PROBABLE CAUSE

On the date and time, I was responding to motor vehicle crash. Lake Worth Regional Communication Center (LWRCC) dispatched advised that the crash occurred northbound, on State Road 9 (I-95) around the area of Gateway Blvd. LWRCC dispatch further advised that it was a single vehicle, which collided with the concrete wall off the right paved shoulder. Once on scene, I located a white SUV style vehicle off the right paved shoulder, against the concrete wall, northbound on I-95, just before the exit ramp to Gateway Blvd. The white SUV was approximately 30 feet off the roadway, up a grassy hill against the concrete wall. I exited my marked patrol vehicle and approached the white SUV. I observed the white SUV to bear Florida License Plate number "035KBE". I further observed a white female in the driver seat; who was later identified by her Florida Driver's License number K-320-172-91-759-0 as DANA LAUREN KATZ, who was secured in the driver seat by a seatbelt. Ms. Katz was receiving medical attention by on scene EMS, then refused to be transported by Fire rescue shortly after. I then identified myself to Ms. Katz and reached inside the SUV and turned the vehicle and placed the keys on the dashboard. I then asked Ms. Katz if she could exit her SUV. Ms. Katz complied and did so.

Once Ms. Katz was out of the SUV, I helped escort Ms. Katz down the grassy hill to the right paved shoulder in front of my marked patrol vehicle to begin my crash investigation. I asked Ms. Katz what happened tonight causing the vehicle crash. Ms. Katz advised that she was traveling northbound, in the outside travel lane, on I-95. Ms. Katz then advised that her sandal fell off of her foot. Ms. Katz advised she reached down to get her sandal, and when she looked up she was traveling up the grassy hill towards the concrete wall. Ms. Katz advised that she then collided with the concrete median wall.

While speaking to Ms. Katz, I observed Ms. Katz to have an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from her mouth and breath area of Ms. Katz. I further observed Ms. Katz to have red glassy eyes, and some trouble balancing. I asked Ms. Katz if she consumed any alcoholic beverages before/while driving. Ms. Katz advised that she consumed two (2) beers around 4:00PM on the boat. Shortly after, I returned to my marked patrol vehicle to complete my crash investigation. Once finished, I returned to Ms. Katz and advised her that I have completed my crash investigation, and that I am now conducting a Driving under the influence (DUI) investigation. Ms. Katz advised she understood. I then read Ms. Katz her Constitutional Rights. After doing so, Ms. Katz advised she understood and would continue to cooperate throughout the DUI investigation.

I then asked Ms. Katz to again explain to me what happened causing the crash. Ms. Katz advised that she was traveling northbound, in the outside travel lane, on I-95. Ms. Katz then advised that her sandal fell off of her foot. Ms. Katz advised she reached down to get her sandal, and when she looked up she was traveling up the grassy hill towards the concrete wall. Ms. Katz advised that she then collided with the concrete median wall. I asked Ms. Katz to point at the vehicle she was driving at the time of the crash. Ms. Katz pointed at the white SUV bearing Florida License Plate number "035KBE" against the concrete wall. I asked Ms. Katz if she consumed any alcoholic beverages before/while driving. Ms. Katz advised that she consumed two (2) beers around 4:00PM on the boat. When asked, Ms. Katz advised she would perform Standardized Field sobriety exercises (SFSE)

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus exercise

Prior to beginning the exercises it was determined Ms. Katz was not wearing contacts. Ms. Katz eyes were checked and her eyes displayed equal tracking and her pupils were equal sizes. Ms. Katz was instructed to following the stimulus with her eyes only, keeping her head still. After stating she understood the instructions Ms. Katz attempted this exercise.

The results of this exercise displayed 6 of the 6 possible clues.

- A lack of Smooth Pursuit in her left eye.
- A lack of Smooth Pursuit in her right eye.
- A distinct and sustained nystagmus in the left eye at maximum deviation.
- A distinct and sustained nystagmus in the right eye at maximum deviation.
- An onset of nystagmus in the left eye prior to 45 degrees.
- An onset of nystagmus in the right eye prior to 45 degrees.
- The exercise further revealed the presence of vertical nystagmus. Vertical nystagmus is an indicator of high doses of alcohol, other central nervous system (CNS) depressants or inhalants, and the consumption of the drug phencyclidine (PCP).
- While performing the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus exercise, it was observed that Ms. Katz:
- Had difficulty following and responding to instructions.
- Swayed while standing.

