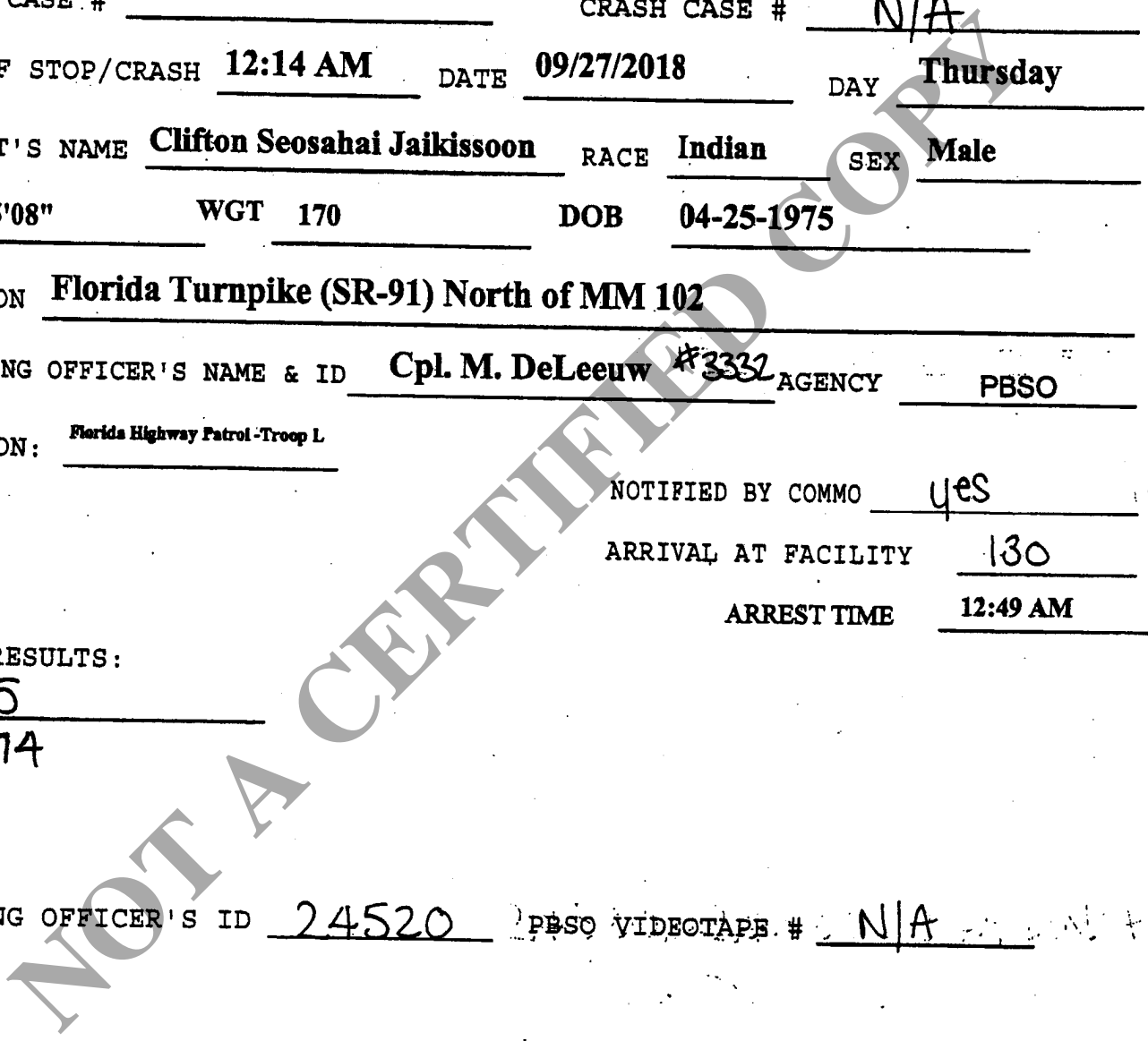
