On 10/12/16 at approximately 0040 hours I observed a pink Mercury bearing FL tag "AYPU14" traveling southbound on Military Trail just south of Atlantic Ave in Delray Beach within Palm Beach County, Florida. As the Mercury approached this intersection it was met by a red traffic signal for south bound traffic. The Mercury passed the clearly painted white stop bar on the roadway before coming to a complete stop. Upon the traffic signal turning green the Mercury turned eastbound onto Atlantic Ave; while traveling eastbound the Mercury failed to maintain its lane crossing the clearly painted white lines on the pavement.

A lawful traffic stop was conducted were I made contact with the driver explaining the reason for the stop. I asked the driver to provide her license and she identified herself as Elexus Kamen. It should be noted as I approached the vehicle I observed to driver spraying what smelled like perfume heavily throughout the vehicle. Although the smell of perfume was apparent I could also smell the odor of burnt Marijuana emitting from the vehicle. I told the driver I could smell Marijuana and Kamen stated she had smoked Marijuana in the vehicle earlier. Then went onto pull a clear plastic bag containing a green leafy substance (suspected Marijuana) from her purse. In plain view next to Kamen's right leg was a clear plastic cup containing an unknown liquid. Behind the drivers seat was a large glass bottle, containing roughly a third amount of a brown liquid. Through my training, knowledge and experience it appeared to be a "Captain Morgen" glass bottle.

While Kamen was speaking her speech was slow a slurred; she refused several times to look in my direction when I asked questions directed to her. I required Kamen to exit her vehicle; as she exited I observed she was unsteady on her feet. As Kamen walked from her vehicle the odor of Marijuana was also emitting from her person. Kamen went onto explainshe had been "drinking" earlier in the night.

The suspected Marijuana was tested using a PBSO issued Duquenois Reagent test kit; this test revealed the the suspected substance was in fact Marijuana. D/S Levey 9415 responded to the scene to conduct a DUI investigation, see Levey's report for further detail.

D.U.I. PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

ON 10/12/2016 AT APPROXIMATELY 0110 HOURS I RESPONDED TO THE 4100 BLOCK OF W ATLANTIC AVE, IN THE CITY OF BOYNTON BEACH, IN REFERENCE TO A TRAFFIC STOP. UPON MY ARRIVAL I MADE CONTACT WITH D/S COOK #16739 WHO ADVISED ME OF THE FOLLOWING.

ON 10/12/16 AT APPROXIMATELY 0040 HOURS I OBSERVED A PINK MERCURY BEARING FL TAG "AYPU14" TRAVELING SOUTHBBOUND ON MILITARY TRAIL JUST SOUTH OF ATLANTIC AVE IN DELRAY BEACH WITHIN PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA. AS THE MERCURY APPROACHED THIS INTERSECTION IT WAS MET BY A RED TRAFFIC SIGNAL FOR SOUTH BOUND TRAFFIC. THE MERCURY PASSED THE CLEARLY PAINTED WHITE STOP BAR ON THE ROADWAY BEFORE COMING TO A COMPLETE STOP. UPON THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL TURNING GREEN THE MERCURY TURNED EASTBOUND ONTO ATLANTIC AVE; WHILE TRAVELING EASTBOUND THE MERCURY FAILED TO MAINTAIN ITS LANE CROSSING THE CLEARLY PAINTED WHITE LINES ON THE PAVEMENT. A LAWFUL TRAFFIC STOP WAS CONDUCTED WHERE I MADE CONTACT WITH THE DRIVER EXPLAINING THE REASON FOR THE STOP. I ASKED THE DRIVER TO PROVIDE HER LICENSE AND SHE IDENTIFIED HERSELF AS ELEXUS KAMEN. IT SHOULD BE NOTED AS I APPROACHED THE VEHICLE I OBSERVED TO DRIVER SPRAYING WHAT SMELLED LIKE PERFUME HEAVILY THROUGHOUT THE VEHICLE. ALTHOUGH THE SMELL OF PERFUME WAS APPARENT I COULD ALSO SMELL THE ODOR OF BURNT MARIJUANA EMITTING FROM THE VEHICLE. I TOLD THE DRIVER I COULD SMELL MARIJUANA AND KAMEN STATED SHE HAD SMOKED MARIJUANA IN THE VEHICLE EARLIER THEN WENT ONTO PULL A CLEAR PLASTIC BAG CONTAINING A GREEN LEAFY SUBSTANCE (SUSPECTED MARIJUANA) FROM HER PURSE. IN PLAIN VIEW NEXT TO KAMEN'S RIGHT LEG WAS A CLEAR PLASTIC CUP CONTAINING AN UNKNOWN LIQUID. BEHIND THE DRIVERS SEAT WAS A LARGE GLASS BOTTLE, CONTAINING ROUGHLY A THIRD AMOUNT OF A BROWN LIQUID. THROUGH MY TRAINING, KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE IT APPEARED TO BE A "CAPTAIN MORGAN" GLASS BOTTLE. WHILE KAMEN WAS SPEAKING HER SPEECH WAS SLOW AND SLURRED; SHE REFUSED SEVERAL TIMES TO LOOK IN MY DIRECTION WHEN I ASKED QUESTIONS DIRECTED TO HER. I REQUIRED KAMEN TO EXIT HER VEHICLE; AS SHE EXITED I OBSERVED SHE WAS UNSTEADY ON HER FEET. AS KAMEN WALKED FROM HER VEHICLE THE ODOR OF MARIJUANA WAS ALSO EMITTING FROM HER PERSON. KAMEN WENT ONTO EXPLAIN SHE HAD BEEN "DRINKING" EARLIER IN THE NIGHT. THE SUSPECTED MARIJUANA WAS TESTED USING A PRSO ISSUED DUQUENOIS REAGENT TEST KIT; THIS TEST REVEALED THE SUSPECTED SUBSTANCE WAS IN FACT MARIJUANA. D/S LEVEY 9415 RESPONDED TO THE SCENE TO CONDUCT A DUI INVESTIGATION, SEE LEVEY'S REPORT FOR FURTHER DETAIL.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