Walk and Turn exercise

Prior to attempting this exercise, Ms. Katz indicated she did not have any medical problems that would have prevented her from performing the exercise. Ms. Katz advised that she was able to walk a straight line. Ms. Katz was instructed to put her left foot on the white line and her right foot in front of it with her right heel touching the toe of her left foot. She was instructed to stand in this manner with her hands to her sides until the exercise instructions were completed and the exercise demonstrated. Ms. Katz was instructed not to begin the exercise until told to start. She was instructed to take nine steps along the imaginary line in a heel-to-toe manner. After the ninth step she was to stop and turn around keeping her lead foot on the ground, taking several small steps with the

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other foot to turn around. After turning around she was to take nine steps in a heel-to-toe manner back along the line, in the direction she had come from. Ms. Katz was further instructed to watch her feet at all times while walking, keep her arms down to her side, and to count her steps out loud. After the exercise was demonstrated Ms. Katz stated she understood the instructions and was instructed to begin the exercise.

- After attempting the Walk and Turn exercise Ms. Katz displayed 2 of 8 possible clues.

Walk and Turn exercise observations:

- On the first set of steps Ms. Katz failed to walk in a heel-to-toe manner on 1,4,7,8,9 steps, - On the second set of steps Ms. Katz failed to walk in a heel-to-toe manner on 3,4,5,6,7,8,9 steps, -
- Turned incorrectly.

One Leg Stand exercise

Prior to attempting this exercise, Ms. Katz indicated she did not have any medical problems that would have prevented her from performing the exercise. Ms. Katz was instructed to stand with her heels together and hands down to her sides while the instructions were given and during the exercise. Ms. Katz was instructed not to begin the exercise until she was instructed to start, and after the exercise had been demonstrated. When instructed to start, she was to raise the foot of her choice off the ground approximately 6 inches. While her leg was raised she was to keep her leg straight, watch her raised foot, and to count out loud by thousands (one thousand one, one thousand two, one thousand three...) and to continue the exercise until told to stop (30 seconds). After this exercise was demonstrated and indicating she understood the instructions Ms. Katz attempted this exercise.

When Ms. Katz attempted this exercise she raised his left foot.

The result of this exercise displayed 1 of the 4 possible clues.

During this exercise Ms. Katz:

- Swayed during the exercise.

Modified Finger to Nose

I asked Ms. Katz to place her hands out to her side at a 45 degree angle close her palms, except her index finger. After doing so, I advised Ms. Katz when asked, to close her eyes and lean her head back. I will then call out left, or right (hand). Once I call out left or right hand, she was to touch the tip of her nose. Not her nostril, or bridge of her nose. Once Ms. Katz touched the tip of her nose, she was to return her hand to starting position (to the side at approximately 45 degrees) Ms. Katz advised she understood. Once started, Ms. Katz touched the bridge of her nose, sliding her index finger down to the tip of her nose. After, Ms. Katz completed each request properly.

Once I concluded the Finger to nose exercise, I asked Ms. Katz to perform the Modified Romberg Balance.

I then demonstrated to Ms. Katz the Modified Romberg Balance exercise. I advised Ms. Katz when asked to begin, to stand with her feet together, keep her hands down by her side, lean her head back and close her eyes. After doing so, Ms. Katz was instructed to estimate the passage of 30 seconds in Ms. Katz head without counting out loud, and when finished to open her eyes, bring her head back to a neutral position and say done. Ms. Katz advised she understood. Ms. Katz then began the exercise. Ms. Katz advised she was done at 26 seconds.

After I completed SFSE observations on Ms. Katz, I then placed Ms. Katz under arrest for suspected DUI of alcohol. I then escorted Ms. Katz to the rear of my patrol vehicle and secured her in. Shortly after, I departed the scene enroute to the Palm Beach County Jail. Upon arrival at the jail, I escorted Ms. Katz to the BAT center. There, I conducted a 20 minute observation period of Ms. Katz. Once the 20 minutes were up, I escorted Ms. Katz into the BAT room. Once there, I requested Ms. Katz to submit to a lawful test of her breath for the purpose of determining its alcohol content. Ms. Katz agreed to submit at 01:59AM. Ms. Katz provided an adequate breath sample of .130 at 02:03AM and another breath sample of .134 at 02:07AM. I then advised Ms. Katz of her Constitutional Rights. After doing so, Ms. Katz advised she understood. A brief Q&A was conducted, Ms. Katz was booked into the Palm Beach County jail on 316.193.1 Florida Statue Misdemeanor. All events occurred in Palm Beach County.
