	On Friday November 15, 2019 at 1525 hours, I responded to The Home Depot Store, located at 9820 Glades Road, unincorporated Boca Raton FL 33428 in reference to a retail theft in progress. Upon arrival, I met with loss prevention officer Stephen Fazekas, who stated the following. Stephen stated today at approximately 1524 hours, he witnessed an unknown white male, wearing a blue and white shirt and tan shorts, enter the Home Depot Store, located at 9820 Glades Road. Stephen stated he witnessed this subject select multiple "high dollar light bulbs". Stephen stated this subject then selected a vacuum and place the vacuum as well as other miscellaneous items in his shopping cart. Stephen stated he then witnessed this subject open the vacuum box and conceal the light bulbs inside the box. Stephen stated he then witnessed this subject conceal other light bulbs in two other containers which were inside his shopping cart. Stephen stated after this subject completed the concealment of the merchandise, he then witnessed him walk directly to the checkout counter. Stephen stated this subject passed all points of sale and made no attempt to pay for the concealed merchandise. I then made contact with this subject after he passed the checkout out line and he was identified by his Florida Drivers License as Forrest Read. Stephen opened the vacuum box and the other containers and located the concealed merchandise. Forrest was then informed he was being arrested for retail theft. Forrest was then handcuffed. The handcuffs were checked for proper tightness, fit and then double locked. Forrest was then escorted to my patrol vehicle, where he was then read his Miranda Warnings off a preprinted card. Forrest stated he understood his rights and wished to speak to me in reference to the incident. Forrest stated he did select and conceal the merchandise because he wanted to give the merchandise to his sister for her birthday. The value which Forrest concealed and stole was \$791.91 dollars. Forrest provided no further information. Upon completion of my investigation, I find probable cause does exist to arrest Forrest for the charge of Grand Theft, per F.S.S. 812.014 2C1. Forrest was transported to the Main Jail. This case is cleared by arrest.
