The vehicle was described as a black Mercedes Benz with a Florida tag of Y58 NPV. The person reporting the incident was Dave Pollock and he was following the car up from Broward County. The Mercedes Benz was headed northbound on Powerline Road and then went east on Palmetto Park Road. The car made a U turn and then went westbound on Palmetto Park Road. I was able to catch up to the car on Palmetto Park Road near the intersection of Lyons Road. I was in the right lane following the Mercedes Benz to observe a driving pattern. Several drivers around me were honking their horns to get my attention to alert me about the driver of the black Mercedes. I continued to follow the Mercedes and I observed the vehicle swerving within the right lane and make abrupt adjustments in an effort to maintain a straight line. The car was traveling just below the speed limit. It was clear to me that the driver was having difficulty operating the vehicle in a safe manner. The tag on the car had an expired sticker ,06/18. The Mercedes drove past SR #7 where I turned on my overhead lights. The car continued to Cartgena Dr. where the driver finally pulled over to the side of the road on Cartgena Dr.. I approached the driver , introduced myself and told her that her tag had an expired decal. She said she had the sticker in the glove box and she had not put it on the car yet. She had difficulty opening the envelope. She provided me with her Florida Drivers license and the picture matched the driver, H/F Christhelle Maria Medina dob 6/25/84. While speaking to her I noticed that her speech was slow and she seemed confused. Her eyes were glassy. She said she was going home to Lake Worth near I-95. I asked her if she knew where she was and she said, "No". I informed her she was in West Boca Raton. Because of the complaint call from Mr. Pollock, her driving pattern, and my observations at her car window, I called for a DUI officer to respond. While waiting for the DUI officer, I called Mr Pollock. He said he had been observing her driving in Broward County, swerving and leaving the roadway on to the grass several times. He said he has a dash camera and he recorded the driving patterns of the Mercedes Benz. Ms. Medina remained seated in her car until DUI Deputies Chiquito-Rodriguez and Schaefer arrived. Ms. Medina was turned over to DS Schaefer for further investigation.</p>

D.U.I. PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On 08/20/2018 at approximately 18:54hrs, I was called to the scene of a traffic stop near the intersection of West Palmetto Park Road and Cartegen Drive, which is located in unincorporated Boca Raton, Palm Beach County, Florida. I arrived at the scene at approximately 19:17hrs. D/S Eric Jensen #9582 relayed to me, and completed a written signed sworn supplemental Probable Cause Affidavit, that he had stopped the defendant's vehicle, a black 2014 Mercedes Benz C250 bearing FL tag Y58-NPV, because PBSO received a mobile call in reference to the defendant driving reckless and being possibly impaired. D/S Jensen noticed that the defendant had articulable indicators of impairment, so he called for a DUI unit to conduct a possible DUI investigation. D/S Jensen identified the defendant, to me, as the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle, at the time of the stop.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Upon making contact with the driver who was identified by her Florida driver license as "CHRISTHELLE MARIA MEDINA", I immediately detected an obvious and strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from her person and face area. MEDINA was still seated in her vehicle, in the driver seat. This odor intensified as I spoke to MEDINA. She had glassy, glazed, and blood shot eyes. MEDINA's speech was extremely slurred, slow, thick, and at times difficult to understand. Upon exiting her vehicle, MEDINA's movements were slow, deliberate, and lethargic with poor coordination. MEDINA needed the assistance of the driver door when exiting. MEDINA had an unsteady gate while walking to my patrol vehicle and had difficulty following directions given to her. MEDINA was wearing a workout tank top and shorts with brown sneakers. All the clothing appeared neat. MEDINA's behavior and emotional unsteadiness exhibited was consistent with that of extreme impairment.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Pre-Miranda: MEDINA stated she was drinking in Boca and had 2 Miller Lite beers. MEDINA refused to provide a breath sample after Implied Consent, which she stated she understood. MEDINA stated she did not understand her rights and refused to participate in the Q&A. (refer to video for detailed statements)

ODORS:

A strong and obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage was emitting from her person and face area which intensified as I spoke to Medina.

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

SPEECH: MEDINA's speech was slurred, slow, and thick, and at times difficult to understand.

ATTITUDE: emotional, annoyed, argumentative, belligerent

CLOTHING: workout tank top and shorts with brown sneakers

MEDICAL/OTHER: PTSD and schizophrenia with 11 different personalities

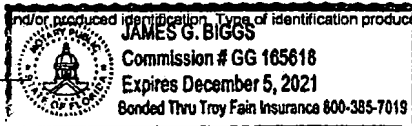

Other Observations:

MEDINA would sway roughly in a side to side front to back pattern throughout the task. MEDINA searched before touching the tip of the pen as directed to positively identify the point to be tracked. MEDINA was reminded numerous times to track the pen with her eyes only. MEDINA failed to keep her head still while tracking the stimulus and I had to have her hold her chin with her left hand and then hold her left elbow with her right hand to further stabilize her head. Medina had VGN.

WALK & TURN:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Walk & Turn" to MEDINA who stated she understood but was indifferent whether she can perform the task. During the task, I observed MEDINA to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. MEDINA could not maintain her balance while listening to instructions. MEDINA stepped out of the instructional stance during the demonstration to catch her balance. MEDINA started the task before being instructed to do so. She would stop walking to steady herself, with pauses to regain balance. MEDINA missed heel-to-toe steps and stepped off the line. MEDINA used her arms for balance by raising them more than six inches. MEDINA performed an improper turn by turning other than which was demonstrated. Additionally, MEDINA performed the incorrect number of steps.

ONE LEG STAND:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "One Leg Stand" to MEDINA who stated that she understood. During the task, I observed MEDINA to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. MEDINA continued to sway while balancing on one leg. MEDINA used her arms to balance raising them more than 6 inches from his/her sides. MEDINA started hopping in an attempt to maintain balance. MEDINA failed to count properly by thousands as instructed. MEDINA put her foot down to regain balance numerous times before the 30 seconds had elapsed. MEDINA put her foot down three times all before counting to 30 seconds, thusly not being able to complete the task.

FINGER TO NOSE:

MEDINA became overly emotional and aggressive during the explanation of this task. This task was not attempted due to MEDINA's state of anger and being uncooperative.

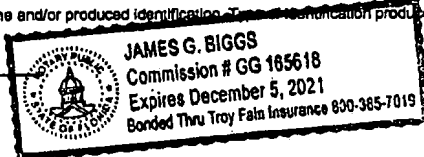

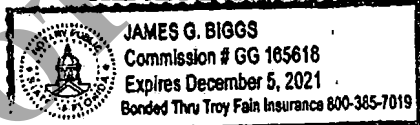
