	When I arrived at the top of the stairs, I observed Monica Figueroa, who was identified by her FL driver's license, standing in front of the door to apartment nine. I knew Figueroa from a call earlier this evening. See BRPD case 2018-9220 for more information regarding my initial contact with Figueroa. Figueroa was visibly upset and had a laceration to the right side of her forehead. She was screaming to the occupant inside of the apartment. Figueroa started to try and bang on the door at which time myself and the officers present restrained her in handcuffs to prevent further injuries to herself and for officer safety. Figueroa was bleeding and blood was dripping as she banged on the door. The occupant of the apartment then shoved Figueroa's phone through the broken glass opening in the door. I requested BRPD to respond to our location and Figueroa was brought out to the parking lot. I asked Figueroa how she got the cut and she advised that she came to her boyfriend's apartment to get her things. Her boyfriend is white male David Hannan, who I also knew from my previous call earlier this evening. She advised that Hannan let her into the apartment to talk about an argument that they had earlier in the day and to grab her belongings. According to Figueroa, Hannan no longer wanted her in the apartment and physically removed her by slamming her head against the door which in turn broke the glass that was in the door. She advised he continued to hit her and pushed her out of the apartment and then locked the door. I inspected Figueroa's head for injuries and observed that she had, what appeared to be a laceration on the back of her head about the size of a quarter. Figueroa also had a laceration to her left shoulder blade. She also had small abrasions on her legs. All of Figueroa's injuries were consistent with her account of what transpired inside the apartment. Pictures of Figueroa's injuries were taken and submitted into evidence. Figueroa was then transported to Boca Raton Reginal Hospital. Officer Herron rode with BRPD and accompanied Figueroa to the hospital.			

I went back to the apartment door to talk to Hannan. Hannan was reluctant at first to open his door and speak with us, he eventually complied. He did not want us to go inside his apartment. I observed that the door was off of the hinges and that the glass from the door was broken on the inside of the apartment. Figueroa's purse and shoes were located inside of the apartment, by the door. We conducted a protective sweep of the interior of the apartment to make sure there were no other persons in need of assistance inside. I observed broken glass on the floor inside the apartment. I observed Figueroa's small black purse and a pair of women's heels by her black purse.

I then spoke with Hannan about the incident and he advised that Figueroa was his girlfriend and that he did let her into the apartment to talk. I asked Hannan about the injury to Figueroa's face and Hannan did not give a direct answer. I noticed that Hannan had a hole in his shirt that was not there during my previous encounter with him this night during the above case. According to Hannan, Figueroa got upset during their talk and left on her own. When asked about why Figueroa's belongings were still in the apartment, Hannan claimed that she left them there from the day before. It should be noted that I observed Figueroa in possession of the purse earlier this night. Upon arrival to this scene, we also observed Hannan holding Figueroa's phone from inside of his apartment behind a closed, locked door while Figueroa was outside. Hannan then advised that he did not know how Figueroa got the injuries but that she broke the glass from outside of the door. It should be noted that the door had a metal grate that covered the glass from the outside and not the inside of the apartment. This would make it impossible to break the glass from the exterior unless a person had a small tool of some type, which I did not observe. It should be further noted that during Hannan's conversations with different officers, his story had changed multiple times. Hannan's story about what happened did not match with the evidence that I observed during my investigation. At one point, Hannan advised nothing physical occurred even when presented with the details of Figueroa's injuries. He also stated he was not sure how his shirt got ripped.

I made contact with RN Justin Snyder at Boca Regional via telephone who advised Figueroa will require staples to heal the laceration on her head.

Due to my investigation, the statement from Figueroa, Figueroa's injuries, the evidence I observed on scene and Hannan's inconsistent account, I placed Hannan under arrest for felony battery, dating violence pursuant to F.S.S. 784.04(1), since Hannan did cause permanent disfigurement to Monica. I handcuffed Hannan by checking for proper spacing and I ensured that the handcuffs were double locked. We secured Hannan's door to his apartment. I transported Hannan to BRPD booking facility.

Officer Tyson gave Figueroa a domestic violence pamphlet. Hannan was processed and turned over to county jail.