UPON MY ARRIVAL I OBSERVED THAT THERE WAS A PINK MERCURY GRAND MARQUIS WITH AN ATTACHED FLORIDA TAG OF AYPU14, THAT WAS STOPPED IN FRONT OF D/S COOK'S VEHICLE. I OBSERVED THAT THE VEHICLE WAS UNOCCUPIED, AND ALL OCCUPANTS WERE SEATED ON THE SIDEWALK, WITH THE DRIVER, ELEXUS MARY KAMEN STANDING NEXT TO D/S COOK'S VEHICLE. I SPOKE WITH KAMEN, AND INFORMED HER OF MY REASONINGS FOR BEING HERE. SHE STATED THAT SHE UNDERSTOOD AS TO WHY. KAMEN WAS INFORMED OF WHY THE DEPUTY STOPPED HER, AND WAS ADVISED THAT I WANTED TO MAKE SURE SHE WAS OKAY TO DRIVE. HER EYES WERE BLOOD SHOT, AND GLASSY.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

KAMEN STATED THAT SHE WOULD DO ROADSIDE TASKS. SHE STATED THAT SHE HAD BEEN DRINKING EARLIER, AND HAD SOME MARIJUANA EARLIER. SHE CONTINUALLY STATED THAT SHE HAD SOME MARIJUANA EARLIER, AND HAD ONE DRINK.

ODORS:

OBVIOUS ODOR OF AN UNKNOWN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE COMING FROM HER PERSON AND AS SHE SPOKE IT BECAME STRONGER. I ALSO NOTICED THE ODOR OF MARIJUANA COMING FROM HER BREATH, AND AS SHE SPOKE IT BECAME STRONGER.

SPEECH: SLIGHTLY SLURRED

ATTITUDE: CALM AND COOPERATIVE AT THE BEGINNING, GIGGLING, HAPPY, Polite



Other Observations:

The overhead forward facing blue police lights were turned off prior to beginning the task. Kamen's eyes tracked equally, the pupils were the same size and appropriate for the lighting conditions, and no resting nystagmus was observed. Kamen had difficulty not moving her head, for the task. She had to physically hold her head and chin to prevent her head from moving. Vertical gaze nystagmus was administered and was not observed. Lack of convergence was administered and was not observed.

WALK & TURN:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the walk and turn task to Kamen who stated that she understood. During the task I observed that Kamen had the following cues: couldn't keep balance while listening to instructions; missed heel-to-toe on all steps; stepped off the line on several steps; used arms for balance (raises arms over six inches; improper turn (loses balance, turns other way)(on 9th step, she immediately went into a turn);

ONE LEG STAND:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the one leg stand task to Kamen who stated that she understood. During the task I observed that Kamen had the following cues: swayed while balancing; put foot down (before 30 seconds); While Kamen was conducting the task, she had to be reminded to look at her foot.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the finger to nose task to Kamen I explained what is considered the tip of the finger and tip of the nose to Kamen who stated that she understood. During the task I observed that when Kamen conducted the task, she did not bring her index finger straight up, she curved it inward, and then back outward, not as instructed. I observed that her eyelids were trembling, while they were closed. The task was conducted in the following manner, Left - tip to tip, Right - tip to tip, Left - tip to tip, Right - pad of finger to tip of nose, Right - pad of finger to tip of nose, Left - tip to tip

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

Prior to beginning the task, I confirmed what level of education Kamen had completed. She stated that they had a gone to college, and is familiar with the English alphabet. I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the Romberg with recitation task to Kamen who stated that she understood. During the task I observed that Kamen had the following cues: swayed more than two inches in any direction. Kamen also sang the alphabet, not say it slowly, as instructed. She said, "A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L, M, N, O, P, Q, R, S, T, U, V, W, X, Y, AND Z"

The modified Romberg balance was explained and demonstrated to Kamen who stated that she understood. Kamen was asked to estimate the passage of 30 seconds in their head. Kamen showed the following cues: 01:47:20 time started, ended at 01:47:40.


