PROBABLE CAUSE

On the above date and time, I was patrolling Palm Beach County in my marked patrol vehicle. I was dispatched to a vehicle crash on State Road 9 (I-95). When I arrived on scene, I observed a dark colored SUV rolled on its driver side, down in a ditch, off the right unpaved shoulder on I-95. I approached the vehicle and observed a white male and a black male standing at the rear of the SUV. I introduced myself to the two males, and asked them both were they okay. The black male advised that he was okay and was not involved, but just stopped to see if the driver was okay. I then spoke with the white male, who was later identified L-250-204-97-092-0 as Ervin David Lescano by his Florida Driver License. Mr. Lescano advised me that he was the driver and he was okay. Fire Rescue then arrived on scene and assessed Mr. Lescano. Shortly after, Mr. Lescano was medically cleared by the on scene Fire Rescue Department. I then asked Mr. Lescano about what events took place leading up to the vehicle crash. While speaking to Mr. Lescano he was observed to have a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his mouth or breathe area. Mr. Lescano was also observed to have:

- Bloodshot eyes
- Slurred speech

Mr. Lescano advised me that he was traveling northbound, on I-95, in the inside travel lane. Mr. Lescano advised me while traveling on I-95, he dozed off behind the wheel of the vehicle. Mr. Lescano then advised me when he woke up, the vehicle was traveling in an easterly direction, across four (4) northbound travel lanes. Mr. Lescano advised that he then attempted to over correct the vehicle. As a result, the vehicle traveled off the roadway onto the unpaved shoulder of I-95. After, the vehicle began to rollover down a grassy ditch. When the vehicle came to final rest, Mr. Lescano then advised that he crawled out the driver window.

While speaking to Mr. Lescano he was observed to have a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his mouth or breathe area. Mr. Lescano was also observed to have:

- Bloodshot eyes
- Slurred speech

I then advised Mr. Lescano that I have completed my crash investigation, and that I am now conducting a Driving Under the Influence (DUI) investigation. Mr. Lescano advised that he understood. I then advised Mr. Lescano of his Miranda Rights. Mr. Lescano understood his rights and agreed to continue to speak with me about the investigation. I then asked Mr. Lescano to advise me of the events that took place leading up to the vehicle crash. Mr. Lescano advised me that he was traveling northbound, on I-95, in the inside travel lane. Mr. Lescano advised me while traveling on I-95, he dozed off behind the wheel of the vehicle. Mr. Lescano then advised me when he woke up, the vehicle was traveling in an easterly direction, across four (4) northbound travel lanes. Mr. Lescano advised that he then attempted to over correct the vehicle. As a result, the vehicle traveled off the roadway onto the unpaved shoulder of I-95. After, the vehicle began to rollover down a grassy ditch. When the vehicle came to final rest, Mr. Lescano then advised that he crawled out the driver window. I then asked Mr. Lescano did he have any alcoholic beverages before operating the motor vehicle involved in the single vehicle crash. Mr. Lescano advised me yes, he had two (2) beers. I then asked Mr. Lescano around what time did he consume the beers? Mr. Lescano advised me that he consumed the beers around 7:30PM. I then asked Mr. Lescano what is the current time (1:14AM). Mr. Lescano advised me that it was around 9:30 PM.

I then asked Mr. Lescano would he be willing to perform series of field sobriety exercises. When asked, Mr. Lescano agreed to submit to a series of field sobriety exercises.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Exercise

Prior to beginning the exercise, it was determined Mr. Lescano was not wearing contacts. Mr. Lescano's eyes were checked and his eyes displayed equal tracking and his pupils were equal sizes. Mr. Lescano was instructed to following the stimulus with his eyes only, keeping his head still. After stating he understood the instructions Mr. Lescano attempted this exercise.

