On the 24 day of October, 2019 at 14:19 (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.) On 10/24/2019 at approximately, 1338 hours, I responded to 1299 W Palmetto Rd in reference to a suspicious person sitting in the driver's seat of a vehicle. While enroute, dispatch advised that a white male was "freaking out" in his vehicle. BRFD Chief Welhalf was on scene and requested law enforcement to step up their response time due to the way the subject was acting. I met with Officer Castellanos who was already on scene with the subject, Eric Ackerman, who was identified by his Florida Drivers License. Ackerman was standing outside of his Black Hyundai getting medical attention from BRFD. Ofc. Castellanos advised that Ackerman was in the driver's seat of the vehicle with the vehicle turned on. I spoke with who Ackerman advised the he was fine and that he was trying to get a slice of pizza to eat. Akerman was sweating profusely and was very fidgety while on scene. Ackerman had pin point pupils and Ofc. Van Camp noticed a small amount of a white powdery substance under Ackerman's nose. At this point, I asked Akerman if he would be willing to perform field sobriety tasks in order to see if he could safely operate his vehicle. Ackerman advised that he would be willing to perform the roadside tasks. Before I began the tasks, I asked Ackerman if I could search for weapons/drugs. I noticed a bulge in his left front pant pocket. I asked Ackerman if I could go into his front left pocket to see what the bulge was. Ackerman advised that I could. Ackerman gave me consent to search him. I pulled out 13 pills in a small baggie that later tested positive for fentanyl. I then continued to pat down Ackerman and found a blue pill bottle containing a variety of pills. Akerman advised that the pills were for a prescription for his headaches and anxiety. The blue pill bottle contained .2 Grams of Claratine, 2.1 grams of Fioricet, .06 grams of Tizanidine, .03 grams of Xanax, 1 pill of 800mg Ibuprofen and 1.6 grams of Clonazepam. At this point I read Ackerman his Miranda Rights and he advised that he understood and agreed to speak with officers.

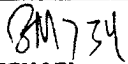

These pills that were later discovered to be fatanyl, Ackerman originally had told officers that they were vitamin capsules. I then began the field sobriety tasks. I asked Ackerman if he was on any medication or if he has any injuries that would prevent him from doing the tasks, he replied "no". I explained and demonstrated each task before he attempted them. First, I performed Walk and Turn, Ackerman advised that he understood the instructions. He began the test missing his heel to toe steps multiple times. On Akerman's second round of heel to toe steps he only completed 8 steps. Next, Akerman did the one-legged stand. Akerman advised that he understood the instructions. Akerman began the task and began to bring his arms away from his body to balance himself. While Akerman was counting he stopped counting for approximately 20 seconds of the task. Next, I instructed Akerman to do the finger to nose. Akerman advised that he understood the instructions. Akerman had a slight bend at the knees when he was tilting his head back but completed the exercise. Lastly, I asked Ackerman to recite the Rhomberg alphabet. He advised he understood the English alphabet. Akerman did not have any difficulties completing the alphabet. Based on the above facts I placed Eric Ackerman under arrest for 893.13(6A) possession of a controlled substance and 316.193(1) driving under the influence. Akerman was transported to the Boca Raton Police Department and Officer Van Camp conducted the Intoxilyzer 8000. Ackerman provided two breath samples .03 .029. Based on Ackerman's level of impairment and his admission to ingesting a controlled substance, I collected a urine sample and submitted it to evidence. Ackerman was later taken to the Palm Beach County Jail without incident.

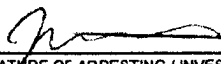
