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Upon arrival, I initially met with Tucker. Tucker had red scratches on the back of his neck, and an abrasion on his forehead. Tucker was stumbling and slurring his words. The odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage was emanating from his person. Tucker had a large wet stain on the front groin area of his pants, appearing to be urine.

Tucker advised me he came home from a party and went upstairs to greet his girlfriend, Linda Hanson (w/f 02/07/68), who he has been dating for seven years. Tucker told me Hanson was upset with him for going to the party and told him to go downstairs to sleep on the couch. Tucker advised he went downstairs with a bottle of wine he brought home and threatened to break Hanson's fish tank. Tucker told me Hanson instructed her son, Anthony Scarnato (w/m 06/17/99), to take him outside. Tucker advised Scarnato grabbed him around the neck and physically removed him from the house. Tucker said Scarnato had every right to throw him out of the house and believed Scarnato was just trying to defend his mother. Tucker denied touching Hanson in any way.

I then spoke with Hanson, who appeared distraught and had slight redness on the front of her neck. Hanson advised me she was upset with Tucker because he came home drunk. Hanson stated Tucker becomes violent and aggressive when he drinks, so she did not want him near her. Hanson told Tucker to go downstairs, which he did. Hanson said she heard Tucker tapping the glass of her fish tank. Hanson stated Tucker has broken her fish tanks before when he's gotten upset. Hanson went downstairs and saw Tucker near her fish tank with a glass wine bottle in his hand. Hanson said she stood in between Tucker and her fish tank to stop him from breaking it. Hanson advised Tucker grabbed her by her throat with one hand and pushed her out of the way. Hanson stated she doesn't believe Tucker was trying to strangle her. Hanson said she yelled for Scarnato and told him to get Tucker out of the house, because Tucker was becoming violent. Hanson told me Scarnato put Tucker into a headlock and dragged him out the front door in order to protect her.

I then spoke with Scarnato, who had no visible injuries. Scarnato advised he was upstairs when he heard his mother calling for him from downstairs. Scarnato ran downstairs and saw Tucker grabbing his mother around the neck area. Scarnato said his mother instructed him to get Tucker out of the house. Scarnato told me he wrapped his arms around Tucker's head/neck area and dragged him out the front door in order to protect his mother. Scarnato further explained Tucker becomes angry and aggressive when he drinks.

Based on my investigation, I found probable cause to charge Tucker with Simple Battery (Domestic), pursuant to FSS 784.03(1)(A)(A), because he intentionally touched his cohabitating girlfriend, Hanson, against her will. I placed Tucker into handcuffs in the rear, which I double-locked and checked for proper spacing.

I transported Tucker to the Palm Beach County Jail without incident.

Charges were not pursued against Scarnato because his actions were taken in order to defend his mother from possible injury.

Hanson was given a domestic violence packet.