The results of this exercise displayed 5 of the 6 points:

- A lack of Smooth Pursuit in his left eye
- A lack of Smooth Pursuit in his right eye
- A distinct and sustained nystagmus in the left eye at maximum deviation.
- An onset of nystagmus in the left eye prior to 45 degrees
- An onset of nystagmus in the right eye prior to 45 degrees

Walk and Turn Exercise

Prior to attempting this exercise, Mr. Lescano indicated he did not have any medical problems that would have prevented him from performing the exercise. Mr. Lescano was instructed to put his left foot on the line and his right foot in front of it with his right heel touching the toe of his left foot. He was instructed to stand in this manner with his hands to his sides until the exercise instructions were completed and the exercise demonstrated. Mr. Lescano was instructed not to begin the

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exercise until told to start. He was instructed to take nine steps along the line in a heel-to-toe manner. After the ninth step he was to stop and turn around keeping his lead foot on the ground, taking several small steps with the other foot to turn around. After turning around he was to take nine steps in a heel-to-toe manner back along the line, in the direction he had come from. Mr. Lescano was further instructed to watch his feet at all times while walking, keep his arms down to his side, and to count his steps out loud. After the exercise was demonstrated Mr. Lescano stated he understood the instructions and was instructed to begin the exercise.

- After attempting the Walk and Turn Exercise Mr. Lescano displayed 1 of 8 possible clues.

Walk and Turn Exercises observations:

- On the first set of steps Mr. Lescano failed to walk in a heel-to-toe manner on 3 steps, failing to walk heel-to-toe on steps 3, 4, and 5. - On the second set of steps Mr. Lescano failed to walk in a heel-to-toe manner on 2 steps, failing to walk heel-to-toe on steps 5, and 9.

One Leg Stand Exercise

Prior to attempting this exercise, Mr. Lescano indicated he did not have any medical problems that would have prevented him from performing the exercise. Mr. Lescano was instructed to stand with his heels together and hands down to his sides while the instructions were given and during the exercise. Mr. Lescano was instructed not to begin the exercise until he was instructed to start, and after the exercise had been demonstrated. When instructed to start, he was to raise the foot of his choice off the ground approximately 6 inches. While his leg was raised he was to keep his leg straight, watch his raised foot, and to count out loud by thousands (one thousand one, one thousand two, one thousand three...) and to continue the test until told to stop (30 seconds). After this exercise was demonstrated and indicating he understood the instructions Mr. Lescano attempted this exercise.

When Mr. Lescano attempted this exercise he raised his right foot.

The result of this exercise displayed 2 of the 4 possible clues.

During this test Mr. Lescano:

- Swayed during the exercise.
- Hopped during the exercise.

After I completed the Standardize Field Sobriety Exercise observations on Mr. Lescano, I then placed Mr. Lescano under arrest for suspected Driving under the influence (DUI) of alcohol. I then placed Mr. Lescano in the rear of my patrol vehicle, and secured him in. Shortly after, I departed the scene enroute to the Palm Beach County Jail. Upon arrival at the jail, I escorted Mr. Lescano to the BAT center. There, I conducted a 20 minute observation period of Mr. Lescano. Once the 20 minutes were up, I escorted Mr. Lescano into the BAT room. Once there, I requested Mr. Lescano to submit to a lawful test of his breath for the purpose of determining if alcohol content. Mr. Lescano agreed to submit at 2:49AM. At 2:54AM, Mr. Lescano provided his first breathe sample of .124. At 2:57AM, Mr. Lescano provided a breathe sample of .118.

After, Mr. Lescano was advised of the samples he provided. I then advised Mr. Lescano of his constitutional warnings. After advising Mr. Lescano of his constitutional warnings, Mr. Lescano advised me he would continue further questioning. After a series of questions and answers, I then placed Mr. Lescano back into the rear of my patrol vehicle and departed the jail enroute to Wellington Hospital to get Mr. Lescano medically cleared to be booked into the Palm Beach County Jail. Upon my arrival to the Wellington Hospital, Mr. Lescano was medically evaluated and cleared at 4:30AM. Shortly after, Mr. Lescano and I departed the scene enroute to Palm Beach County Jail. Once arrived, Mr. Lescano was booked into the Palm Beach County jail on 316.193.1 Florida Statue Misdemeanor DUI. All events occurred in Palm Beach County.
