D.U.I. PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On Monday October 02, 2017 at approximately 00:10 hours, Corporal Soriano #9418 and I were conducting speed enforcement in the 6000 block of Southern Blvd. Corporal (CPL) Soriano was utilizing his Stalker Lidar XLR Laser S/N LF003912 when he placed his red dot laser on a dark gray Subaru hatch back vehicle traveling at a visual estimated speed of 70 miles per hour (MPH) in a posted 50 MPH speed zone. Cpl Soriano received an audible tone from his laser's audio Doppler and a confirmation of 73 mph in the target window. Cpl Soriano then directed me to follow the vehicle westbound on Southern Blvd in order to conduct a traffic stop. Neither Cpl. Soriano or I lost visual of the vehicle and proceeded to overtake its speed. We observed the vehicle maintained its position in the number 1 lane, which is the lane closest to the median before it entered the left turn lane at the intersection of Southern Blvd and Sansbury Way. I observed the vehicle was a Subaru Crosstrek bearing Florida tag "HVV G66". I initiated my emergency red and blue lights while the vehicle was stopped for a steady red light. As I exited my vehicle to make a driver side approach on foot, the traffic left turn signal cycled green and the vehicle proceeded to make a left hand turn. I got back into my vehicle and once again proceeded to follow the vehicle with my emergency lights still activated. Once the vehicle cleared the intersection onto Sansbury way southbound, it came to a stop in the 100 block of Sansbury Way. I parked my patrol vehicle directly behind the Subaru and proceeded to exit my vehicle. I conducted a driver side approach on foot and made contact with the driver who verbally identified himself as Cory Windsor Sodergren. As he lowered his window, I detected a strong odor of marijuana coming from the interior of his vehicle. Sodergren was holding his valid Florida driver's license in his hand ready which he handed me as soon as he lowered his window. I asked Sodergren for his registration and proof of insurance at which time he had trouble obtaining. I observed he had watery eyes which were red and glassy. I observed a case of Stella Artois Belgium beer which was visible in the center of the rear seat. I introduced myself and explained to Sodergren that he had been stopped for an unlawful speed of 73 mph in a posted 50 mph speed zone. Sodergren appeared confused and at that time I once again explained to him why he was being stopped. As Sodergren responded to me, I detected a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his breath. I explained to him that I was under the suspicion that he may have consumed an unspecified amount of an unknown alcoholic beverage and that I wanted to make sure he was O.K. to drive before I let him go. I asked Sodergren if he would be willing to submit to a series of Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks (SFST's) to make sure he was O.K. to drive. Sodergren agreed and at that time I asked him to step out of the vehicle.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I observed that Sodergren was wearing blue pants and a blue shirt. While questioning Sodergren, I observed that he seemed to be confused by some of my questions. I noticed his eyes to be red and glassy. Sodergren was asked to exit the vehicle to perform field sobriety tasks and he agreed.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

I asked if Sodergren had been drinking or used any drugs and he stated "i had three beers at Mojito's. I asked Sodergren what medical problems and/or previous injuries hes had and he stated nothing. I asked if Sodergren wore glasses or contacts and he stated "He wore glasses but wasn't currently wearing them. I asked what medications he takes and he said none.

ODORS:

Obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage and strong odor of marijuana.

SPEECH: slurred, thick, unclear

ATTITUDE: calm, upset, angry



ROADSIDE TASKS

HORIZONTAL GAZE NYSTAGMUS:

Other Observations:

Once positioned in the front of my vehicle, I continued my investigation. I instructed Sodergren to keep his hands by his side, stand with his feet together, and follow a red light stimulus with his eyes not turning his head. I asked him if he understood my instructions. Sodergren verbally stated he understood my instructions. I observed both eyes to be red, bloodshot, and glossy. His left and right eye displayed equal pupil size, equal tracking, and a lack of smooth pursuit. I observed distinct and sustained nystagmus was present in both his left and right eye at maximum deviation during two separate four second evaluations. The onset of nystagmus was prior to a 45 degree angle in both his left and right eye during two separate four second evaluations. Vertical nystagmus was not present in both the left and right eye during two separate four second evaluations. While conducting the task I had to remind him not to turn his head and follow the stimulus.

WALK & TURN:

I positioned Sodergren on a painted white line which was on a smooth and level surface, free of any debris and well lit by the headlights on my vehicle. I instructed Sodergren to place his left foot on the line and his right foot in front of the left touching heel to toe. I instructed him that he was to keep his hands at his side and stay in this position until I instructed him to do otherwise. I instructed him to walk nine heel to toe steps counting out loud, while watching his feet. On the ninth step he was to keep his front foot on the line and use his back foot, in a series of small steps, to turn around before walking nine heel to toe steps the opposite direction counting out loud and watching his feet. I demonstrated the task while I was verbally instructing him in the proper way to complete the task. During the task, I observed Sodergren swayed while balancing, started too soon and did not touch heel to toe. Sodergren used arms to maintain balance (+6") and did not turn properly.

ONE LEG STAND:

I placed Sodergren with his feet together and arms at his side. I demonstrated the task as I verbally instructed him to raise one of his feet approximately six inches off of the ground, point his toe towards my patrol car, look at the raised foot, and count out loud 1001, 1002, 1003 and so on until told to stop. I asked him if he understood the instructions and demonstration I provided. After Sodergren stated he understood my instructions, the task was performed. While Sodergren stood in the instructional position, I observed he started too soon. While raising his foot he swayed while balancing and used hands more then 6" to balance himself.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I instructed Sodergren to stand with his feet together, make each hand into a fist keeping pointer finger extended and to place his palms facing up. He was instructed to lower his arms by his side. I instructed and demonstrated the proper hand and arm position and for him to remain in this position while I demonstrated the rest of the task. I instructed and demonstrated him to tilt his head back approximately 45 degrees and close his eyes while waiting for a verbal command of left or right. On the command of "left" or "right", he would raise the requested hand, touch the tip of his finger to the tip of his nose, then bring his hand immediately back down to his side. I asked him if he understood the instructions I provided and he verbally stated he understood. I instructed Sodergren to start the task as explained. During the task, I observed Sodergren failed to return his arms to his side and missed his nose. Sodergren started to soon and I had to remind him multiple times to keep his head tilted back at 45 degrees.
