Probable Cause

On 12/03/2019 I Trooper Cheyenne Mack (4323/1593) with the Florida Highway Patrol was on patrol in Palm Beach County, Florida. I was in a marked FHP unit equipped with overhead emergency lights and external siren. At approximately 7:33 PM I was dispatched to a BOLO that occurring northbound passing Yamato Road. I was informed by dispatch that there was a witness following the vehicle and would stay behind it until we arrived. I started making my way towards the vehicle from Lantana Road.

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Sergeant Alacron #366 was able to find the vehicle and then position himself behind the vehicle and was able to obtain a driving pattern, he then activated his lights and sirens and initiated for the vehicle to pull over. As he got out and approached the driver of the vehicle he observed a white male behind the wheel. The vehicle bore a FL/TAG of Z74EJR it came back to a Blue Ford Pickup. I then identified the driver through FCIC/NCIC with his FL/DL (M531178560930) to Dennis Thomas Mandeville with a DOB of 03/13/1956.

Personal Contact: I then approached the vehicle on the driver's side and observed Mr. Mandeville behind the wheel of the vehicle. I observed Mr. Mandeville with glassy bloodshot eyes, and was flushed in the face. He also appeared confused as far as where he was going. I then had him step out of the vehicle and began asking some questions. I observed him unable to maintain his balance and was swaying. He advised me that he had been coming from Boca Raton and was heading to Boynton Beach. I asked if he had been drinking tonight and he stated yes and that he had two drinks specifically vodka. I then asked if he would perform some Field Sobriety Exercises which he agreed to. Mr. Mandeville had no medical or physical issues that would prevent him from performing any of the Exercises.

Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSE):

The area for the following roadside exercises was level hard surface and was free of debris. The weather was clear.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus:

I advised the subject to stand straight with their feet together and arms down by their side. I asked subject if they wear any glasses or contacts, they advised no just that he wears reading glasses. For the exercise, I used my issued red in color pen light. I asked the subject if they could see the red pen light, they stated yes. The subject was asked about any current medical conditions, they stated that they did not have any. I advised the subject to follow the red pen light with their eyes, and to not move their head. I asked subject if they understood the instructions I gave to them. They stated yes. I asked if they had any questions they stated no.

The following was observed during Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus:

The subject did have resting Nystagmus and dilated pupils.

- LT EYE-LACK OF SMOOTH PURSUIT
- RT EYE-LACK OF SMOOTH PURSUIT
- LT EYE-DISTINCT & SUSTAINED NYSTAGMUS AT MAX. DEVIATION
- RT EYE-DISTINCT & SUSTAINED NYSTAGMUS AT MAX. DEVIATION
- LT- EYE-ONSET OF NYSTAGMUS PRIOR TO 45 DEGREES
- RT- EYE-ONSET OF NYSTAGMUS PRIOR TO 45 DEGREES

Subject could not follow the tip of my finger with their eyes only. I had to instruct subject multiple times to keep their head straight and follow the red pen light with their eyes. While standing within proximity

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of the subject, I could detect a slurred speech from the subject, and their eyes were watery. I also observed the subject with a flushed face. Subject was swaying. Could not complete the entire exercise. The following was observed during Vertical Gaze Nystagmus:

- Could not complete due to subject not following directions.

Lack of Convergence:

- Subject had lack of convergence in both eyes. Subject was swaying.

Walk and Turn Exercise:

Interaction Phase:

The area for the following roadside exercises was level and free of debris. I had Mr. Mandeville imagine a white line directly in front of him.

I advised the subject to place their left foot on the white in color line and their right foot directly in front of it, touching heel to toe. I advised the subject to keep their arms down by their side and to stay in that position until I advise them to begin the exercise. This exercise was first explained to the subject then was demonstrated by myself. Subject advised that they would be able to perform the exercise. Subject advised that they had no injuries that would affect the exercise. Subject advised me that they understood instructions and did not have any questions.

- The following was observed during the instructional phase of the exercise:
The subject could not keep balance while in the starting position.

- The following was observed during the walking phase of the exercise:
The subject missed heel to toe on multiple steps. The subject performed an improper turn (not as instructed). Subject stopped after the turn. I had to repeat the instructions multiple times to the subject.

One Leg Stand Exercise:

The area for the following roadside exercises was level and free of debris.

I instructed the subject to stand with their feet together and keep their arms down by his side. I instructed the subject to stay in that position until I tell them to start the exercise. This exercise was first explained to the subject then was demonstrated by myself. Subject advised that they will be able to perform the exercise. Subject advised me that they had no injuries that would affect the exercise. Subject advised that they understood instructions and did not have any questions.

- The following was observed during the exercise:

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Based upon my observations and the totality of circumstances, Mr. Mandeville was placed under arrest for DUI pursuant to Florida Statute 316.193.1 at 8:04 PM. Mr. Mandeville was then searched and placed in my patrol vehicle, and transported to the Palm Beach County Jail. While in transport to the Palm Beach County Jail there was an obvious strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage within my vehicle that was not present prior to placing the defendant in the vehicle.

The defendant arrived at the Palm Beach County Jail at 8:26 PM. After the defendant's 20min observation, the defendant was then given the opportunity to provide a sample of his breath which he refused to provide. Mr. Mandeville refused at 8:52 PM.

Video of the traffic stop, roadsides and transport are available through the FHP custodian. The above incident did occur in Palm Beach County, Florida.

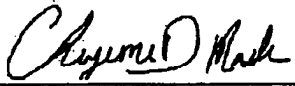
