ON SUNDAY, JULY 7, 2019 AT APPROXIMATELY 1930 HOURS, I, DEPUTY SCHNEIDER, WAS CONDUCTING SPEED ENFORCEMENT ON 50TH STREET SOUTH, PALM BEACH COUNTY FLORIDA, 33414 WHEN I OBSERVED A DARK IN COLOR PICK UP TRUCK TRAVELING EAST BOUND AT 60 MPH IN A POST 30 MPH SPEED ZONE. AS WE CONTINUED EAST THE VEHICLE APPROACHED A ROUND ABOUT AND WAS UNABLE TO PROPERLY NAVIGATE THE ROUND ABOUT AND FAILED TO MAINTAIN THEIR LANE AS THEY WENT THROUGH THE ROUND ABOUT. AT THAT TIME I ACTIVATED MY EMERGENCY LIGHTS TO CONDUCT A TRAFFIC STOP. THE DRIVER FAILED TO ACKNOWLEDGE THE TRAFFIC STOP AND CONTINUED EAST BOUND.

ONCE STOPPED I IMMEDIATELY APPROACHED THE VEHICLE. THE DRIVER HAD HIS DRIVERS LICENSE IN HIS HAND AND AS I STOOD AT THE DRIVERS DOOR I IMMEDIATELY NOTICED A STRONG ODOR OF AN UNKNOWN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE IN THE VEHICLE. I ASKED THE DRIVER, LATER BY HIS FLORIDA DRIVERS LICENSE AS DAX RANKINE WHO HAD BEEN DRINKING IN THE VEHICLE TO WHICH HE AND HIS PASSENGERS SAID NO ONE. I ASKED MR. RANKINE TO STEP OUT OF THE VEHICLE AND EXPLAINED THAT I WANTED TO REMOVE HIM FROM THE OBVIOUS ODOR IN THE VEHICLE AND I TOLD HIM I WAS GOING TO ASK HIM SOME RANDOM QUESTIONS. I ASKED HIM WHERE HE WAS COMING FROM AND DURING THE CONVERSATION I DETECTED MR. RANKINE HAD A STRONG ODOR OF AN UNKNOWN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE EMANATING FROM HIM. HE ALSO RED BLOOD SHOT EYES AND HE TOLD ME HE TOOK THE KIDS TO BINKS FOREST SO THEY COULD DRINK. WHEN ASKED ABOUT THAT HE CLARIFIED IT WAS KOOL AID.

AT THAT TIME INVESTIGATOR J. SCHAEFER WAS REQUESTED TO CONDUCT A DUI INVESTIGATION. UPON HIS ARRIVED AND I EXPLAINED WHAT I HAD OBSERVED AND I TURNED THE INVESTIGATION OVER TO HIM FOR FURTHER EVALUATION.

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On 07/07/2019 at approximately 19:36hrs, I was called to the scene of a traffic stop near the intersection of 50th Street South and 120th Avenue South, which is located in the Village of Wellington, Palm Beach County, Florida. I arrived at the scene at approximately 19:48hrs. D/S David Schneider #8723 relayed to me, and completed a written signed sworn supplemental Probable Cause Affidavit, that he had stopped the defendant's vehicle, a 2013 red Chevy Silverado bearing FL tag CZH-S72, because the defendant was speeding (60/30mph). D/S Schneider noticed that the defendant had articulable indicators of impairment, so he called for a DUI unit to conduct a possible DUI investigation. D/S Schneider identified the defendant, to me, as the driver of the vehicle, at the time of the stop.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Upon making contact with the driver who was identified by his Florida driver license as "DAX EVERARD RANKINE", I immediately detected an obvious and strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from his person and face area. This odor intensified as I spoke to Rankine. Rankine had glassy, glazed, and extremely blood shot eyes. Rankine's speech was somewhat slurred and slow. Rankine's movements were slow, deliberate, and lethargic with poor coordination. Rankine had difficulty following directions given to him. Rankine was wearing a blue t-shirt, print board shorts, and gray sandals. All the clothing appeared somewhat neat.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Pre-Miranda: Rankine stated he had consume only "1 Michelob Ultra and ate 1 slice of pizza".

Rankine refused to provide a breath sample after Implied Consent stating he wanted a lawyer. Rankine refused to participate in Q&A.

ODORS:

A strong and obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage was emanating from his person and face area which intensified as I spoke to Rankine.

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

SPEECH: Rankine's speech was somewhat slurred and slow.

ATTITUDE: talkative, indifferent, polite, cooperative, annoyed

CLOTHING: Rankine was wearing a blue t-shirt, print board shorts, and gray sandals.

MEDICAL/OTHER: none stated

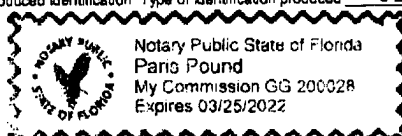

Other Observations:

Rankine would sway roughly in a side to side front to back pattern throughout the task. Rankine did touch the tip of the pen as directed to positively identify the point to be tracked. Rankine was reminded numerous times to track the pen with his eyes only. Rankine failed to keep his head still while tracking the stimulus. Rankine had VGN.

WALK & TURN:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Walk & Turn" to Rankine who stated the he understood. During the task, I observed Rankine to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. Rankine could not maintain his balance while listening to instructions and stepped out of the instructional stance during the demonstration to catch his balance. Rankine would stop walking to steady himself with pauses to regain balance. Rankine missed heel-to-toe steps and used his arms for balance by raising them more than six inches. Rankine continuously asked for confirmation of the instructions during the performance of the task, which he stated in the beginning that he understood.

ONE LEG STAND:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "One Leg Stand" to Rankine who stated that understood. During the task, I observed Rankine to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. Rankine continued to sway while balancing on one leg. Rankine used his arms to balance raising them more than 6 inches from his sides. Rankine failed to count out loud or properly by thousands as instructed.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Finger to Nose" task to Rankine who stated that he understood. During the task, I observed Rankine to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. Rankine's index finger did not touch the tip of the nose on 5 of 6 attempts. Rankine used the hand other than that which was called. The sequence used for this task was L, R, L, R, R, and L.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Rhombert Alphabet" task to Rankine who stated that he understood. During the task, I observed Rankine to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase swaying more than 2 inches. Rankine correctly recited the alphabet.

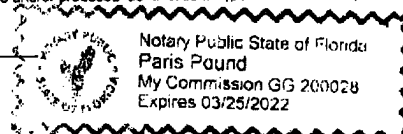

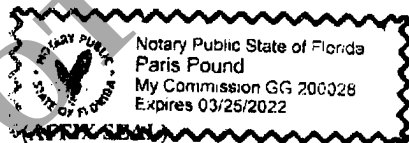

Refusal to submit to the test I have requested of you is admissible into evidence in any criminal proceeding.
